### Agriculture Researh and Draw

Draw the missing stages.



There are six stages for growing wheat. If needed, research to find out what the missing stages should look like.

**Seedling** - The first leaves emerge from the soil.

**Tiller** - New shoots grow from the root of the plant. Each tiller can grow its own stalk and seed head. The number of tillers determines the yield of the plant.

**Jointing** – The stalk forms a second "joint" from which the plant telescopes upward. The smaller, less-formed tillers may die off at this stage.

**Booting** – You can see the head of the wheat forming beneath the sheath on the stalk.

Head and Flower Stage - All the plants in the field should flower at the same time.

**Maturity** – the kernels of grain form, grow and dry.
