



God's Love & Man's Love

The HISTORY of the King James Bible

"By the early 17th century, the English Bible had been developing for more than two centuries. The wording of the **King James Bible** represents the labors of centuries of brilliant, believing, sacrificial, godly scholarship. Dozens of some of the best biblical linguists who have ever lived applied their minds and their prayers to translating into English precisely what the Hebrew and Greek text means. "Thus it came to pass, that the English Bible received its present form, after a fivefold revision of the translation as it was left in 1537 by Tyndale and Rogers. During this interval of seventy-four years, it had been slowly ripening, till this last, most elaborate, and thorough revision under King James matured the work for coming centuries"

(Alexander McClure, *The Translators Revived*, 1855, p. 59).

By the early 17th century, the English language was at its apex. Alexander McClure observed:

"The English language had passed through many and great changes, and had at last reached the very height of its purity and strength. The Bible (KJV) has ever since been the grand English classic. It is still the noblest monument of the power of the English speech. It is the pattern and standard of excellence therein' (*The Translators Revived*)."


Memory & the Brain & the Bible
