Beginning with Cathy McNeil at an unknown location. Then it's Lorraine DeLoia with a baby (unknown), likely at the DeLoia place in Pike Lake. Pretty sure this is 1950. Gidgie McNeil. Unknown who the man looking through the camera is.

2:04 – Cathy McNeil. Then the picnic section is Gidgie, Georgia Coffin, Cathy, George Coffin, who married Peg McNeil, and Peg sitting next to George. The woman in white is Mickey, my father's first wife. The man with his back to the tree is Charles McNeil, my father. Emerson Duncan McNeil Jr. holding Cathy, George, Peg, Mickey, Charles. Charles enjoying a beer. Cathy and Georgia. At the end there is a brief shot of Cathy dancing outside of Eshquaguma Country Club near Gilbert. Not positive the picnic was at Eshquag, but it could've been. Cathy is wearing a different dress in that picture.

4:11 – Mickey with my oldest brother Emerson Duncan McNeil at the McNeil house in Duluth. This is 1951. Cathy with Duncan. After watching Cathy's lack of concern for Duncan's neck, they felt it'd be safer to replace him with dolls. Gidgie. Cathy. Mima Lenont, Charles B. Lenont's wife, Peg, George. Stanley (SE) Lenont. George, Peg, Mima. That is Catherine 'Gamma' McNeil, Emerson Duncan McNeil Sr.'s wife. Peg and George. Emerson Duncan McNeil Jr. Peg, Mima. Cathy, back when yoga was more 'I fell in a weird way.'

8:20 – Charles and Mickey with Cathy in the middle. Peg and Gidgie on the other side of the table. This is also in the Duluth house, the next morning.

8:57 Cathy baton-ing. Cathy being Cathy. Creepy red bear.

10:45 – The Little boy is Mick Giblin, Jim Giblin and Joy Lenont Giblin's son. That's Jim next to Mick. Gidgie. Mick, Cathy. Briefly, behind Mick, is Joy.
