During the night of November 1st, 1936, while two burglars were attempting to get into a safe of the Adams Transfer Company at Fargo, one of the burglars was shot and the other escaped. The burglar who was shot was FRED PORTH of St. Paul, and he died from the gunshot wounds on Nov. 4, 1936. On Nov. 3, 1936, Investigators of this Bureau arrested FRANK PIPAN, MITCHELL SLONINA and PETER HOCKERT in Minneapolis, and they confessed to the following crimes, and Frank Pipan confessed that he was the burglar who was with Fred Porth when he was shot.

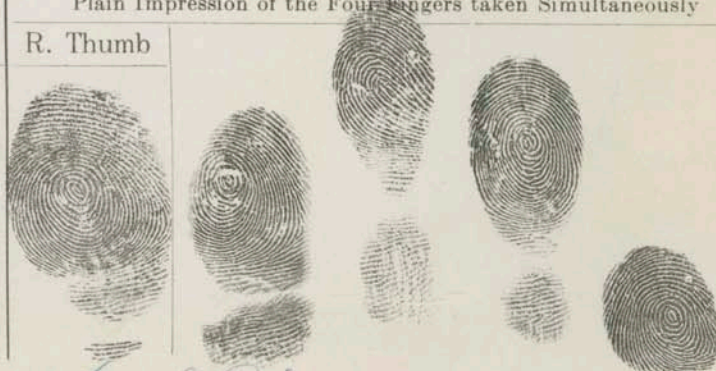
Plain Impression of the Four Fingers taken Simultaneously

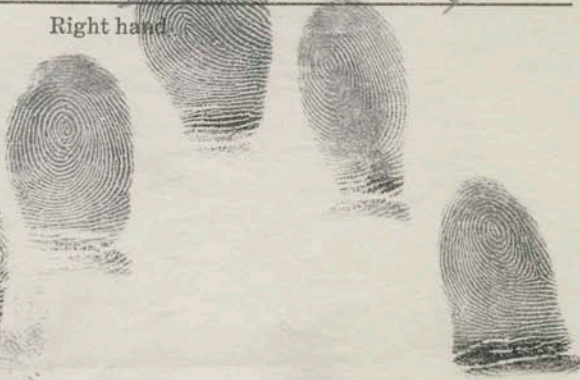
