Use this framework to map out your potential board members and ensure you have comprehensive coverage across all key areas of NIL.

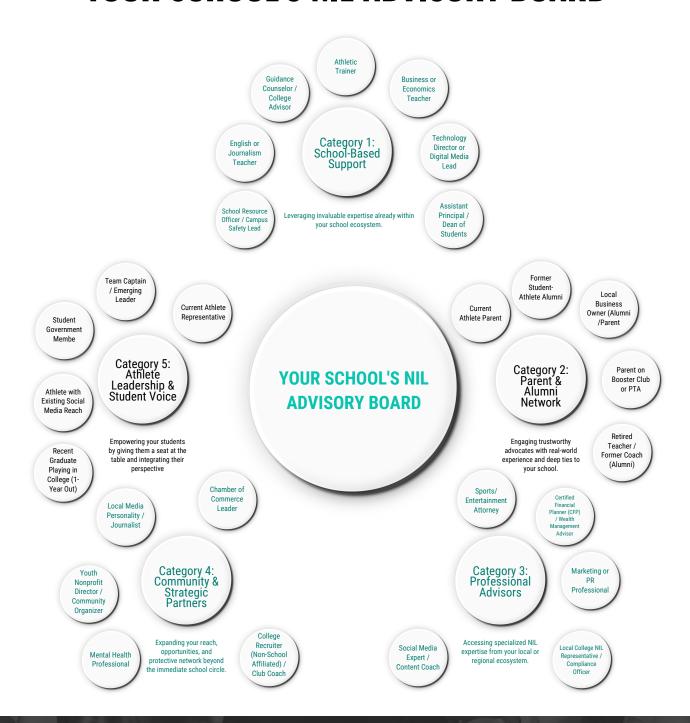

SUGGESTED BOARD ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Consider assigning specific leadership roles to ensure your board operates effectively and intentionally.

- Chairperson: (Typically the Athletic Director or a designated school leader) Oversees meetings, sets agenda, ensures strategic alignment.
- Legal & Compliance Officer: Leads discussions on policy, state laws, and risk mitigation.
- Brand & Media Liaison: Guides discussions on athlete branding, online presence, and PR opportunities.
- Financial Planning Lead: Provides insights on financial literacy, tax implications, and wealth management.
- Health & Wellness Advocate: Focuses on mental health, life balance, and overall athlete well-being.
- Parent/Athlete Relations Representative: Gathers feedback from families, ensures clear communication.
- Community & Business Outreach Lead: Explores potential local partnerships and community engagement opportunities.
