However, **government funding will run out in September 2024**. The sustainability of the program relies on the generosity of contributions from businesses and individuals, such as yourself. **Our goal is to secure \$65,000** to ensure that every elementary-age student in the county participates in expert-led outdoor education experiences. We want to inspire kids and families all over our county to get outside and enjoy nature!

During the school year 2023-2024, Randolph County Outdoors delivered exceptional outdoor education experiences to over 1,200 students, and we aspire to exceed that number in the upcoming year. Your assistance is crucial!

- The current cost of programing is \$77.46 per student and our funding will expire in September 2024.
