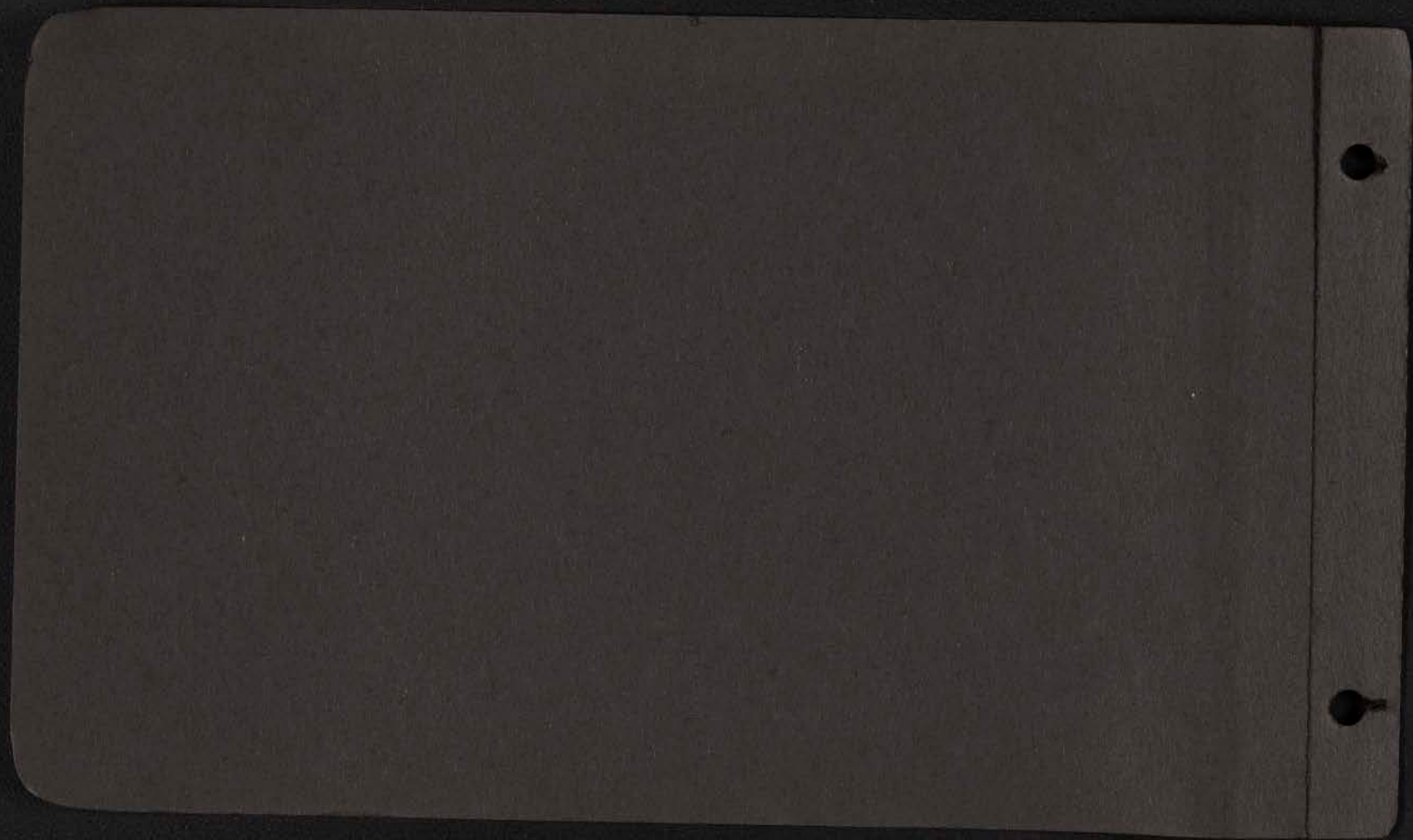

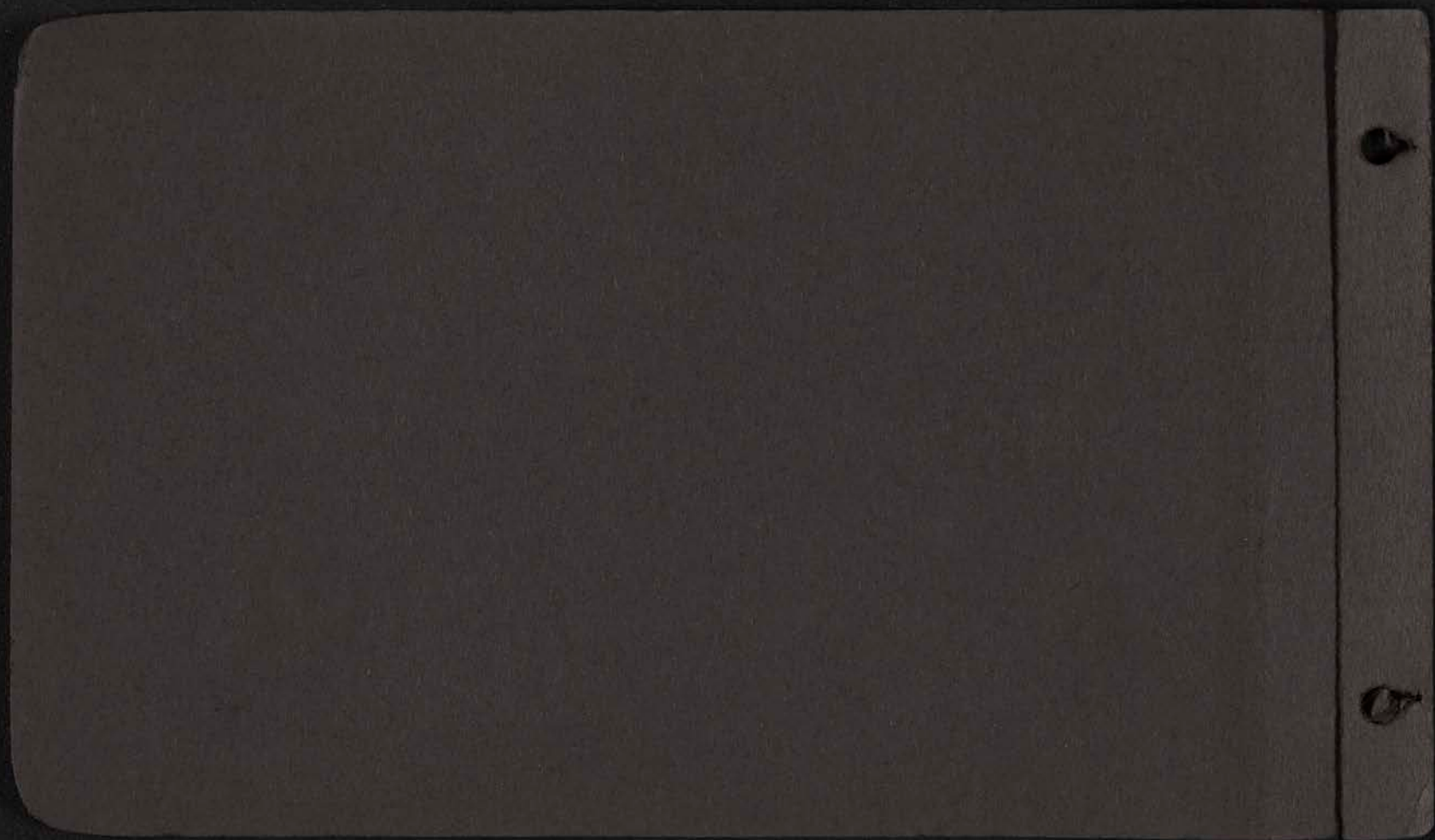

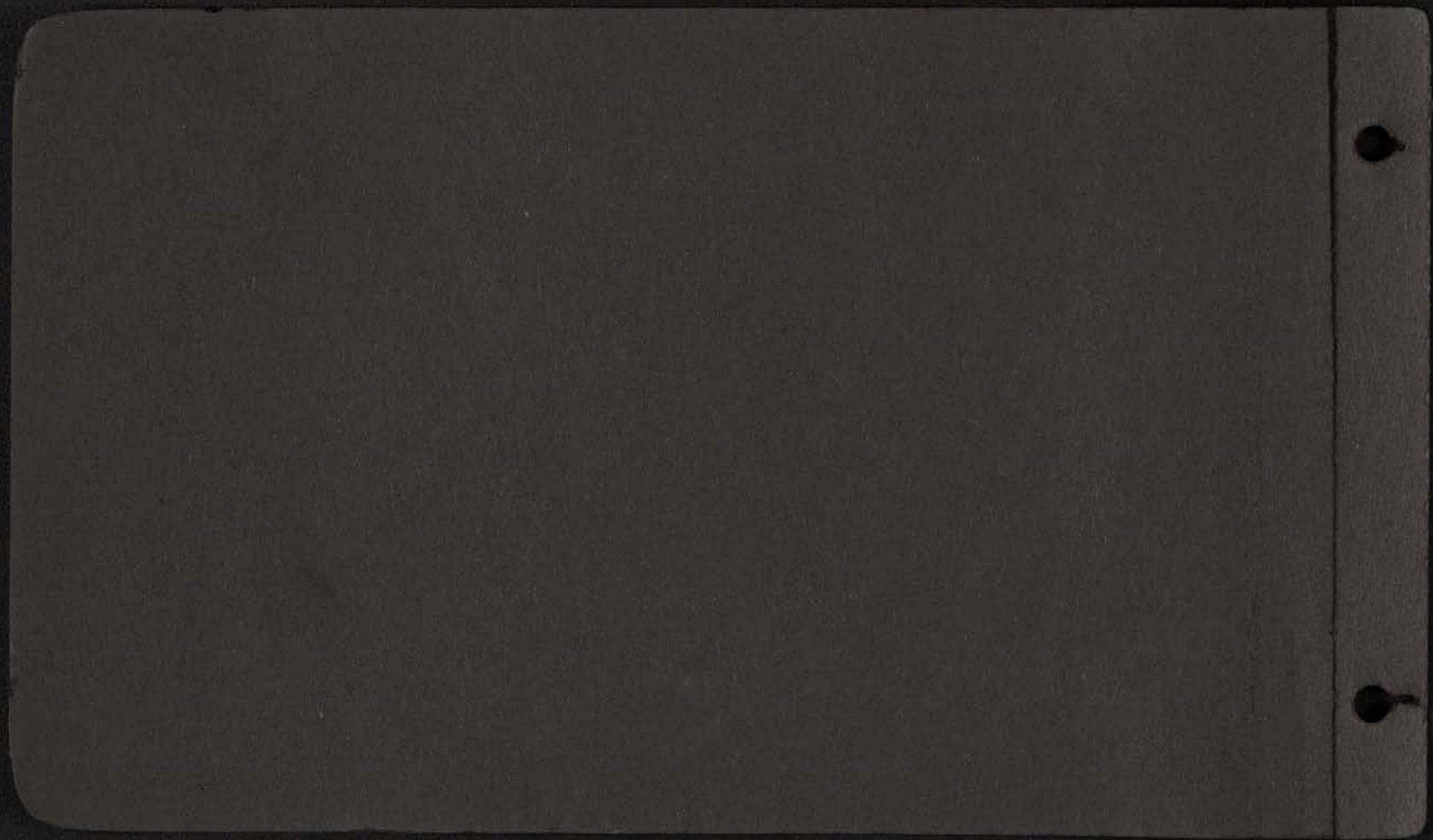


Progress View, Looking East, Sept. 27, 1926.



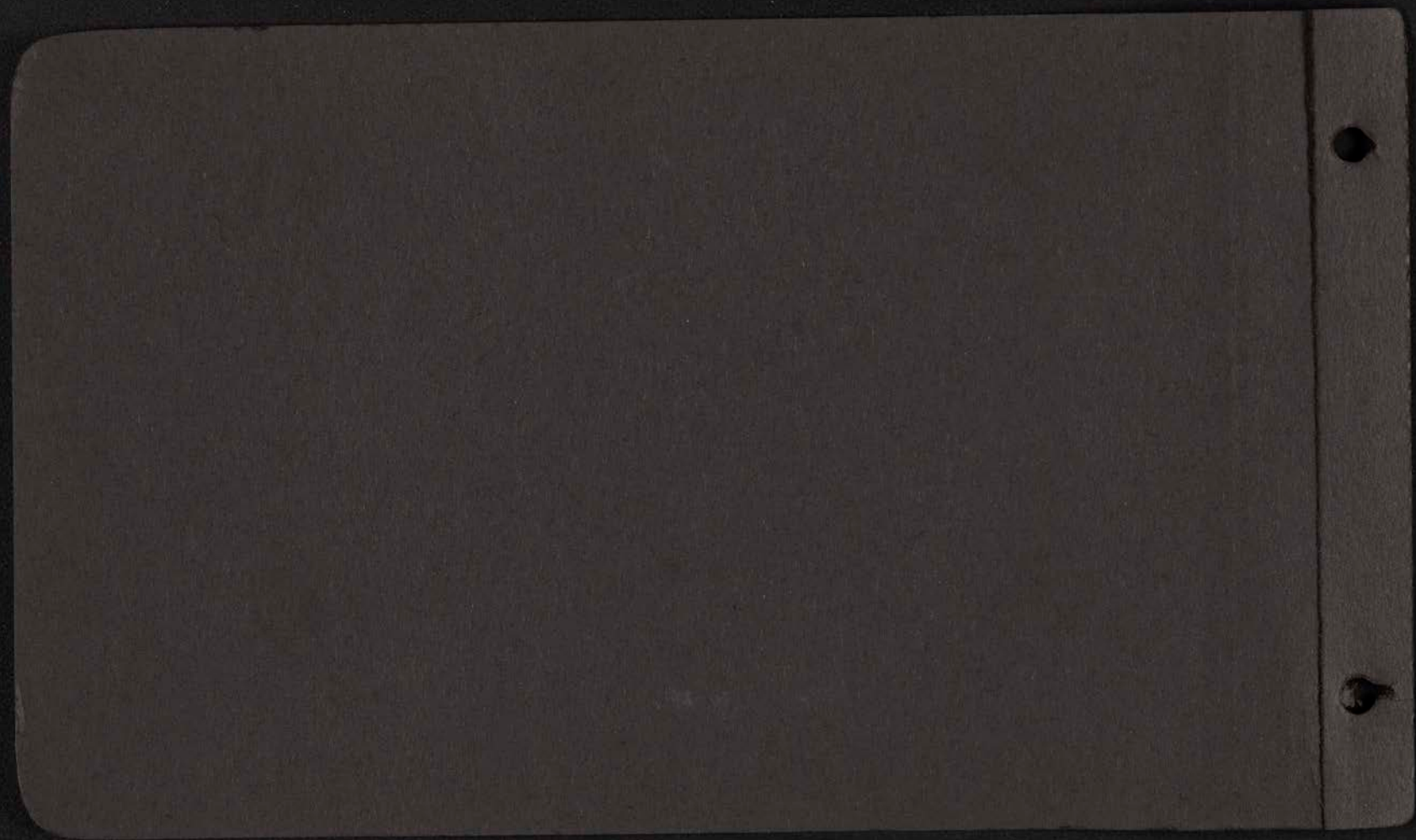

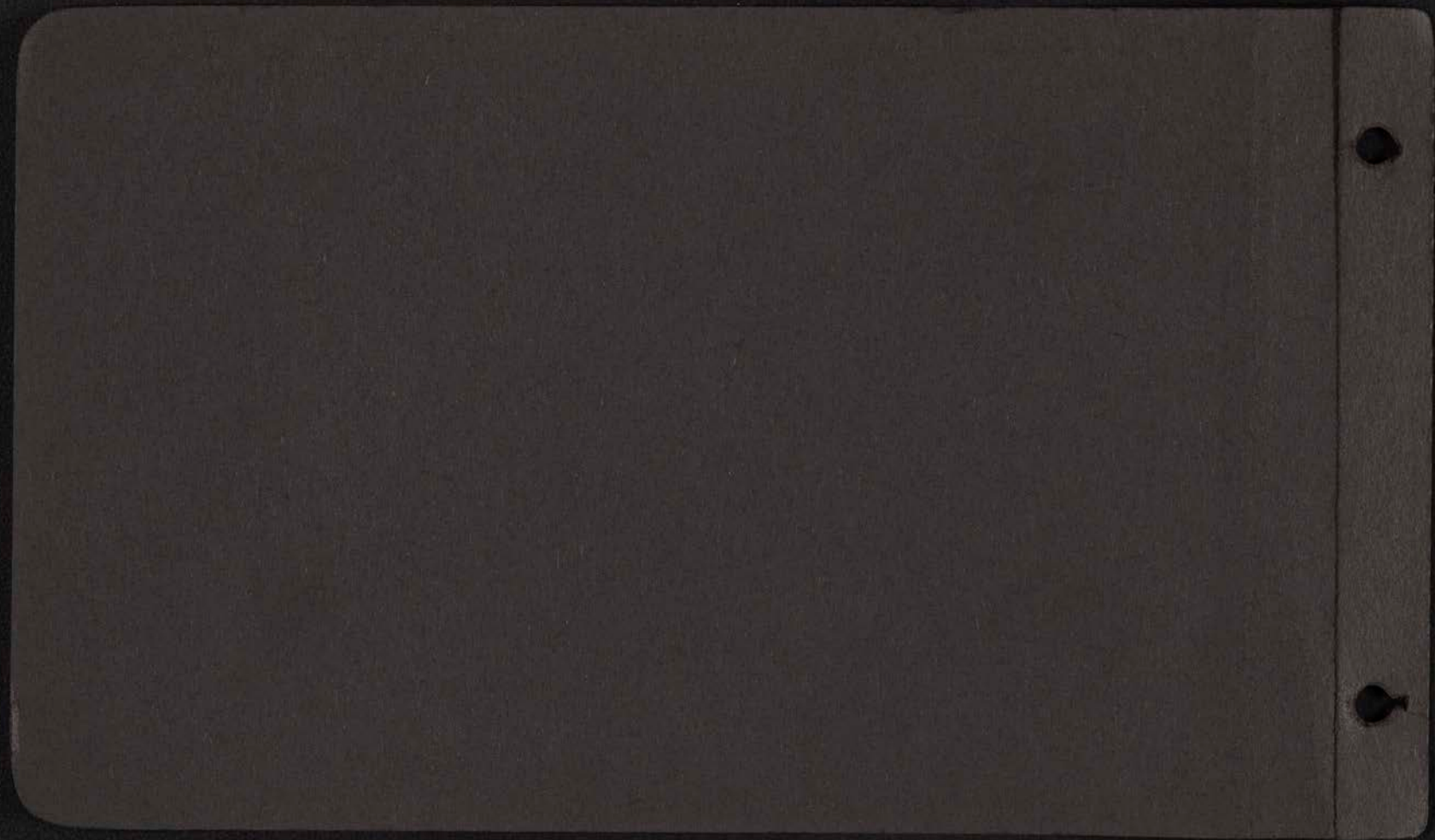

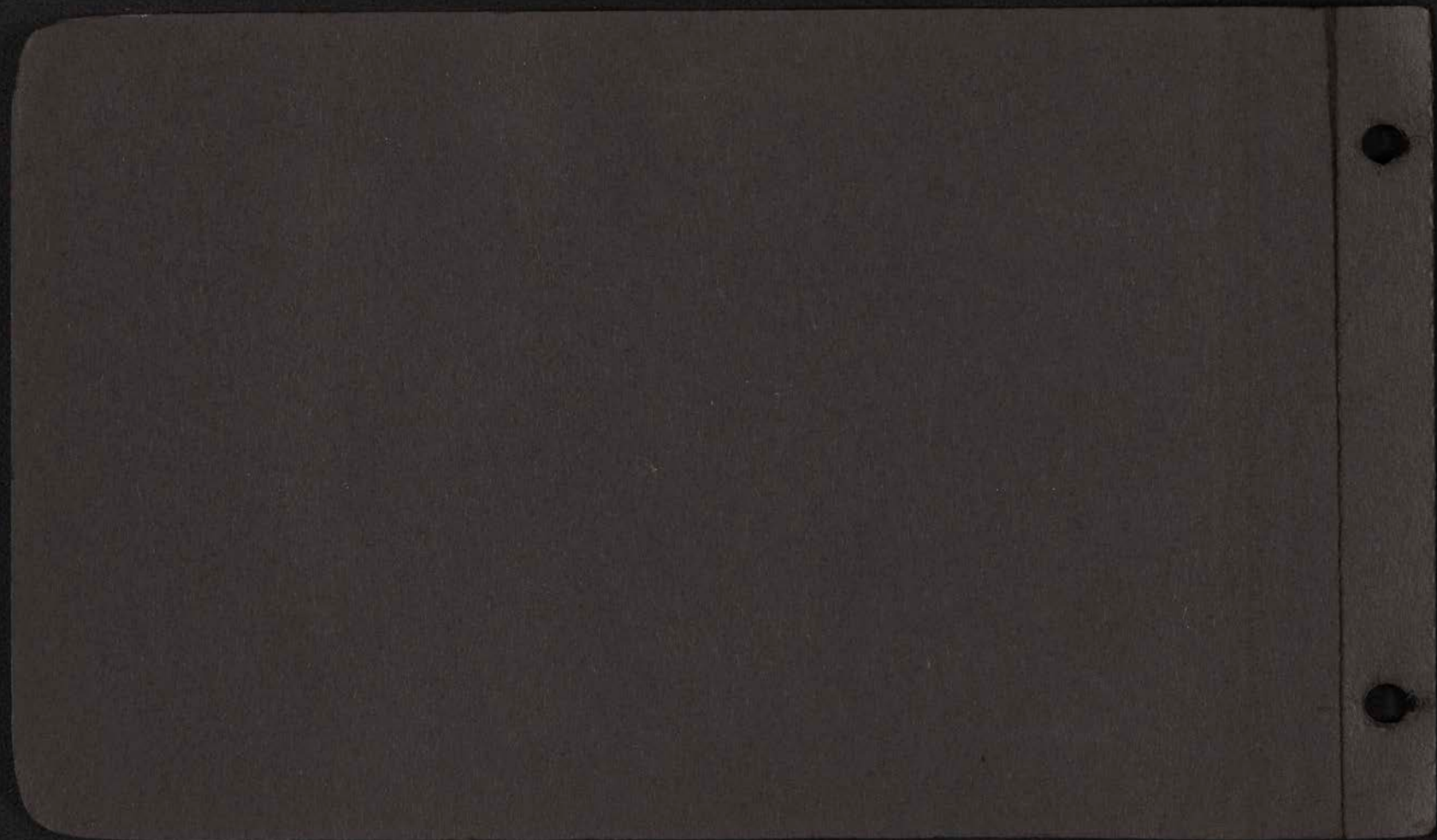

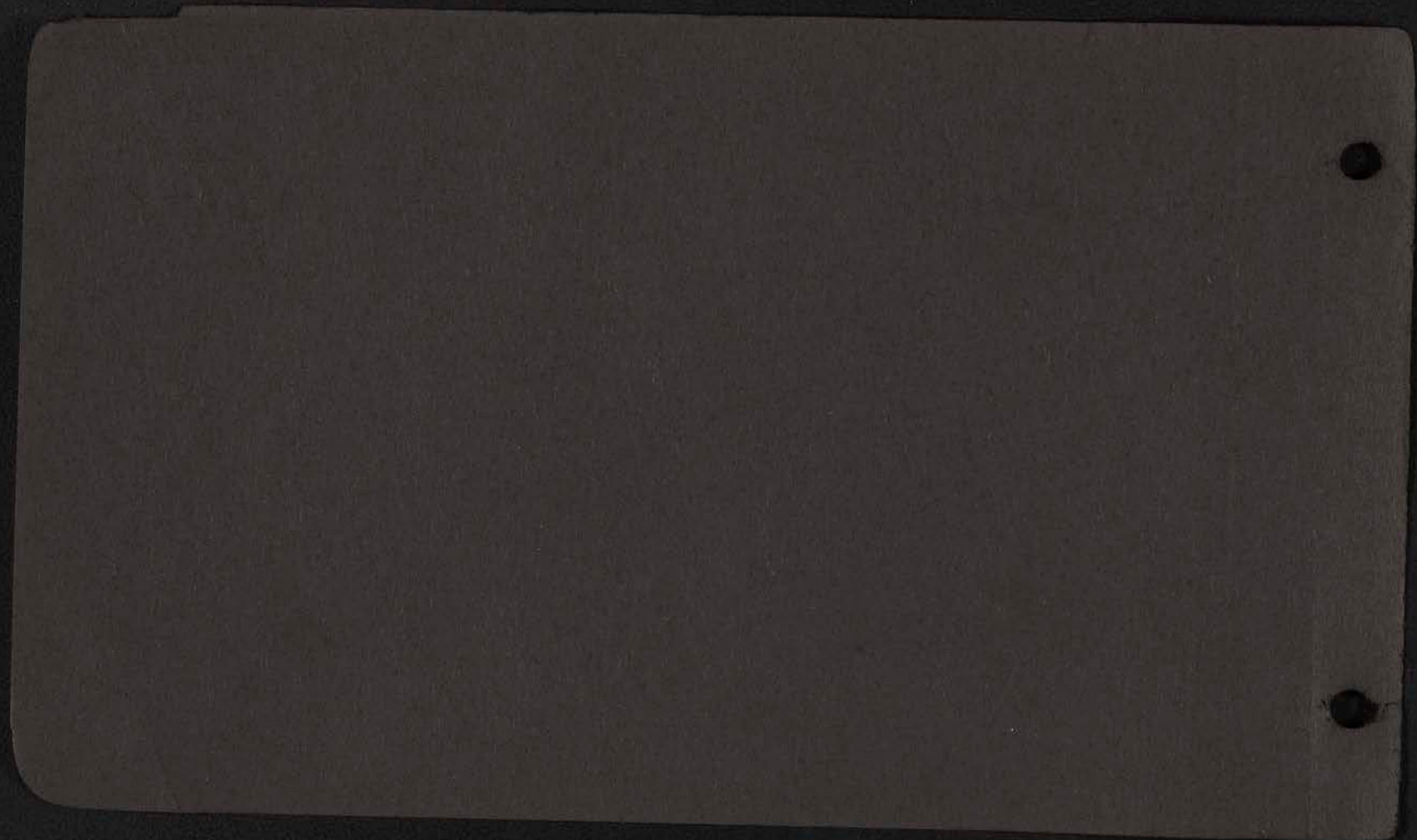

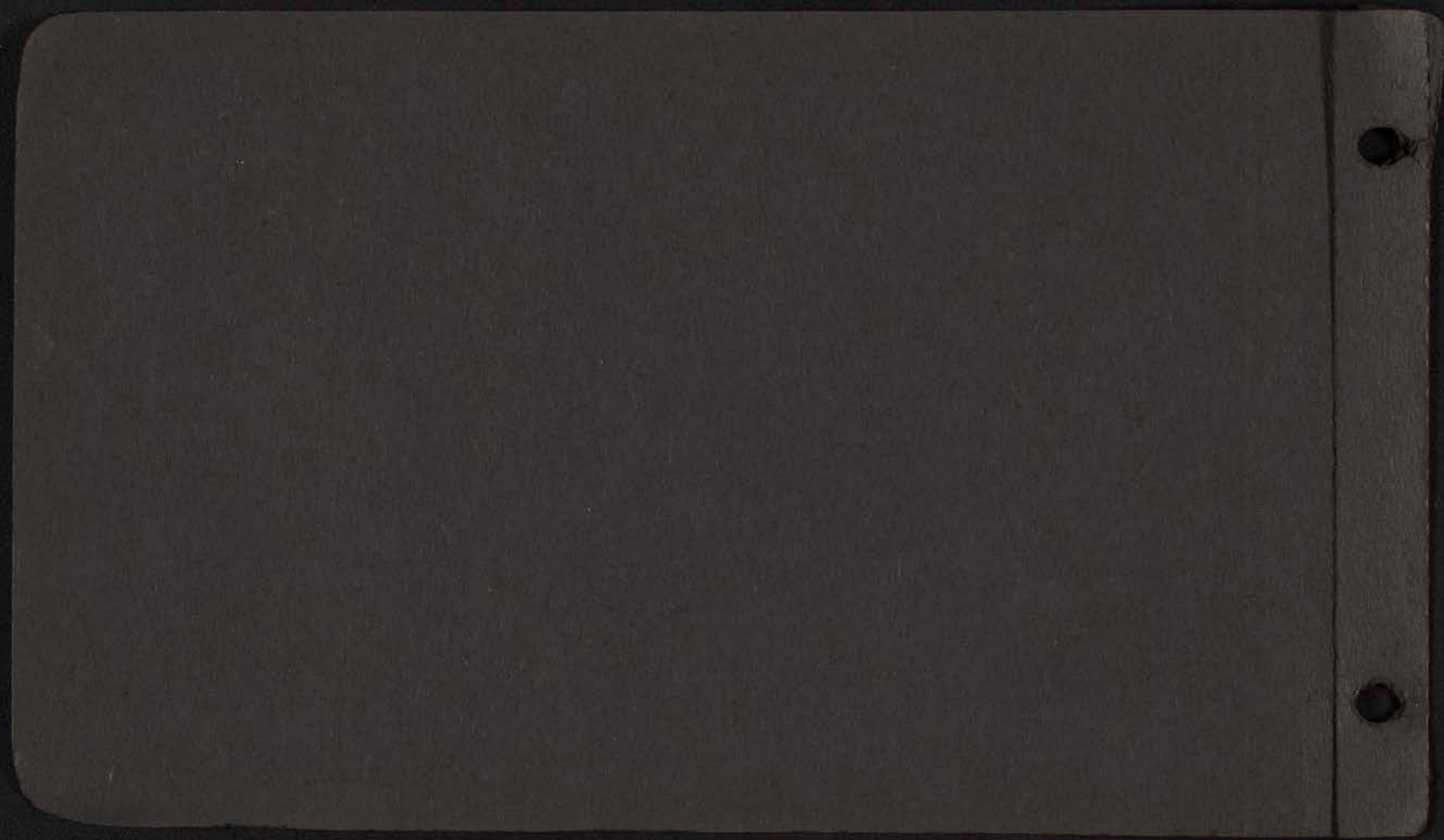

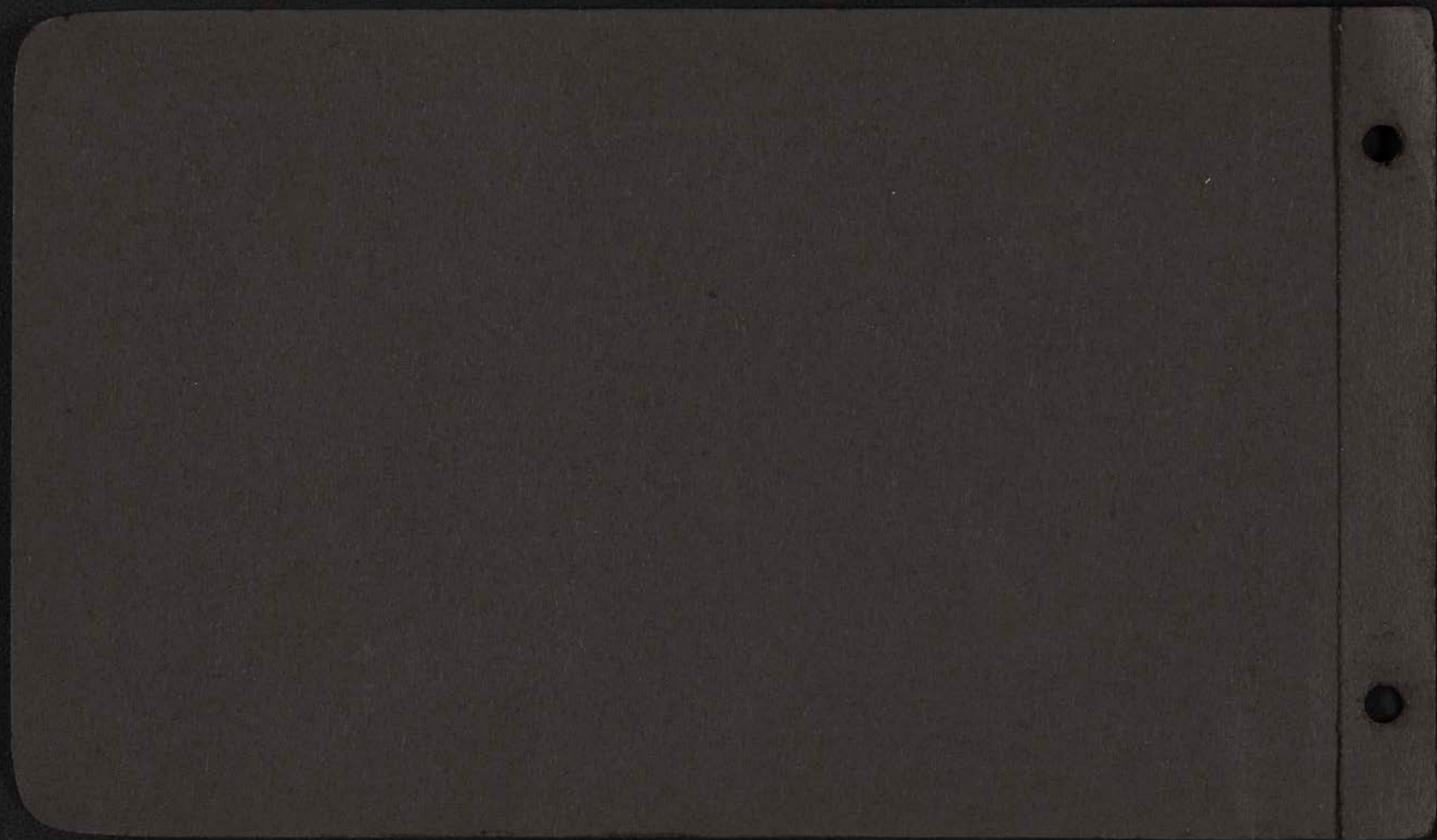

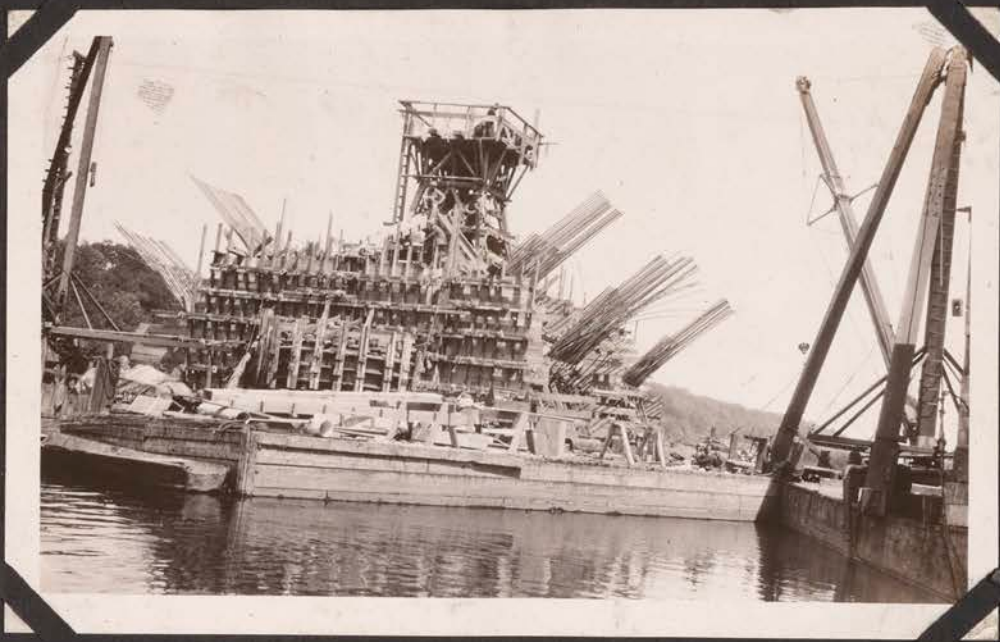

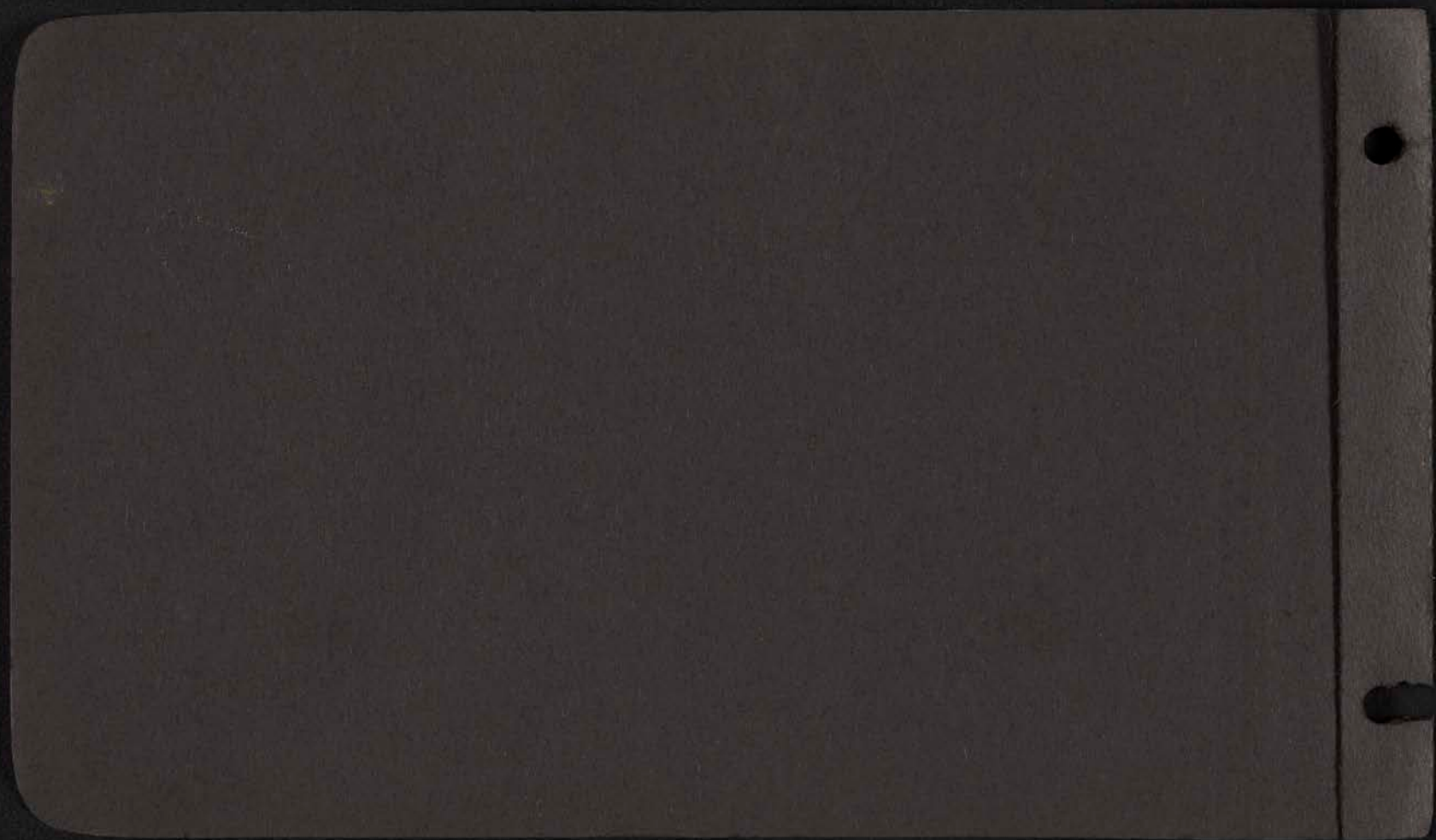


Sinking Caisson by Jetting



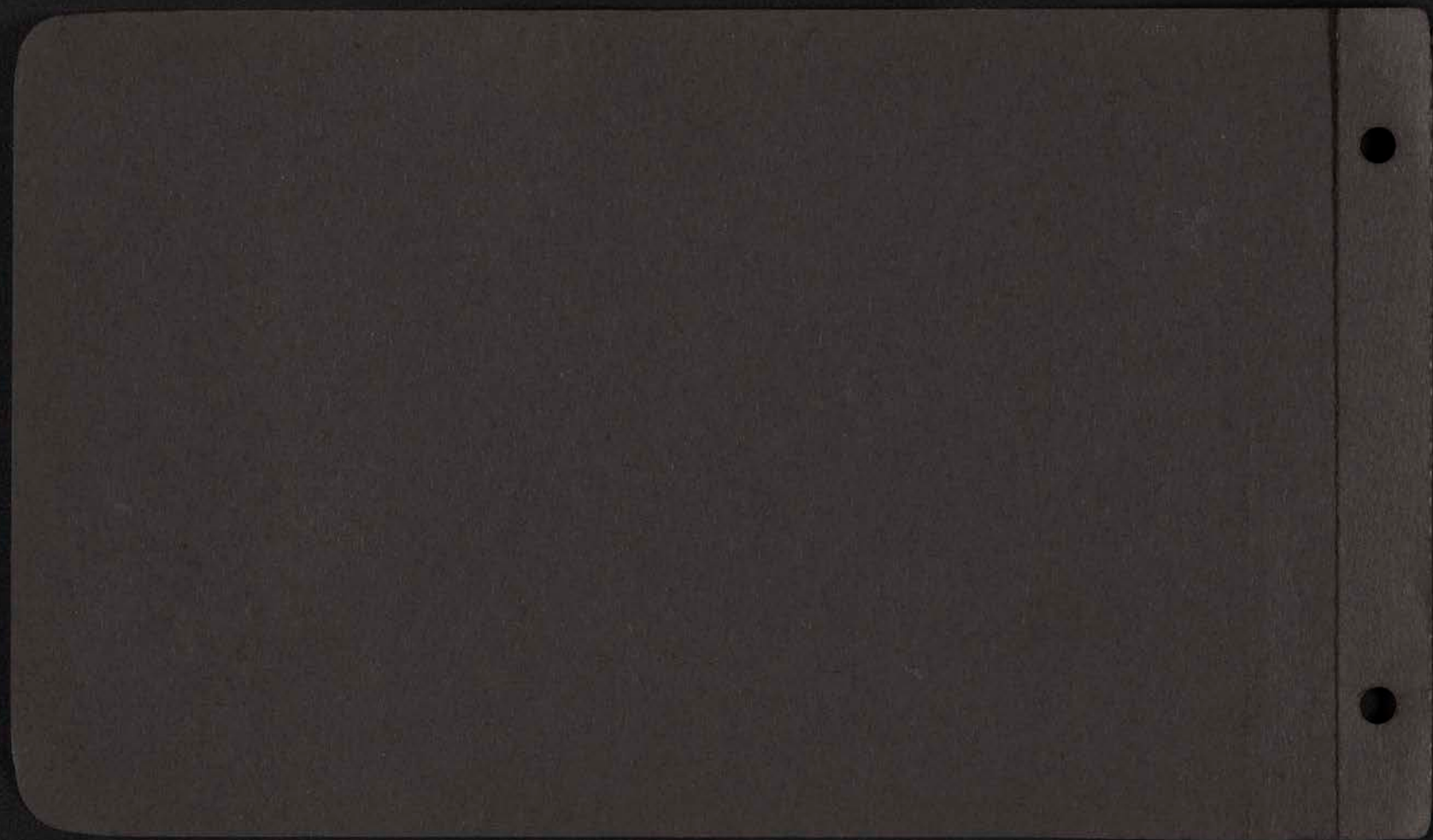

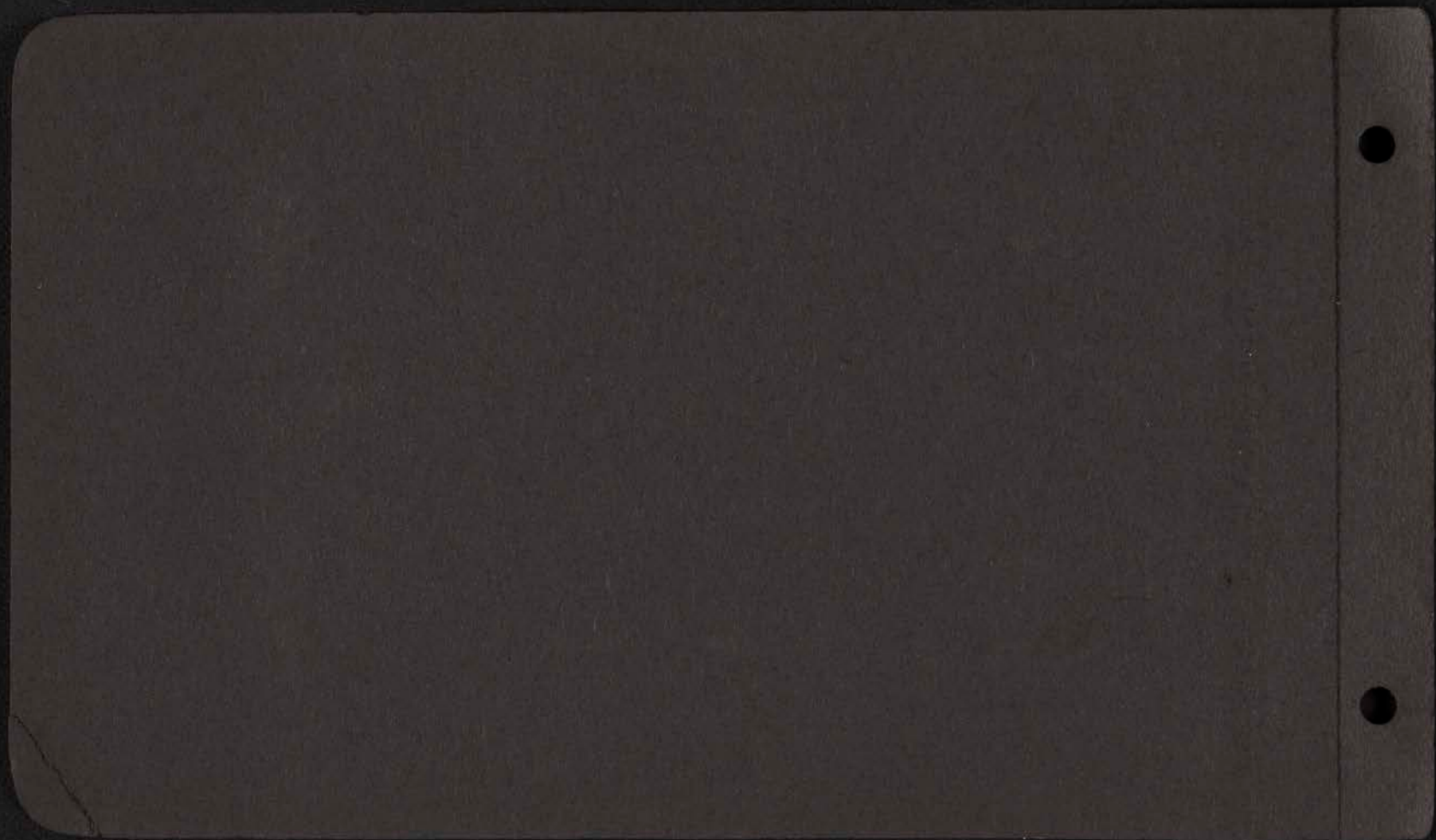

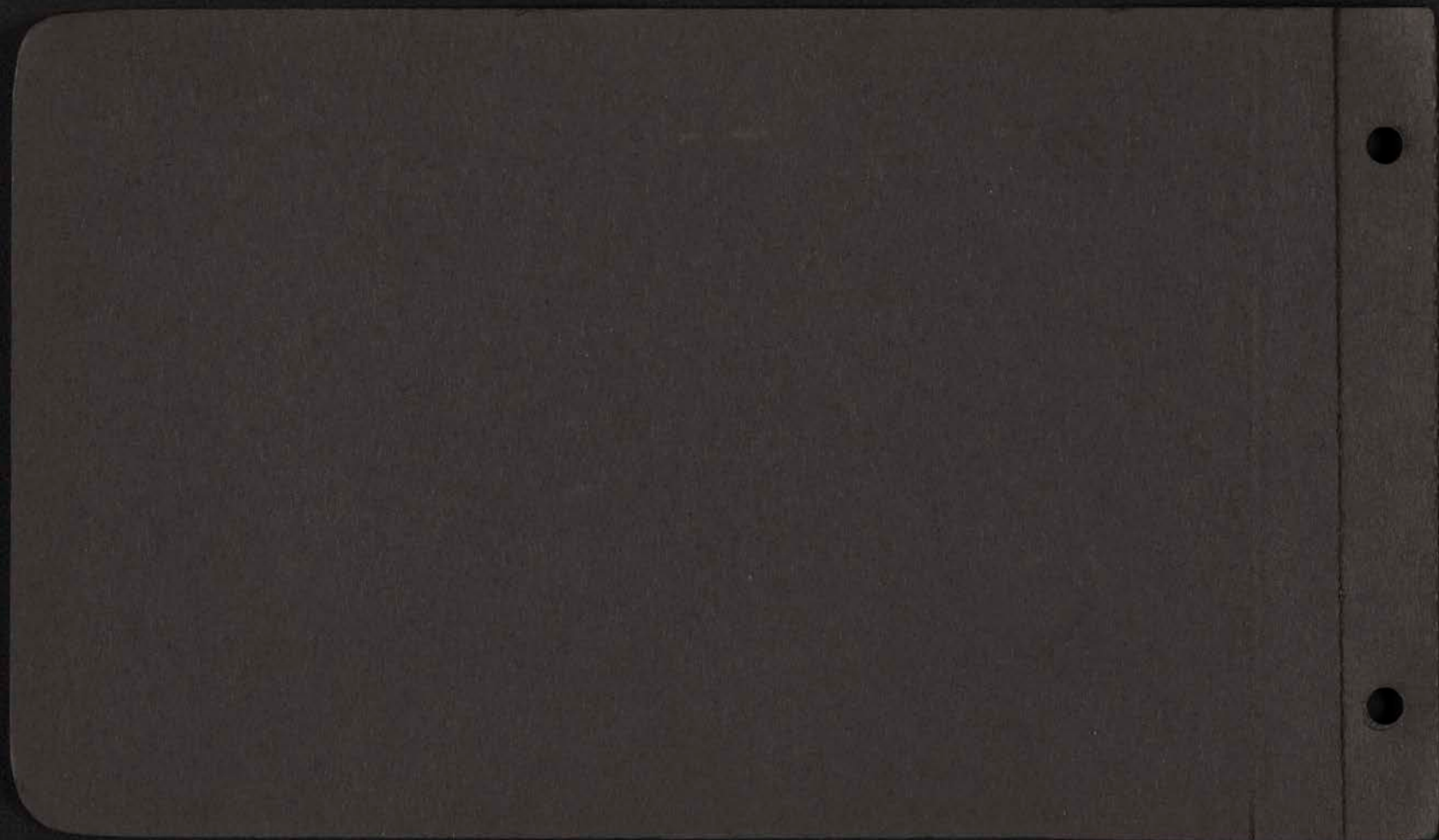

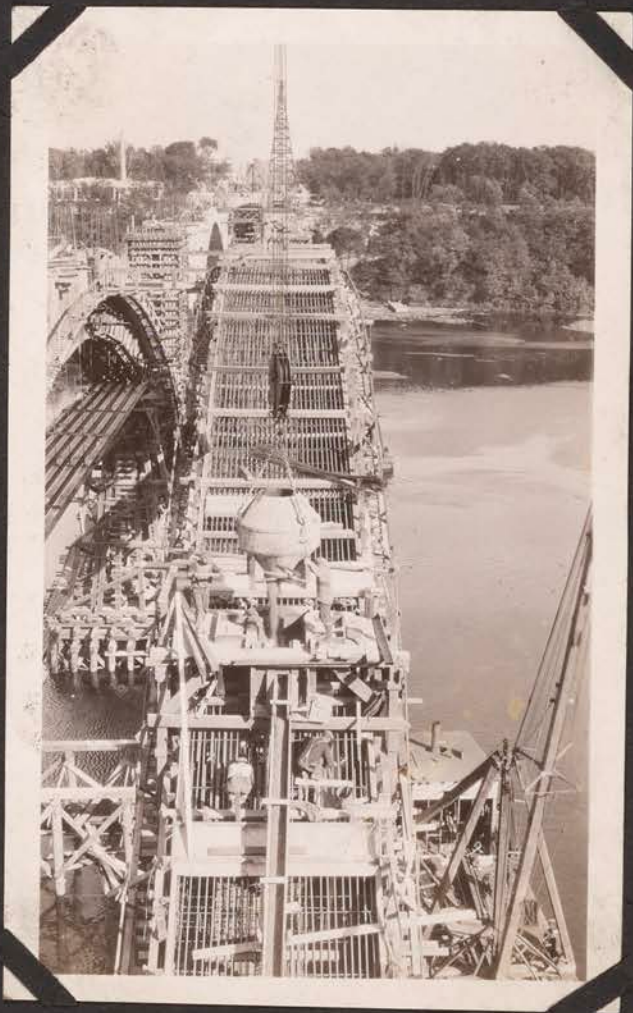

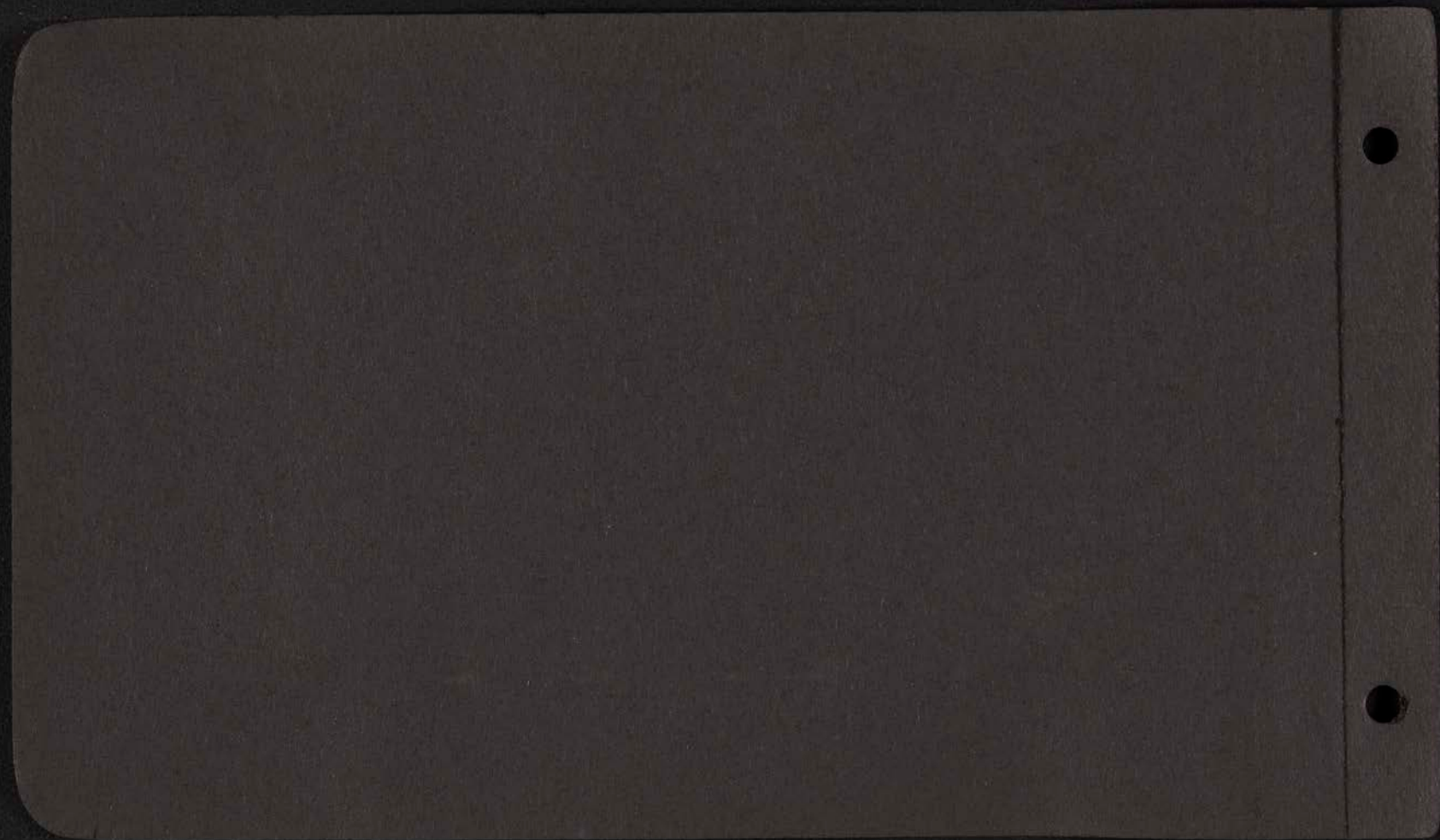

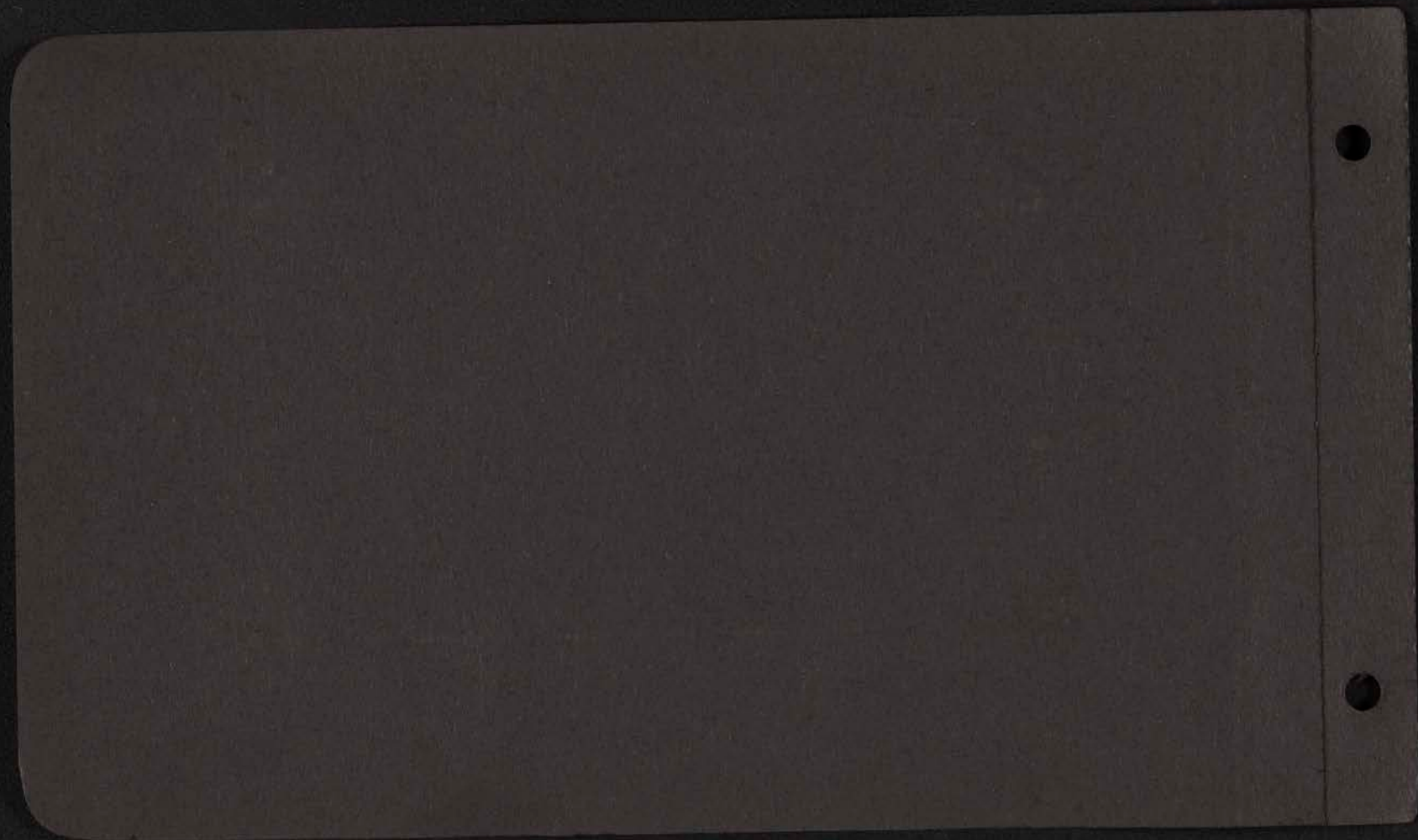

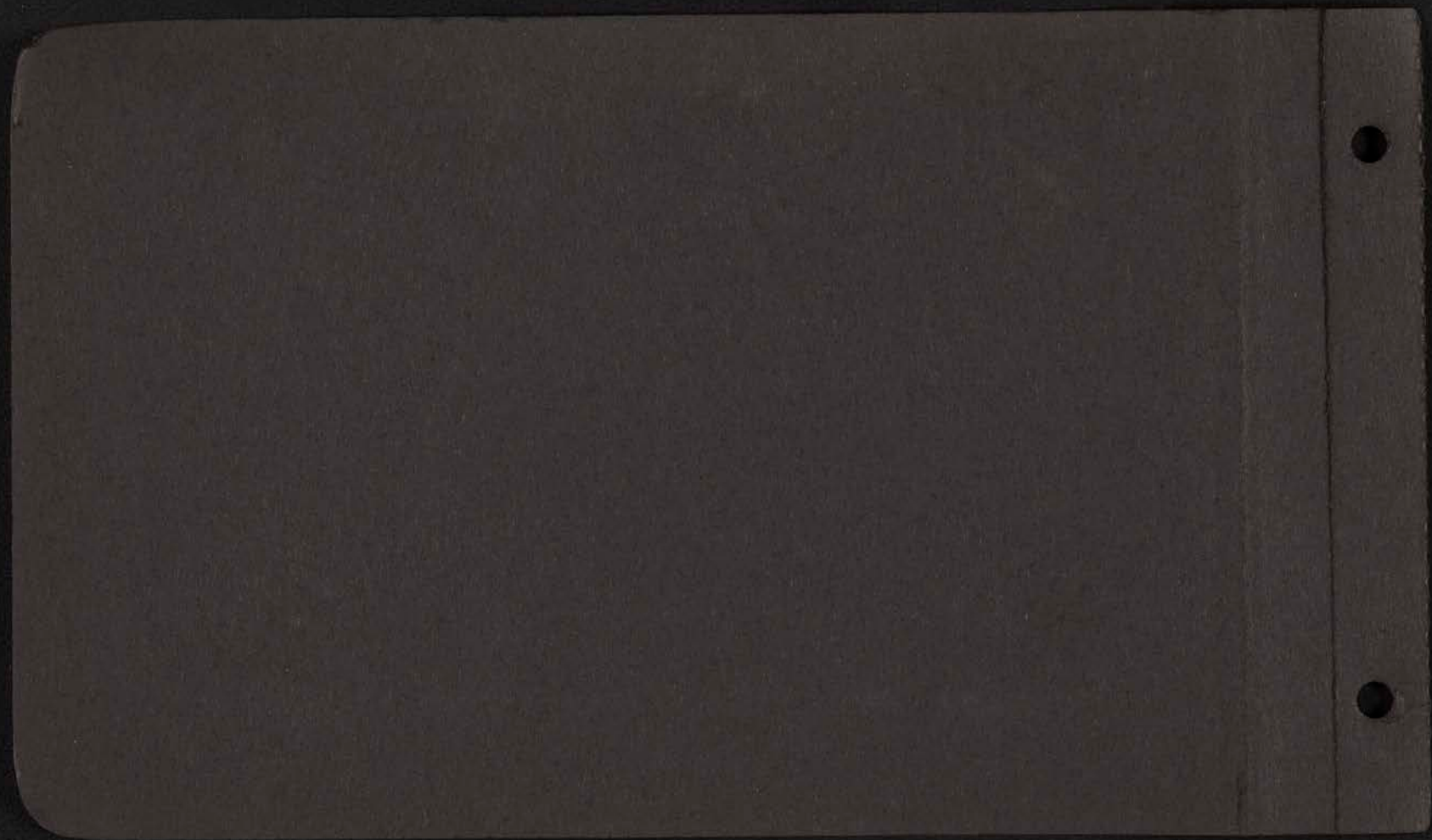
Typical Splice in Arch Rib Reinforcing.





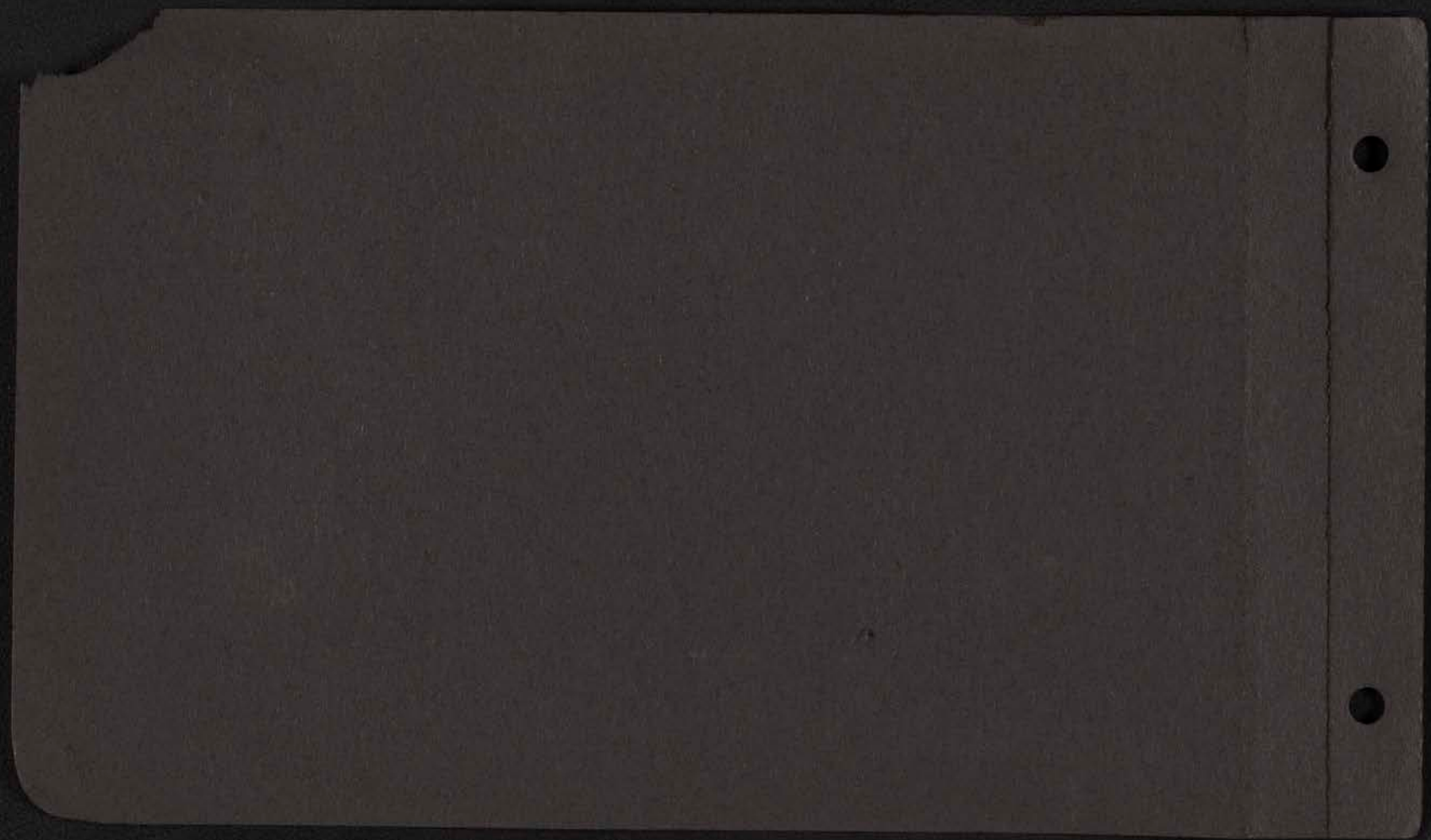

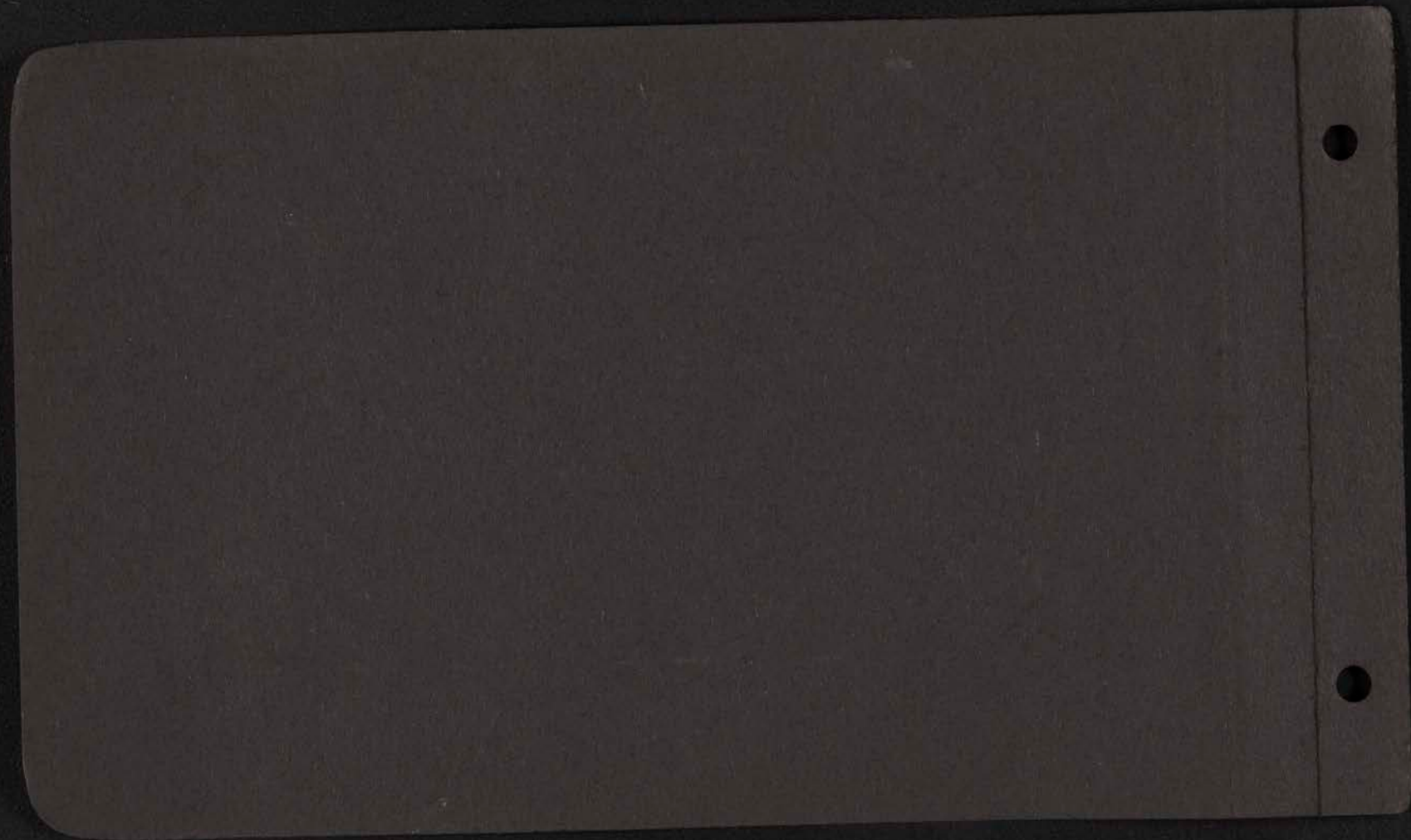


South Elev. Span 9   Ribs poured except Key Sections.

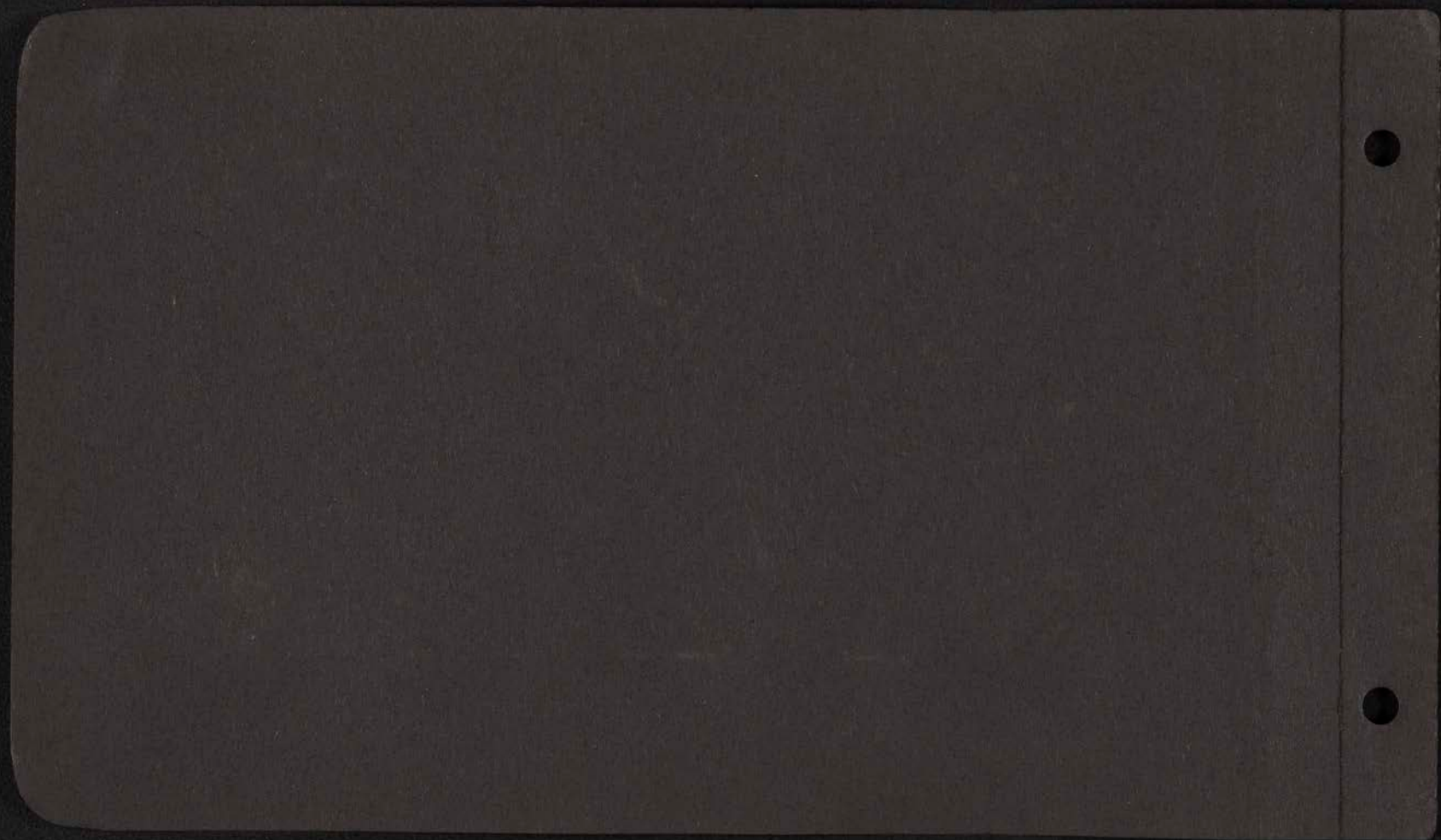


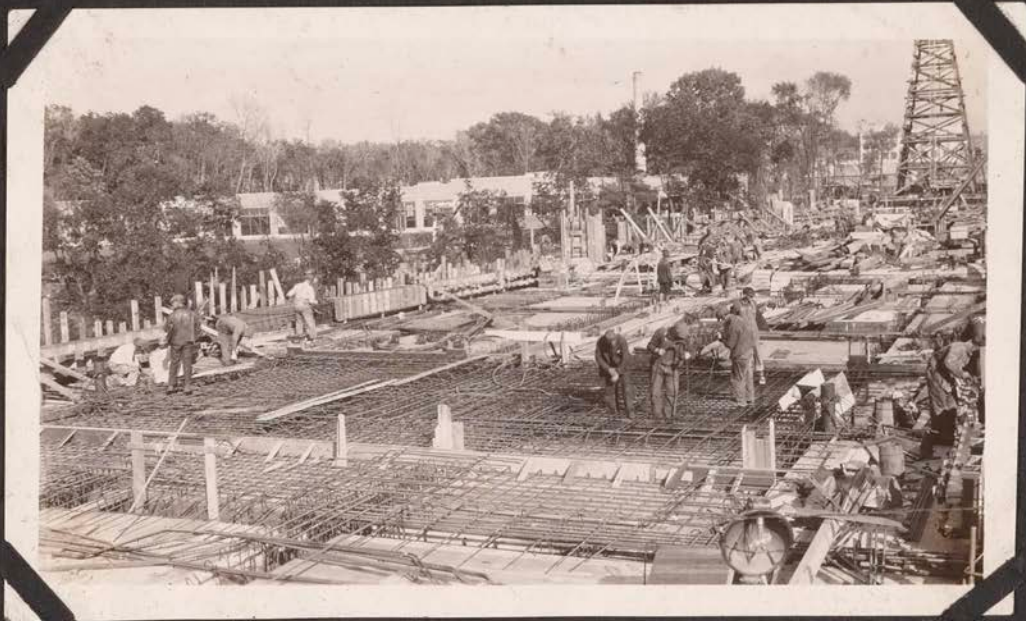
Lowering Steel Centering S. Rib Span 9.



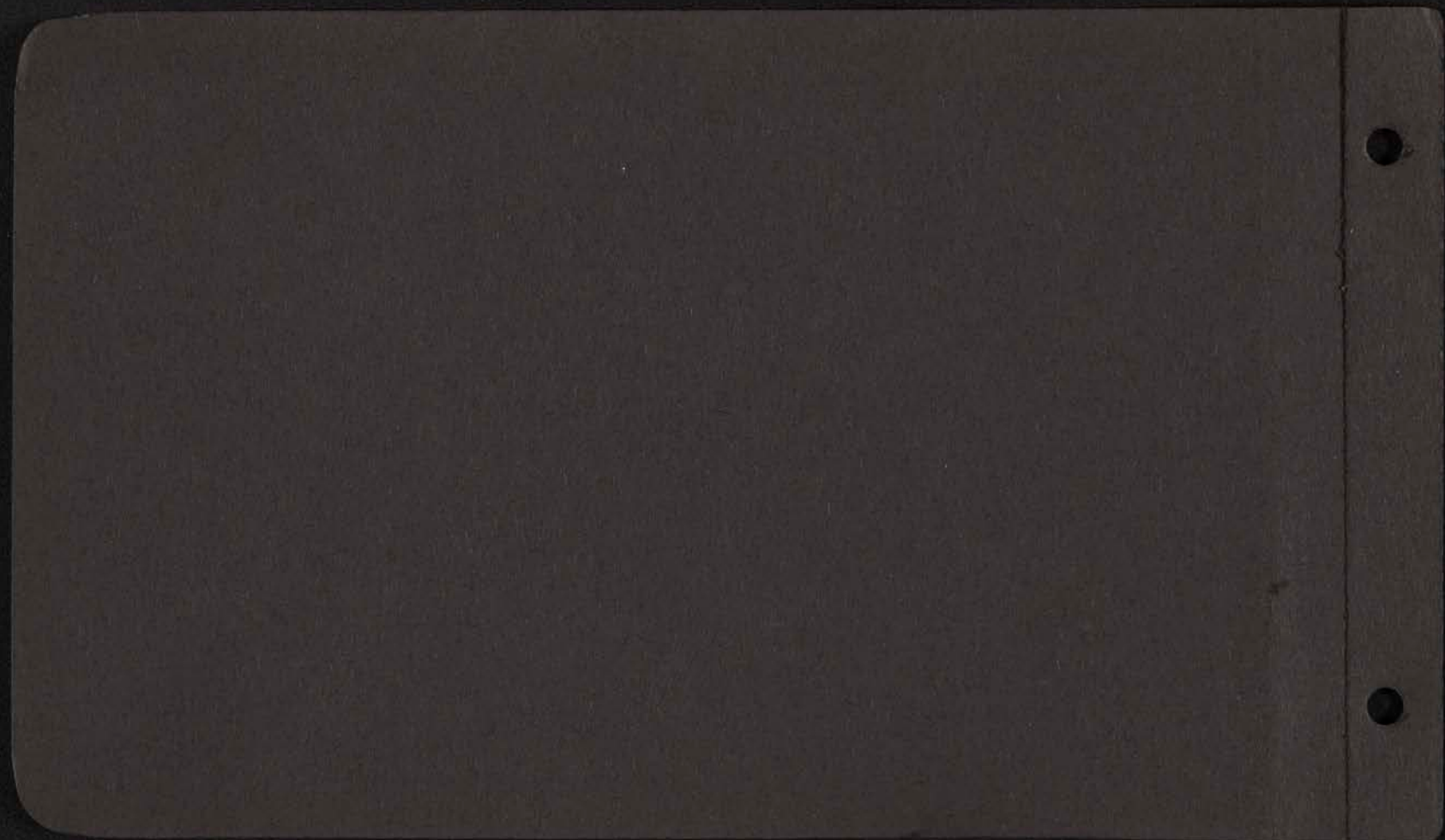


Northwest View of Ribs and Columns Span 8



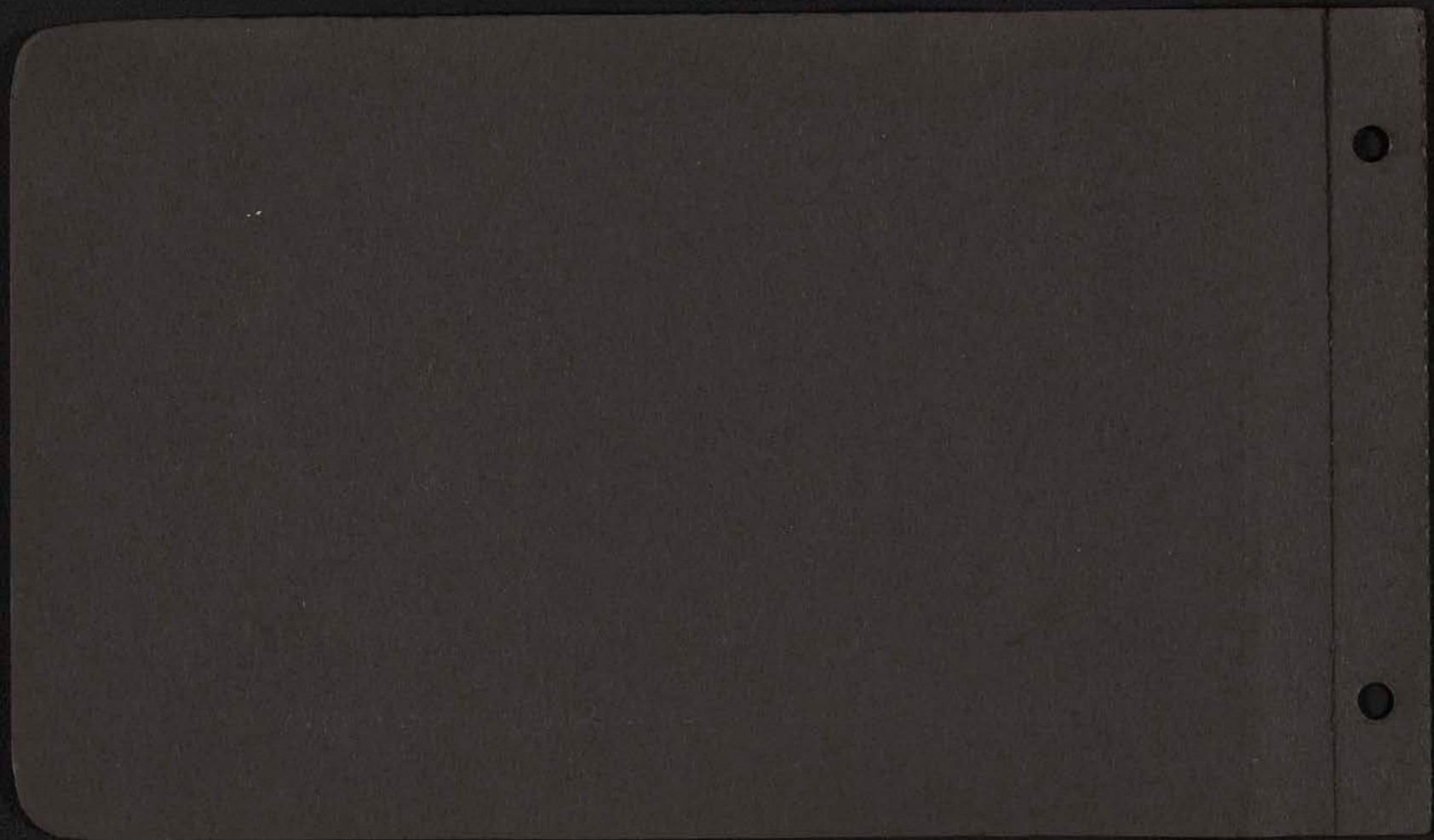


Typical Slab Reinforcing



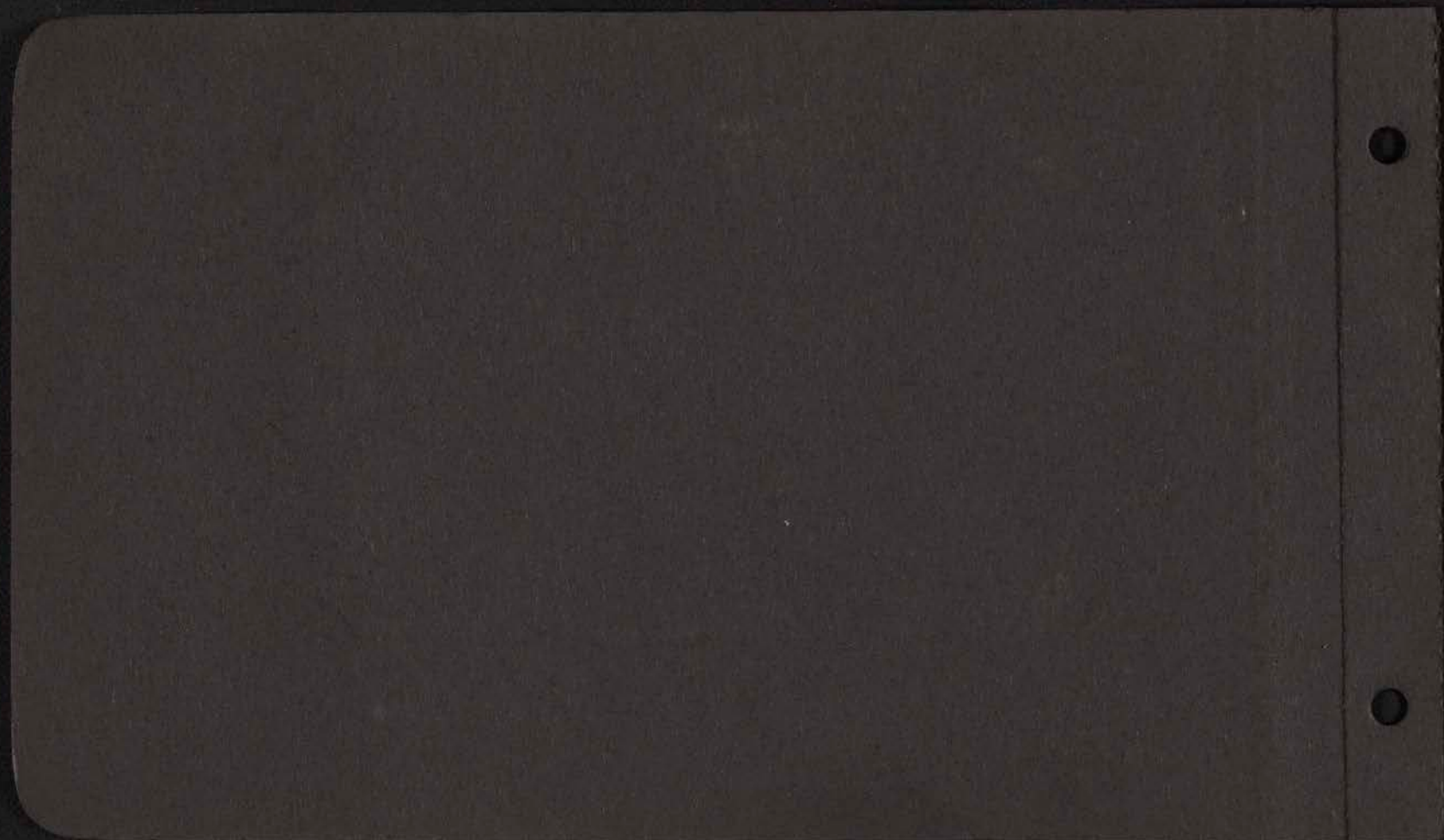


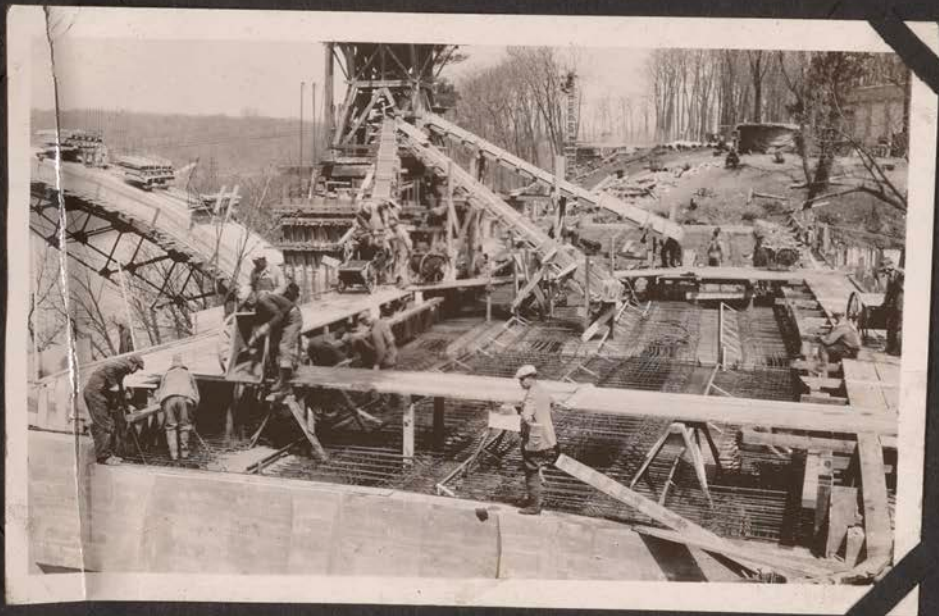

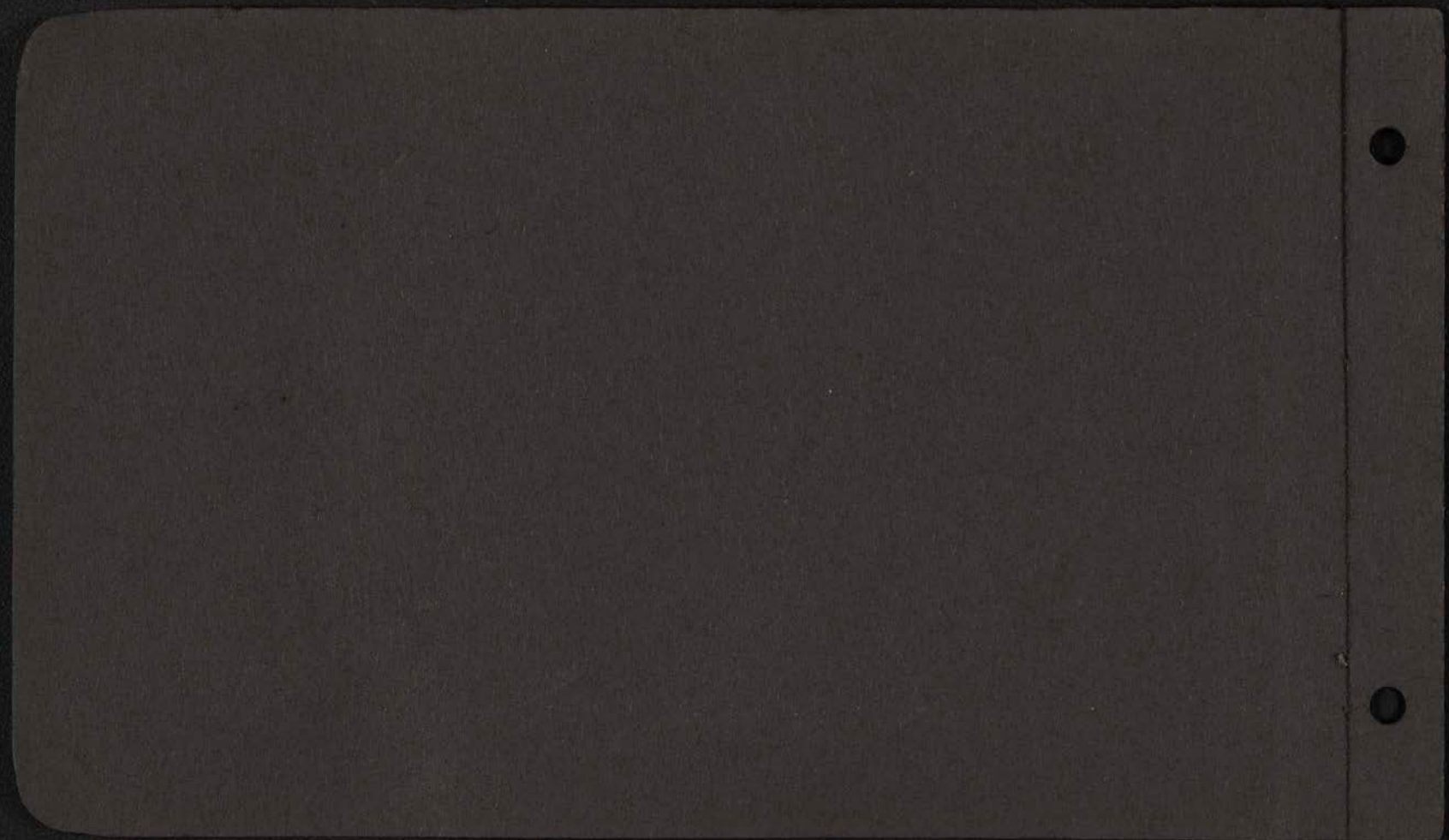


Building Forms For Under-Crossing Apr. 2, 1926.



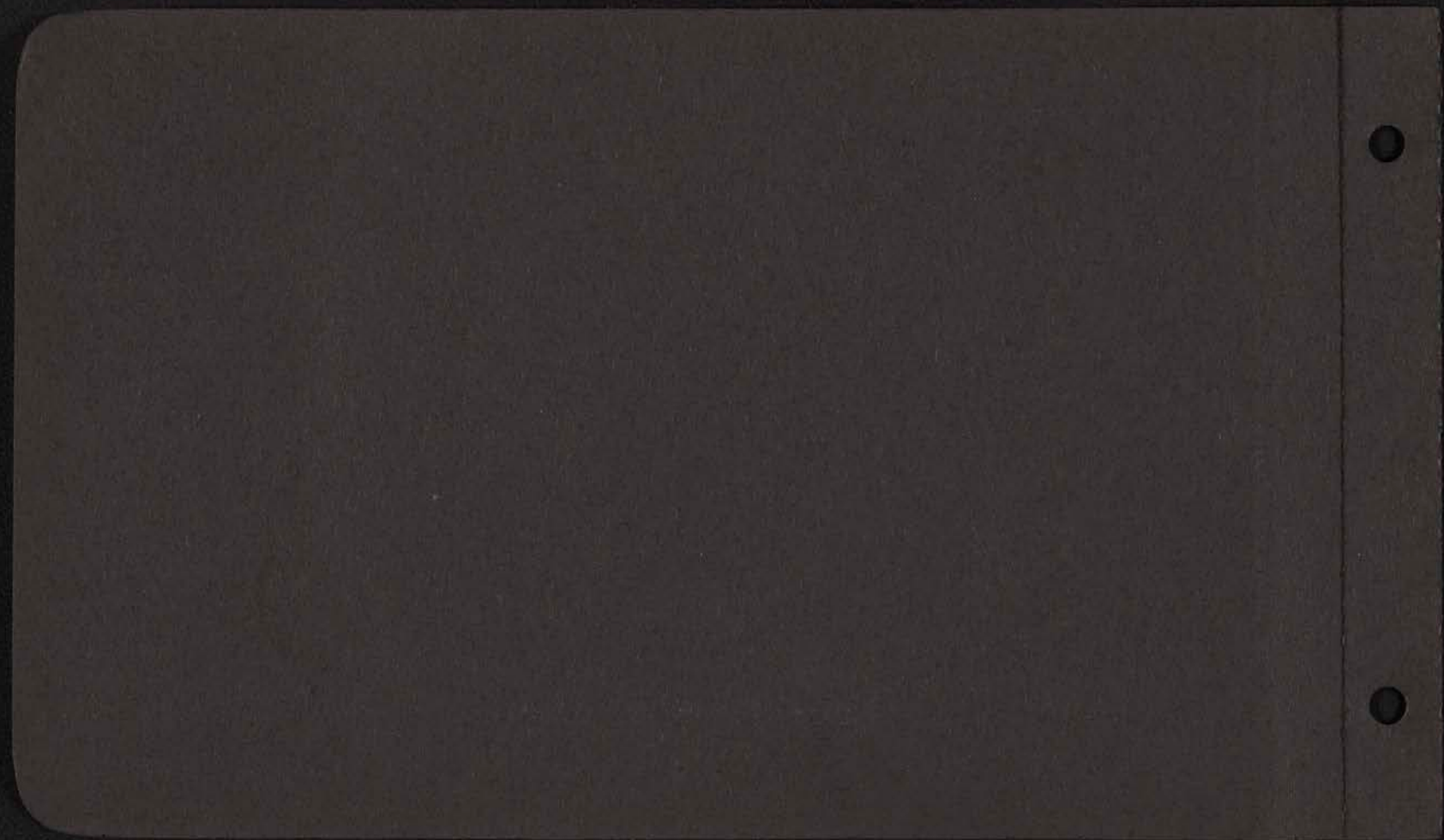


Pouring slab of Under Crossing      Apr. 29, 1926.



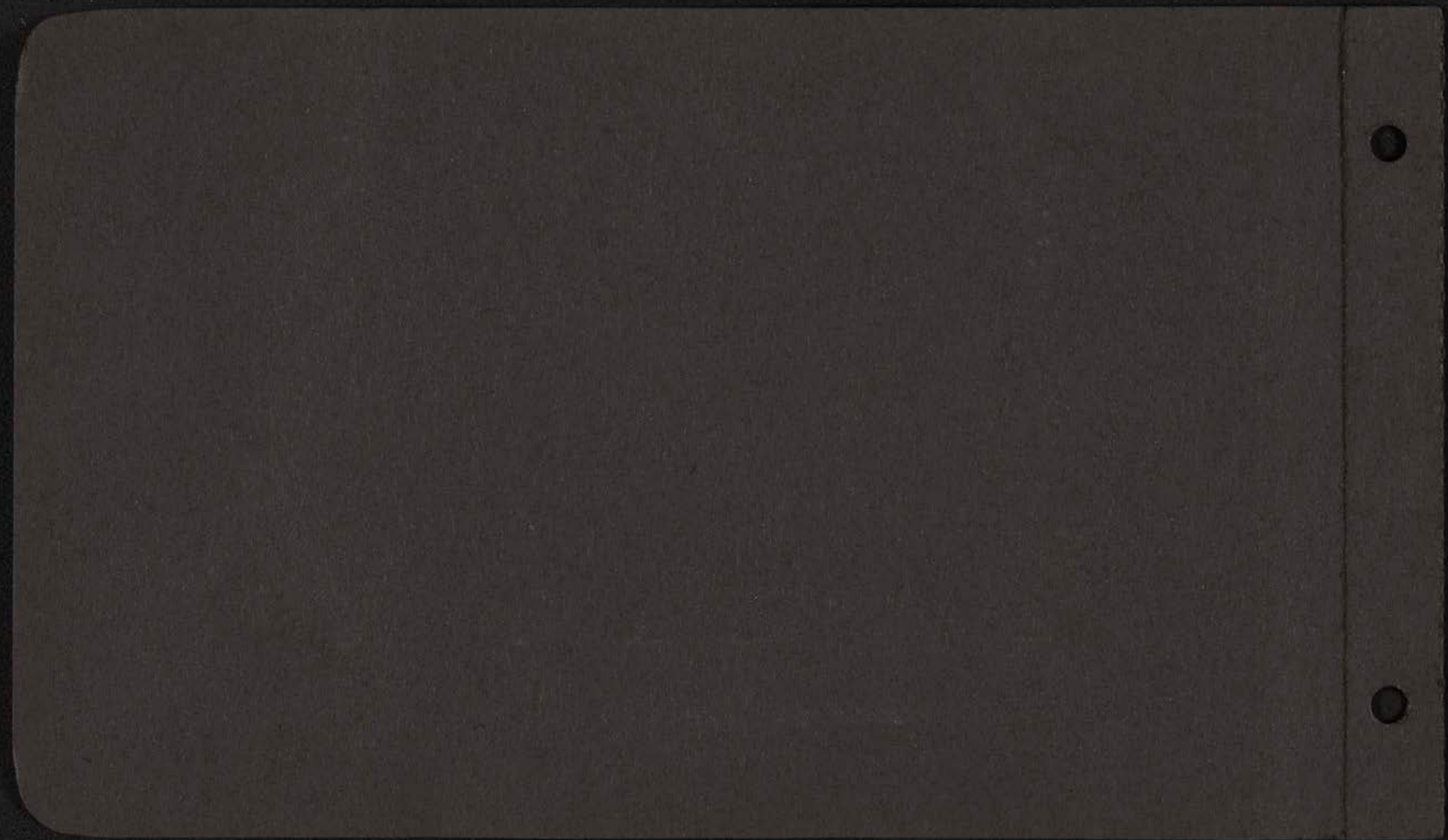

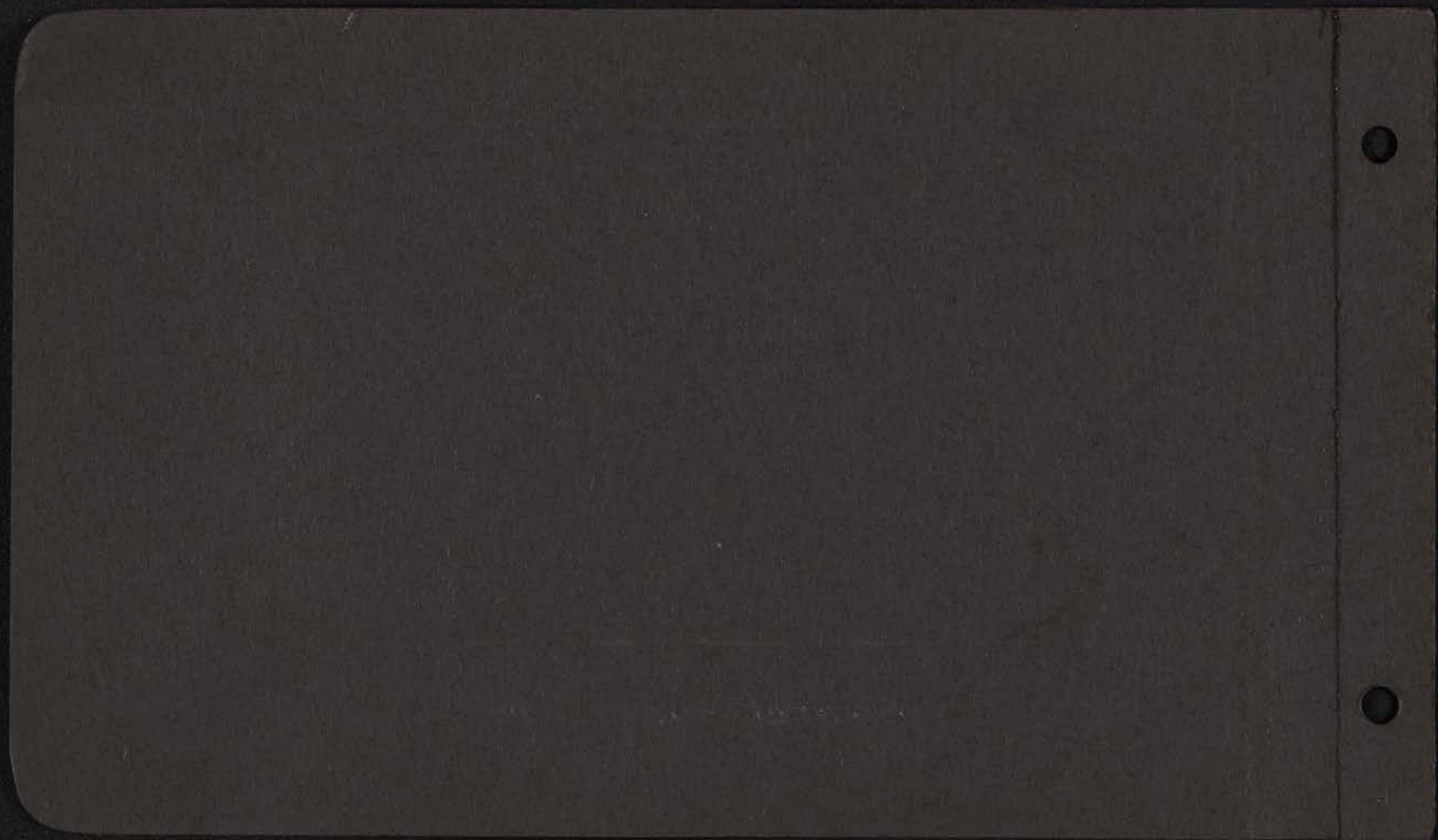


Godfrey Road Viaduct  
Building Forms for Railing.



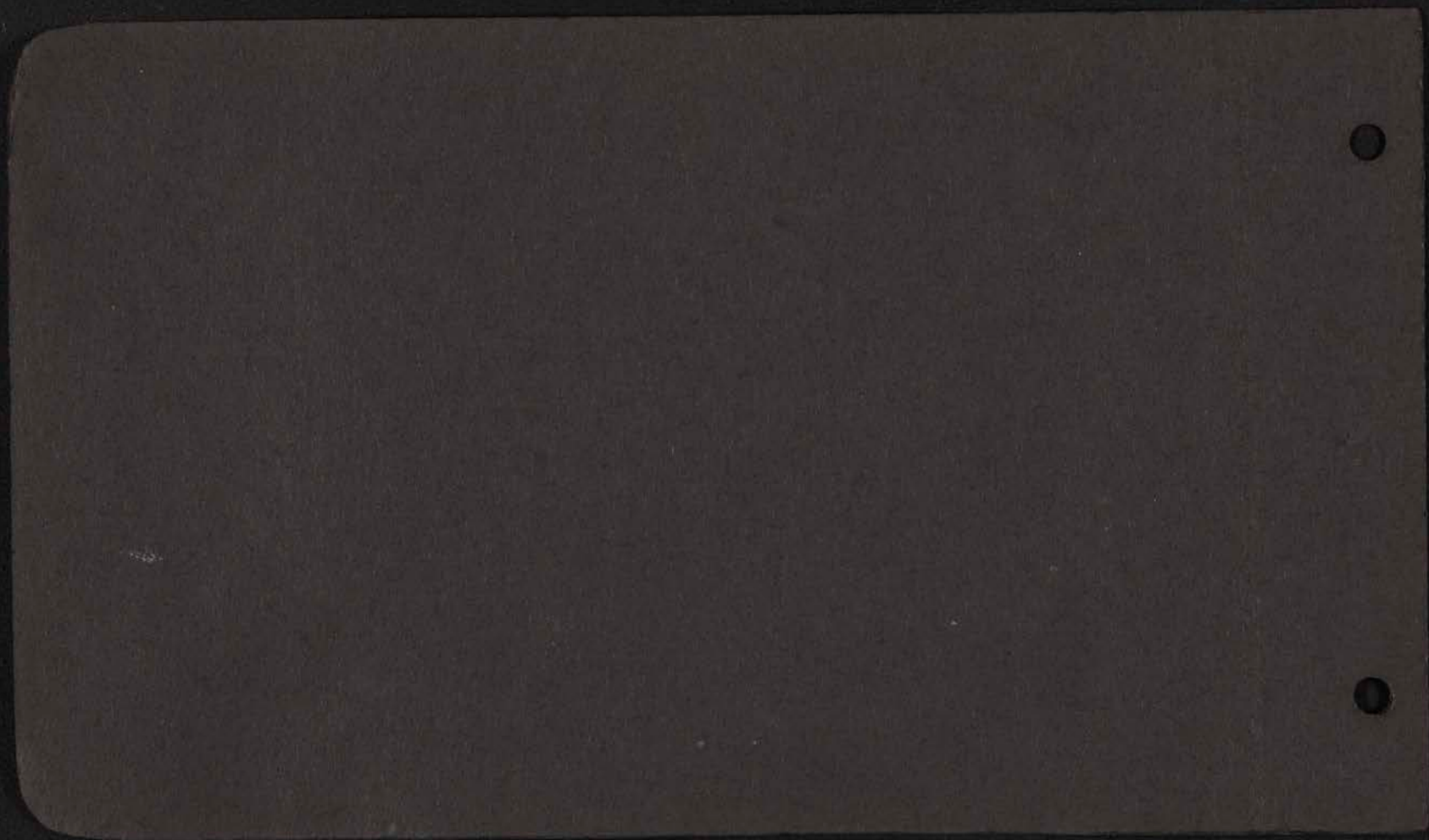


Godfrey Road Viaduct  
Rubbing Concrete Railing.



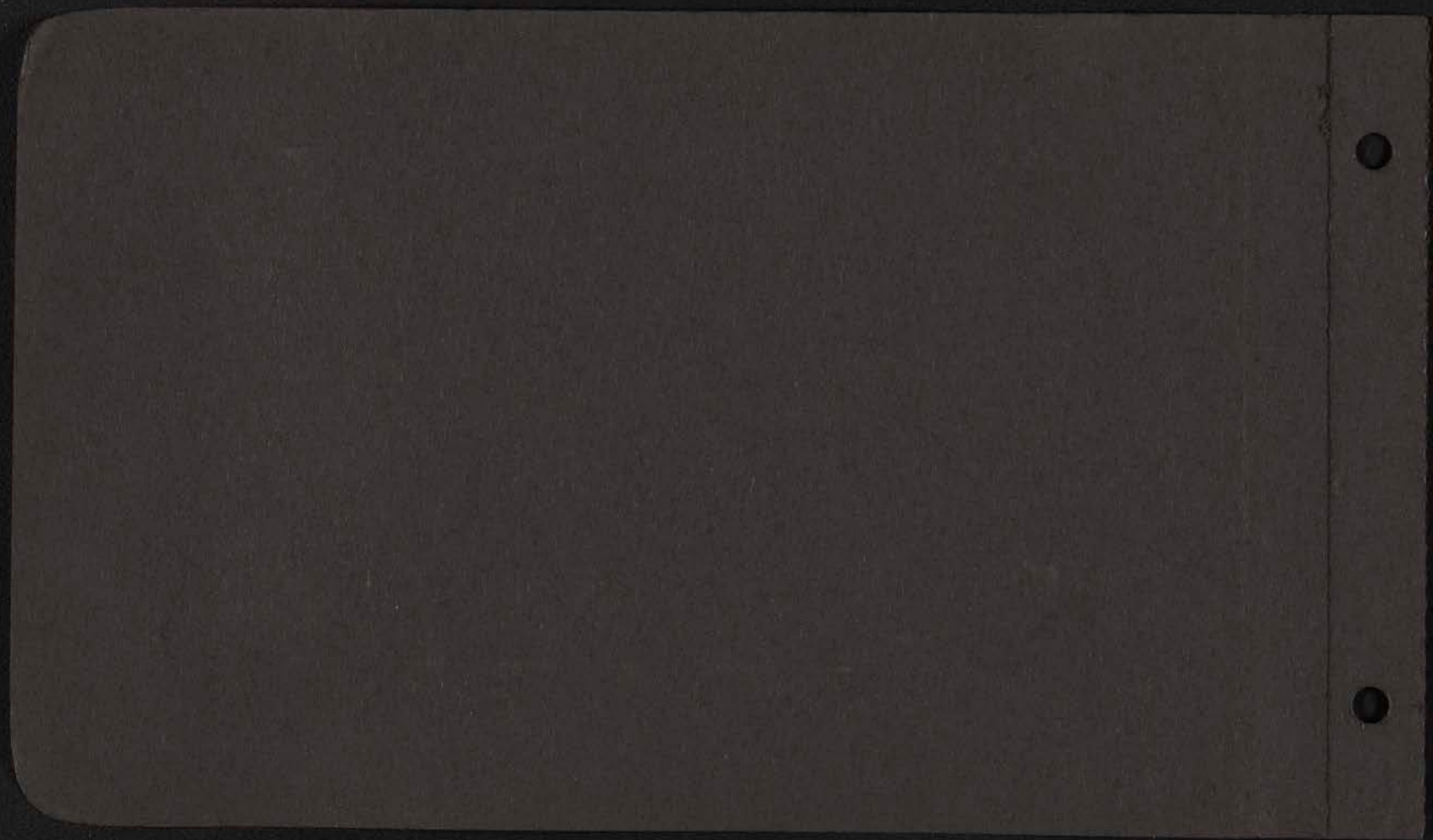

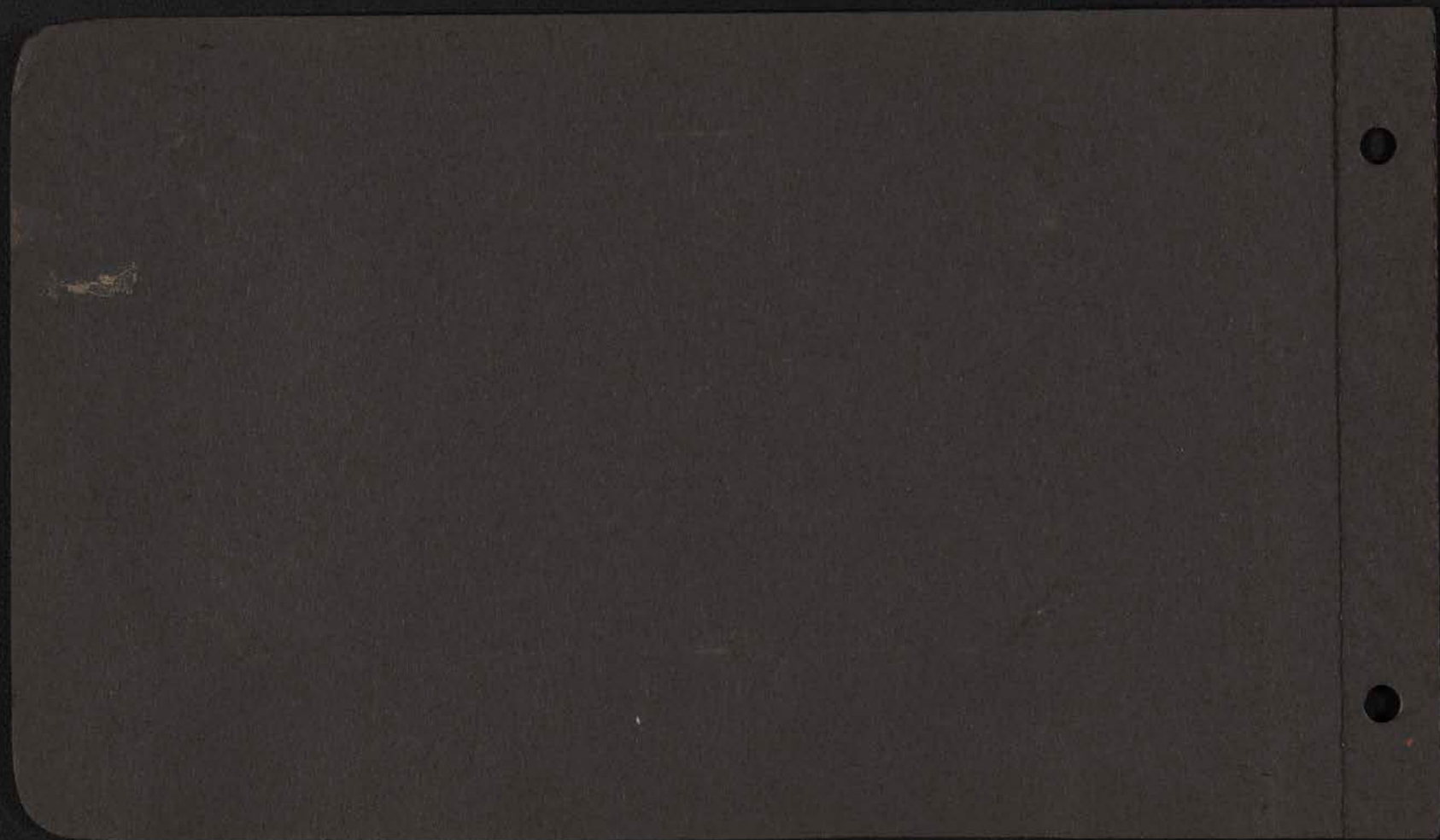

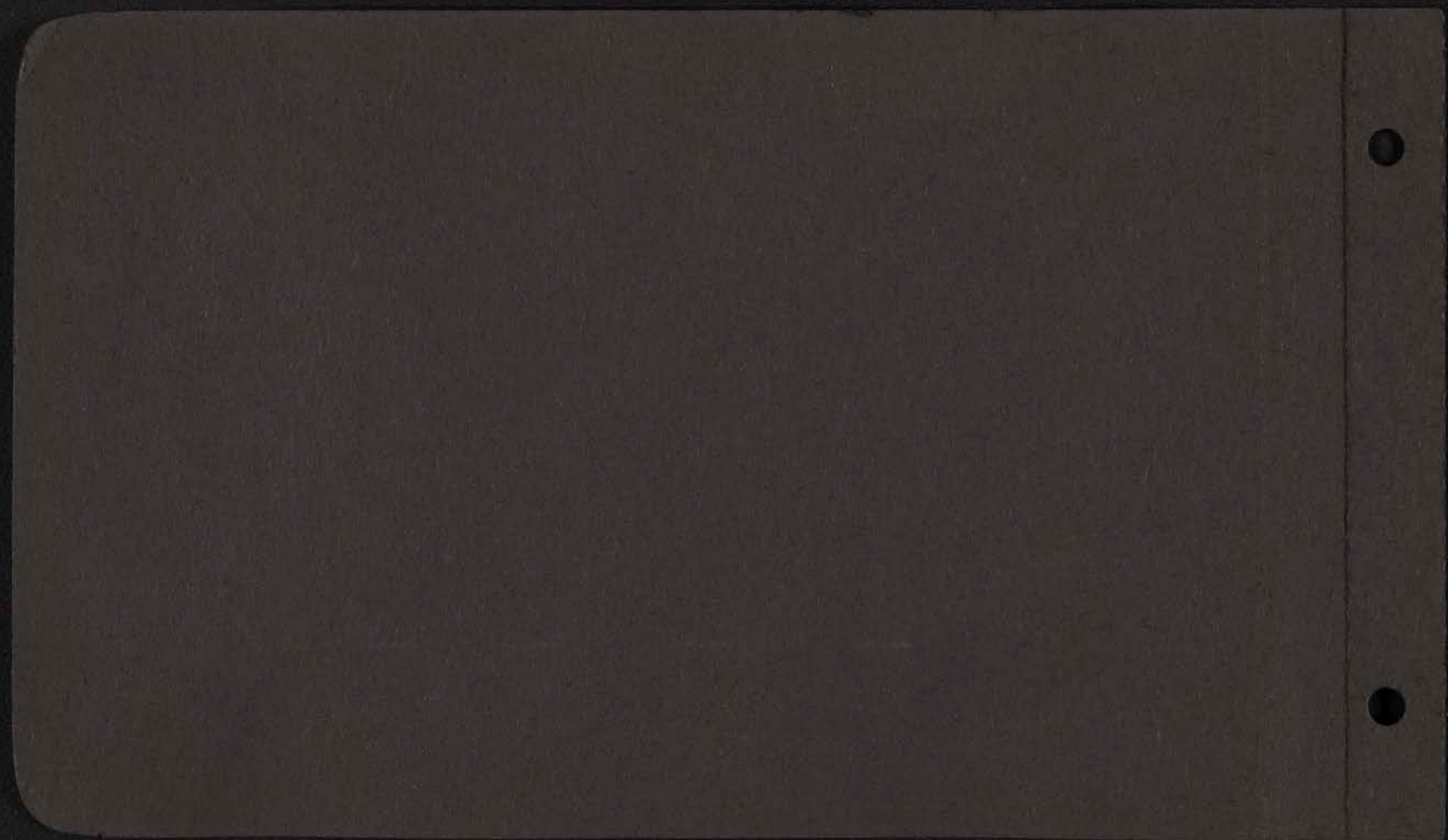

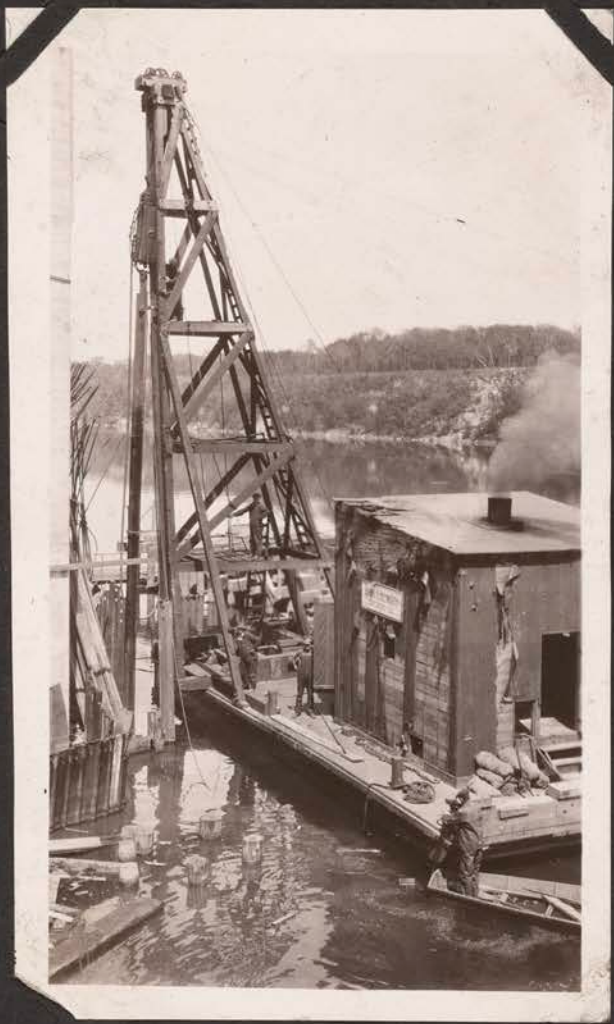

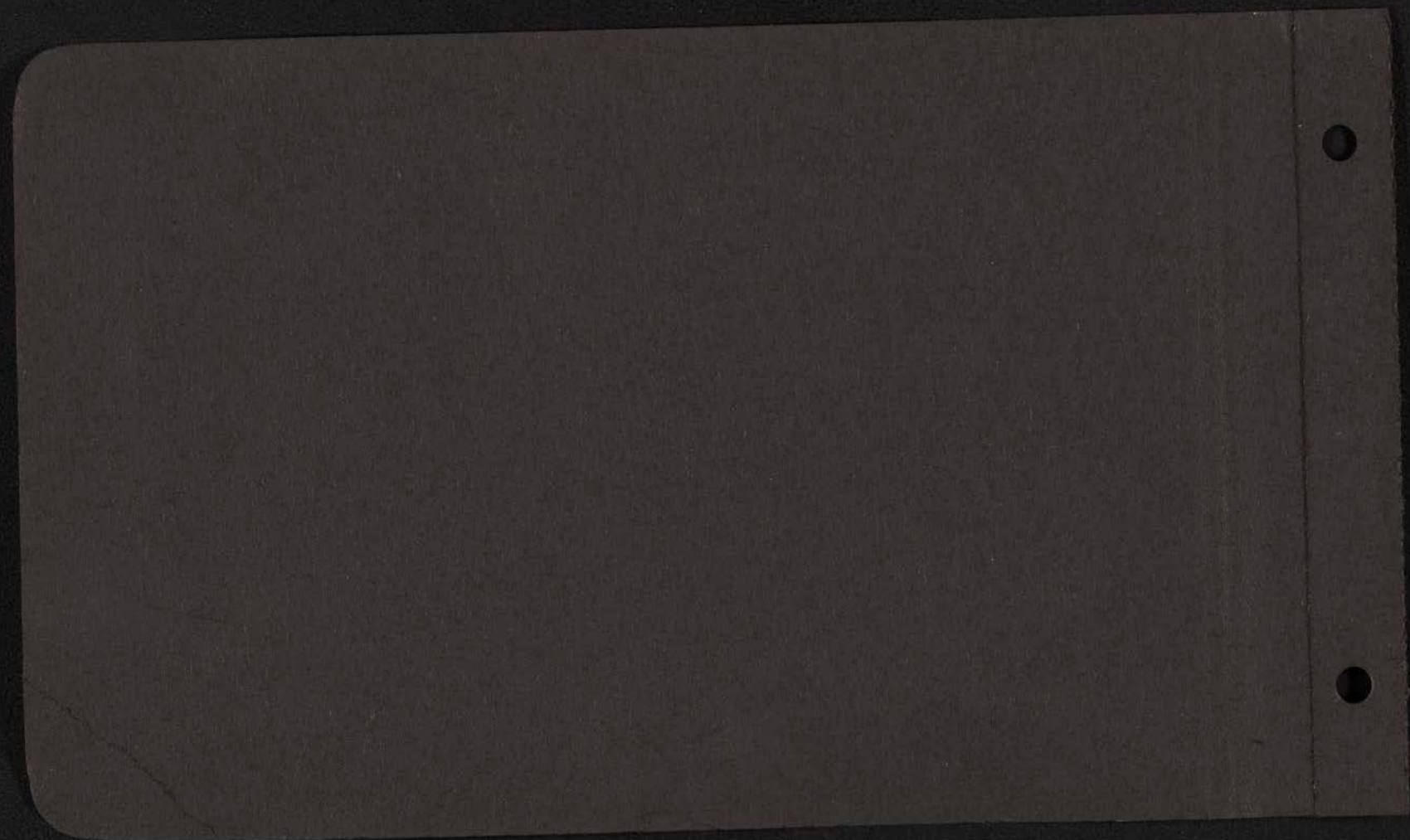


Concrete Chute

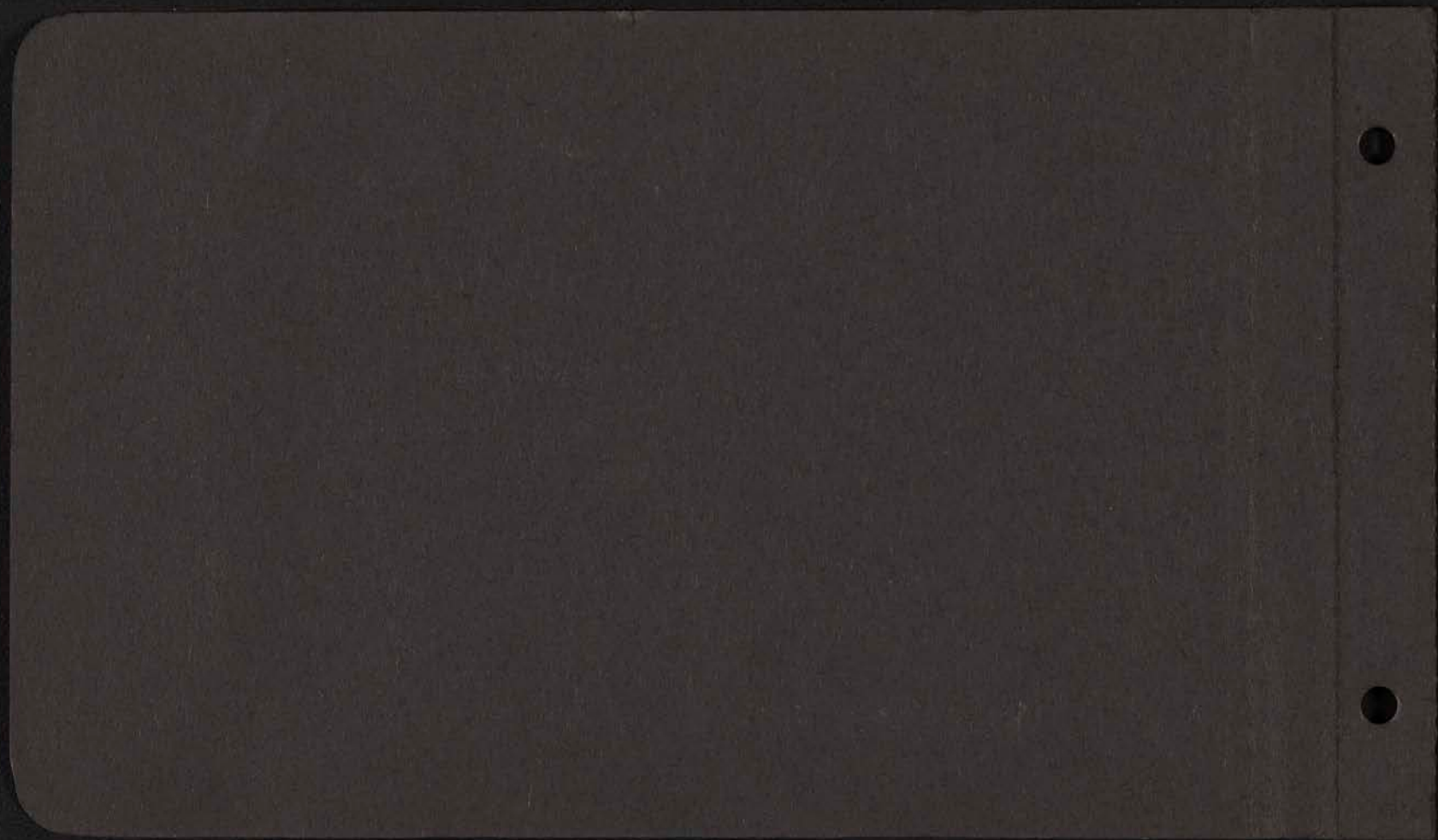

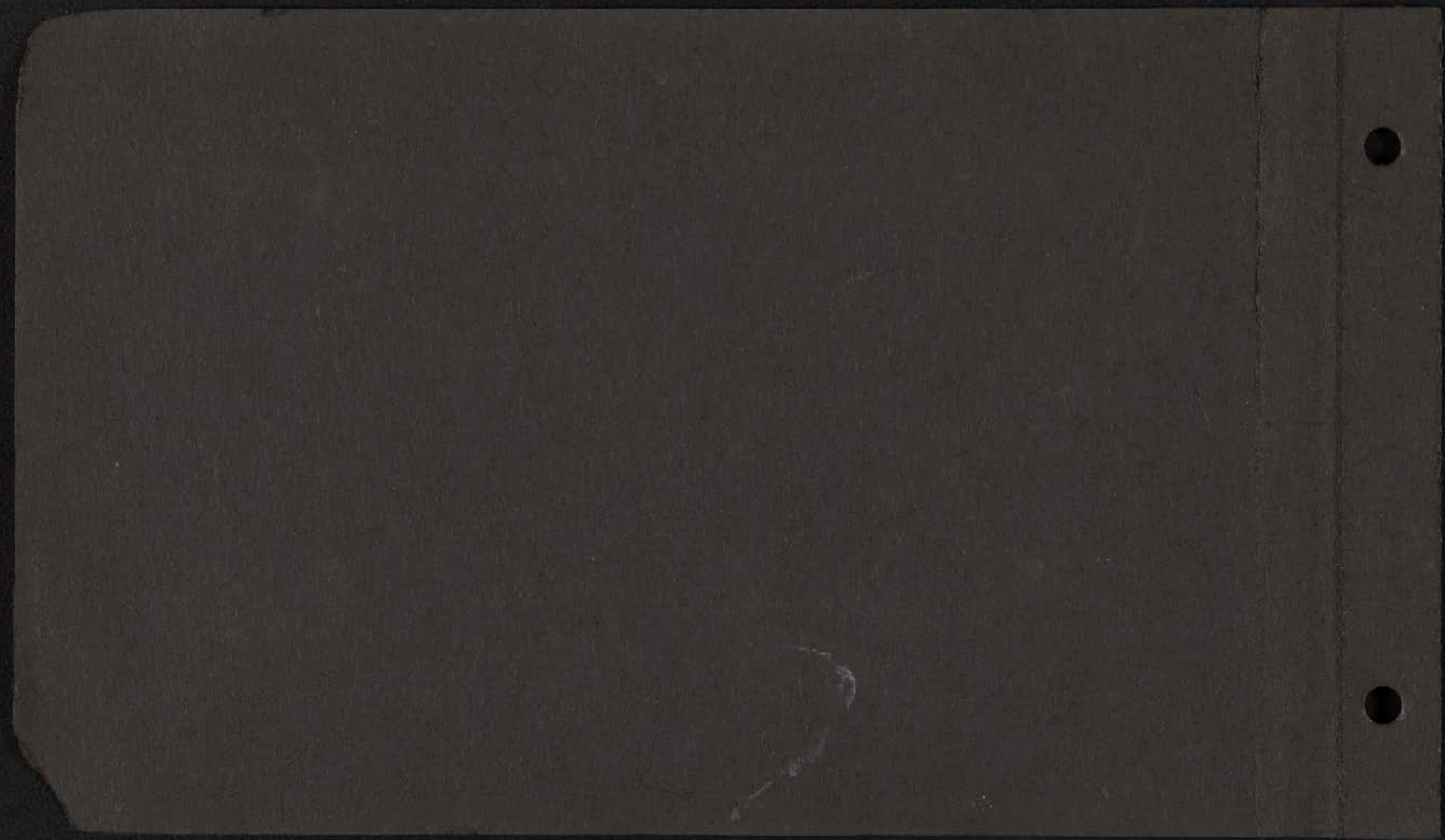
