Kathryn Thorne Kelly was indicted in the Federal Court at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, on August 23, 1933, together with her husband George R. Kelly, and others, and charged with kidnaping Charles F. Urschel at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, on July 22, 1933, and transporting him to Paradise, Texas, where he was held for ransom in violation of the Act of Congress approved June 22, 1932.
