

Benjamin Franklin & Turkeys



The King Jame Bible 'Flavor'

Edward F. Hills, Ph.D., textual criticism, Harvard:

"The Bible is *not* a modern, human book.

It is *not* as new as the morning newspaper, and no translation should suggest this. If the Bible were this new, it would not be the Bible.

On the contrary, the Bible is an ancient, a divine Book, which nevertheless is always new because in it God reveals Himself.

Hence the language of the Bible should be venerable as well as intelligible, and the King James Version fulfills these two requirements better than any other Bible in English" (*The King James Version Defended*, p. 219).

Leland Ryken, Wheaton College:

"I believe that it is correct for an English translation to preserve an appropriate archaic 'flavor' as a way of preserving the distance between us and the biblical world.

Joseph Wood Krutch used an evocative formula in connection with the King James Bible when he spoke of 'an appropriate 'flavor' of a past time.' ... a sacred Book should sound like a sacred Book, not like the daily newspaper!

It should command attention and respect, and to do so it cannot be expressed in the idiom of the truck stop.

The failure of modern colloquial translations is frequently a failure of tone"

Polar Ice Update

"It has been a while since we have checked in on polar ice. I'm sure you remember the hysteria of a few years ago - *Arctic sea ice is melting!*

Al Gore predicted, in 2009, that the Arctic would be 'completely ice-free' by 2014.

Far from having disappeared, there are still 1.8 million square miles of ice floating in the Arctic Ocean

[at sea ice minimum at the end of summer].

To sum up: [T]here has been *no* significant downward trend

in September minimum extents over the past two decades.' Meanwhile, ice in the Antarctic region has generally expanded in recent years.
