Eshquaguma Country Club, Gilbert. The McNeil cabin. Joy Lenont amongst others. Mr. Haslam and others golfing. Joy, a Haslam girl, Mima Lenont. Mr. Haslam. My father believes the close up is of Mr. Haslam's wife.

2:50 SE Lenont and Joy, likely in the yard of the Elliot's, neighbors of the Lenont's in Virginia, Minnesota.

3:12 A Florida Trip 1929. Mima and Charles B. Lenont picking grapefruit. Lenont family swimming in the Miami area. A trip to the racetrack.

4:49 Virginia, Minnesota at the Lenont home, 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. and 1<sup>st</sup> St. N. CB Lenont and Peg. SE. Gidgie, Charles, Peg and SE. Emerson Duncan McNeil Senior, and Emerson Jr. walking from the front door. A family moment with most of the Lenont's and Emerson D. McNeil's, Sr. and Jr. This appears to be them heading out for their annual southern excursion to Florida. Not sure if this was the same trip as the other images. This is likely in early 1930.

6:26 Mima, Niece Lenont and Joy. On the way to Florida. Mima and CB Lenont swimming. Mima, Joy and Niece at the racetrack in Florida

7:38, back to Virginia, and the Lenont House, likely summer 1929. Gidgie, baby Charles, Niece, Peg, and the 'Elliot girl from next door.' Bill Loomis and Aunt Lotta (Mima's sister). Various girls from the neighborhood. Gidgie, Joy and Peg. Aunt Lotta and Bill. The last image of my father is probably from 1930 and edited on to the 1929 footage.

9:37 Unknown location but it's either on a boat or on a dock. My father believes this was either on the way to, or in, Florida. Charles B. Lenont and Mima are there. Unknown the other individuals.

9:53 Eshquaguma Country Club

10:10 Charles and Peg on the Lenont Home in Virginia, 1930. He always loves the Hobby Horse he had. Joy. Then winter late 1930. Joy and the Elliot girl.

12:50 Mima in Florida again
