Available Cases - Selected Case in Bold

1. *Testing Differences: Stowerbury Metals Ltd v Metronical Products Ltd* February 2026
A small commercial dispute is an exercise designed to test basic principles in mediation as a means of preserving and enhancing commercial relationships. Suitable for all. For 3-7 participants.
2. *Asparagrass: Gevblates v Willowgrant Farm* February 2026
Low-value commercial dispute, focusing on mediation's potential to preserve a commercial relationship. Suitable for all. For 3-5 participants.
3. *Community Chest: Harold Court Community Group and the Local Authority* February 2026
This is a community dispute with competing interests between participating stakeholders. Suitable for all. For 4 participants.
4. *Anniversary Blues: Staples v Minsantino Hotels* February 2026
A mediation about a consumer dispute - loss of enjoyment and personal factors. Suitable for all. For 3-7 participants.
5. *Extending No. 10: Brown v Quality Extensions* February 2026
A mediation about a domestic construction contract and payments - with additional factors - suitable for all. For 3-8 participants.
6. *Farmyard Spats: Screeside Farms - The Poulterers* February 2026
A farming partnership and family mediation with commercial and property aspects - complex. For 5-12 participants.
7. *Falcon: Falcon Consulting and Macadam* February 2026
A commercial mediation - dispute about construction contract and payments - suitable for all. For 3-5 participants.
8. *Gated Developments: Green v Hopper* February 2026
A neighbour dispute mediation - property access with personal factors - suitable for all. For 3-7 participants.
9. *High Trees: Colabriot and Mr & Mrs Holden* February 2026
A commercial mediation - property valuation dispute - suitable for all. For up to 5 participants.
10. *Black's News: Black and Baker* February 2026
A commercial mediation - business sale valuation dispute - suitable for all. For up to 3-5 participants.
11. *The Burning Boat: Sammy and Frankie* February 2026
A dispute between former friends - suitable for all. For up to 5 participants.

12. *The Greenbank Case*: Hugh Rowles and Bestys Ltd February 2026
A small commercial IT mediation - software delivery issue, withheld payments - suitable for all.
For up to 3-7 participants.
13. *Brazanian Telecommunications*: Brazania Telecoms and Billco March 2026
A substantial telecoms commercial dispute - more complex
For 3 participants plus representatives.
14. *All at Sea*: Lempton Properties International plc and Pavlovic Charter Packages April 2026
A commercial mediation with personal relationships - more complex
For up to 5 participants.
15. *Hidden Costs*: Sunscape Enterprise plc and Drakenby Services LLP May 2026
A mediation of a construction dispute involving competing claims for delay and disruption, and contested variations. More complex. For 3 participants.
16. *Where there's a will*: Re: The estate of Robert Gaffity, deceased June 2026
Mediation of a family business dispute involving will trusts. More complex.
For up to 5-9 participants.
17. *The Island Healcase Coverings and Lasrena Construction* July 2026
Mediation of a construction dispute over delay and disruption. Suitable for all.
For 3 participants.
18. *Malcontent Towers*: Capo Siciliano and Goodenough Clark August 2026
Mediation of a professional negligence claim - suitable for all.
For 4-5 participants.
19. *A Fish Stew!* The Mishra Nana family. September 2026
A mediation of a family business dispute - suitable for all.
For 3-5 participants.
20. *Holding Tight*: Cawston Induction and Alain Charont October 2026
Mediation of an employment dispute - suitable for all
For 4 participants.
21. *Re SBL Toolbox*: CES Systems and Number Faith November 2026
Commercial Mediation Exercise for advanced training, with difficult issues of confidentiality arising.
