CRIMINAL RECORD

As John Dillinger, #14395, received State Reformatory, Pendleton, Indiana, September 16, 1924; crime, assault and battery with intent to rob and conspiracy to commit a felony; sentences, 2 to 14 years and 10 to 20 years respectively;

As John Dillinger, #13225, received State Prison, Michigan City, Indiana, July 16, 1929; transferred from Indiana State Reformatory; paroled under Reformatory jurisdiction, May 10, 1933; parole revoked by Governor - considered as delinquent parolee;

As John Dillinger, #10587, arrested Police Department, Dayton, Ohio, September 22, 1933; charge, fugitive; turned over to Allen County, Ohio, authorities;

As John Dillinger, received County Jail, Lima, Ohio, September 26, 1933; charge, bank robbery; escaped October 12, 1933;

As Frank Sullivan, arrested Police Department, Tucson, Arizona, January 25, 1934; charge, fugitive; turned over to Lake County, Indiana, authorities;

As John Dillinger, #14487, arrested Sheriff's Office, Crown Point, Indiana, January 30, 1934; charge, murder - bank robbery; escaped March 3, 1934.

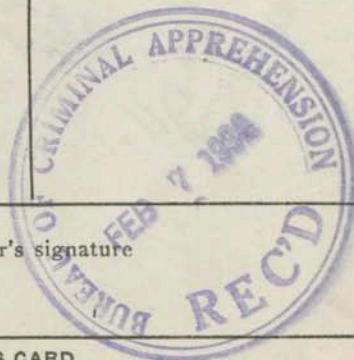

DILLINGER'S GIRL AND DOCTOR FREED BY U. S.

Leavenworth, Kan., Jan. 30.—(AP—Wirephoto)—Dr. Clayton E. May, 47, Minneapolis physician, is shown in the sheriff's office at Leavenworth Thursday after he had been freed from the federal penitentiary where he served a term on conviction of harboring the late John Dillinger, notorious gunman. Dr. May was convicted of treating without reporting to police gunshot wounds suffered by Dillinger, probably in a gunfight with deputies south of St. Paul after his escape from the Little Bohemia, northern Wisconsin, raid. Dr. May's rearrest Thursday was on a Minneapolis illegal operation charge.

Detroit, Jan. 30.—(AP—Wirephoto)—Evelyn Frechette, sweetheart of John Dillinger, took a pauper's oath as the last formality for her release Thursday from the federal prison farm at Milan, Mich., where she served a two-year sentence for harboring the gunman. The oath relieved her from paying a \$1,000 fine. She declared she had only \$20 and a small income from a federal Indian pension. She was with Dillinger when the couple shot their way out of a trap in a St. Paul Lexington avenue apartment. She announced she intends to "go straight" and return to her mother's home at Noepit, Wis.
