



CHOOSING YOUR GLUE

There are a number of glues you can use. UHU Por is the best option, but you can also use superglue with an accelerator or even PVA, but this will take a long time to dry.



USING SUPERGLUE

Apply glue to one surface of the styrofoam, give the other surface a squirt of accelerator and hold the two surfaces together. The bond will be rapid and give you a quick and firm joint.



USING UHU POR

UHU Por is a contact adhesive. Put the glue on one edge of the styrofoam, bring the two pieces together, then pull them apart. Wait until the glue becomes tacky, a minute or so, then bring the two pieces together. Push down firmly to form a strong bond.



USING PVA GLUE

Apply PVA to one edge of the styrofoam. Hold the styrofoam in place and push together for a few moments until a bond is achieved. The PVA will take a few hours to fully cure.
