On leave of absence for forty-four (44) days from September 4, 1898. Promoted Captain April 3, 1899 to take rank from March 3, 1899. Detached from Brooklyn, N.Y. and ordered to marine barracks, Port Royal, S.C., April 18, 1899; joined April 24, 1899. Detached from Port Royal, S.C. and ordered to Washington, D.C. was enrolled July 2, 1898, but was not mustered into service as 1st Lieut. Co. C, 15th Minnesota Infantry volunteers until July 18, 1898, when he was mustered to date from July 12, 1898. He was mustered into service as captain, same company and regiment, December 30, 1898, and was mustered out of service as such, with his company, March 27, 1899.

Commissioned 2nd Lieut. U.S.M.C. July 19, 1900 to take rank from July 23, 1900. On September 10, 1900 ordered to Marine barracks, Washington, D.C. for instructions; joined September 11, 1900. On February 19, 1901, commissioned 2nd Lieut., to take rank from July 23, 1900 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate. Detached from marine barracks, Washington, D.C. and ordered to U.S. Torpedo Station, Newport, R.I. May 10, 1901; joined May 15, 1901. Detached from Newport, R.I. and ordered to marine barracks, New York, N.Y. August, 19, 1901; joined August 28, 1901. Detached from marine barracks New York, N.Y. and ordered to marine barracks, Washington, D.C. October 16, 1901 for duty as assistant instructor at the School of Application; joined October 24, 1901. At Sea Girt, N.J. as a member of marine corps rifle team, to compete for the Hilton trophy, from August 20, 1902 to September 6, 1902. Detached from Marine barracks, Washington, D.C. November 18, 1902, and ordered to marine barracks, Portsmouth, N.H., to command the marine guard of U.S.S. Raleigh when that vessel is placed in commission; joined marine barracks, Portsmouth, N.H. November 24, 1902.

On duty with Marine Battalion, North Atlantic Squadron from April 22, 1898 to September 20, 1898. Detached and ordered to U.S.S. Buffalo, September 20, 1898; joined September 30, 1898. Detached from the Buffalo and ordered to U.S.S. Olympia, March 17, 1899; joined same day. Detached from the Olympia and ordered to Cavite, P.I., March 23, 1899; joined same day. Detached from Cavite, P.I. and ordered to U.S.S. Oregon, May 18, 1899; joined same day. Detached from the Oregon and ordered to U.S.S. Charleston July 11, 1899; joined same day. Promoted captain May 28, 1899, to take rank from March 3, 1899. Detached from the Charleston and ordered to Cavite, P.I., December 14, 1899; joined same day. On duty in China from June 26, to October 9, 1900. Took part in the battle of Tientsin, China, July 13-14, 1900. Detached from Cavite, P.I., (date not given) and ordered to Guam, L.I.; joined at Guam, L.I. November 27, 1900. On March 18, 1901, appointed first Lieut. by brevet, for distinguished conduct and public service in the presence of the enemy at Guantanamo, Cuba, June 11, 1898. Detached from Guam, L.I. and ordered home August 5, 1901; reported arrival home September 6, 1901. On November 7, 1901 ordered to New York, N.Y. to appear as a witness before a court martial there and when discharged by said court to proceed to Norfolk, Va., for duty in the Marine Barracks there; joined December 6, 1901. On detached duty from September 12, 1902 to December 10, 1902 with marine battalion on Isthmus of Panama. (Sailed on U.S.S. Panther with battalion on September 14, 1902 from League Island, Pa., and arrived at Colon, U.S.C. September 26, 1902. Embarked on U.S.S. Panther November 18, 1902). Detached from the battalion on board the U.S.S. Panther December 10, 1902 and ordered to resume duty at marine barracks, Norfolk, Va., joined December 15, 1902 and on December (date not given) 1902, detached from Norfolk, Va. and ordered to marine barracks, Boston, Mass. for duty; joined December 30, 1902.

Appointed 2nd Lieut., U.S.M.C. (for the war) May 20, 1898, accepted May 23, 1898. On May 23, 1898 ordered to Brooklyn, N.Y. for instructions; joined May 27, 1898. Detached from Brooklyn, N.Y. and ordered to U.S.S. Yale June 11, 1898; joined June 13, 1898. Detached from the Yale and ordered to marine barracks, League Island, Pa., September 2, 1898; joined same day. Detached from League Island, Pa., and ordered to U.S.S. Resolute November 18, 1898; joined November 21, 1898. Detached from the Resolute and ordered to his home to be mustered out of the service, February 8, 1899. Honorably discharged February 23, 1899.

Commissioned 1st Lieut. U.S.M.C. April 8, 1899, accepted April 8, 1899. On April 8, 1899 ordered to duty with Marine Battalion, Manila, P.O. Joined April 9, 1899 and arrived at Cavite, P.I. May 23, 1899. Took part in engagement at Novalleta Bridge, P.I., October 8, 1899. Promoted Captain July 23, 1900, subject to examination and confirmation. Detached from Cavite, P.I. and ordered to Mare Island, Cal. February 7, 1901; joined March 14, 1901. On March 14, 1901, promoted Captain, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate to take rank from July 23, 1900. On March 28, 1901, appointed Captain, by brevet, for distinguished conduct and public service in the presence of the enemy at Novalleta, P.I. from October 8, 1899. Detached from Mare Island, Cal. and ordered to report to the Brigadier General, Commandant, Washington, D.C. April 27, 1901; reported April 24, 1901. On May 7, 1901 ordered to U.S. Torpedo Station, Newport, R.I.; joined May 10, 1901. Detached and ordered to marine barracks, New York, N.Y. August 19, 1901; joined August 24, 1901. Detached from New York, N.Y. and ordered to marine barracks, Norfolk, Va. and ordered to the Special Detachment of Marines, North Atlantic Squadron, Jan. 13, 1902; joined Jan. 21, 1902. Detached from Special Detachment of Marines, North Atlantic Squadron, Culebra, P.R., May 24, 1902 and ordered to his home; reported arrival home Feb. 3, 1902. On June 12, 1902, ordered to U.S.S. Alabama for duty; joined June 23, 1902. Detached from the Alabama Dec. 12, 1902 and ordered to U.S. Olympia; joined same day.
