CITY OF MOSINEE NEWS

During the July 12, 2021, meeting, the City's Common Council approved the Final Plat and related development agreement for the Jackson Woods Subdivision that will be located on the existing 7.66-acre vacant parcel that is located on the north side of Oconto Road and west of Golden Hawk Way. The developer will be establishing nineteen (19) lot single-family residential lots on the parcel and construction of the subdivision will likely begin later this summer.

Also at the July 12, 2021, meeting, the Common Council approved a request from the Pine Traveler to establish a seasonal parklet on Third Street next to their building located at 224 Main Street. The parklet will provide space for picnic tables, benches, and outdoor musical entertainment. The Common Council also tentatively (subject to formal permit approval), approved a request from the Pine Traveler to temporarily closed Third Street next to their building for a special music event that will be held in conjunction with this year's Little Bull Falls LogJam Festival that will be held from August 13th to 15th.
