"Forgetta 'Bout It" (If the Sopranos were only a comedy) What happens when Bobby C, our "Stand-Up Guy", shares too much of his New York life on stage as one of 32 cousins employed in the family business run by the 8 uncles and two-dozen aunts? Do the math, then, Forgetta 'Bout It!

"Wannabes 10" Ten quickly aging, mid 40-year-old guys that can't play competitive physical sports anymore, resort to a chair, a table, beer, pizza and a little Texas Hold 'em tournament where only the top two of these soon to not be such best friends, will go on to play in the World Series of Poker. It's more reality than it is fiction when it comes to sharing this country's latest addiction. (Three cameras, ten real ethnic poker players and two tickets to the WSOP in Vegas.) The characters: Gabby: Turkish, a bad accountant. Subtitles needed to distinguish his fast, raspy whining voice; Co-Jacks: Both bald, no Tootsie Roll, both Greek and both in your face, hot headed security guards; Ace of Spades, cool and a bit slow as a player (their only black friend); Disputin: The Russian, a constant accuser who likes to bump the ethnic music at the wrong time during play; Jew Bros, Ray-Ray, Goldsmith and (penny) pincher all with a lot of questions and no answers and the two middle Eastern cousins and ironic peacemakers of the group, Short Stacked and Big Slick. So Billy goes rouge to show the airline and those who are forced out of their jobs, that he still has it and he takes his case to the people across the country borrowing the company newest wide body and a few unsuspecting flight crew personnel in this CGI roller-coaster ride across the US from the buzzing of the Statue of Liberty, through the skyscrapers of downtown Chicago and Wrigley Field, to the Rocky Mountains, to (or under) the Golden Gate Bridge and (just) over the Matterhorn in Disneyland!

If picked, the person or the family will receive an abundance of corporate, regional and local gifts from organizations, businesses and private donors. Vouchers for one full year will come from many entities that will provide necessities from job placement, education, grocery stores, department stores, doctors, dentists, housing, transportation and so much more.

“The Cool, Cooky Life of Corky Shamatzu” A daring show about “thievery”? Well, we prefer to think “borrow” or even better, “imitate” better describes our attempt at the sincerest form of flattery... Imitation! One can’t help but see past successful formulas that just slightly compare to the compilation of characters and settings that have endeared us in the past. A touch of Friends, to be sure; Frazier has not totally left the building; the D’s are reaped quite well with Dynasty, Dallas and even the old cherished MTM success are somewhere in those walls of the Shamatzu estate. The fact is sometimes Hollywood is all about imitation. The studios love proven successes, they are called sequels, remakes and spin-offs. So why not be bold and borrow from previous successes.

Make no mistake about it, Corky is a highly original character in a situation not quite like any other. Yet, there will be a constant comparison of everything about her and her supporting cast. But it will be a happy reminder to those who are in the compassion business. Good, this is what we want.

This is what America wants. This is intention to a degree because people need familiarity to be in their comfort zone. Our character is a little bit Oprah, a little bit Donald Trump and a lot Corky! She provides us the newest edition of a “makeover” show out of the reality realm to a wonderfully crafted and scripted light-hearted-comedy. It will all come together with a fresh, memorable cast and most importantly, the story-lines that will be water cooler worthy.

Corky reaches out to people because she can. (Billionaire) She is able to help celebrities (Cameos) with their incredibly complicated lives (Actors/Politicians) and repair relationships (Anyone) with a single call to her radio talk show (1075 AM). “Deli, NY” Receipt for disaster: Four aged Jewish sibs, a pinch of three 40-year old, half baked kids of sibs, a dozen spicy ethnic workers (that don’t mix so easily unless beaten), a strong dose of Herb (the prodigal son/ Michelin Chef /Imported from the south of France.)
