Product Use: Apply curl-enhancing products on wet hair to lock in moisture and maintain thick, lustrous waves. Use a curl-specific leave-in spray and a moisture-rich, alcohol-free mousse for added definition and a soft, no-crunch finish.

Natural Wave: Use a water mister or curl-defining conditioning mist to refresh and enhance waves between washes. Avoid brushing and use your fingers to style.

Do wavy extensions feel drier than straight ones?

Yes, wavy hair tends to be drier and needs more moisture. Use hydrating products, heat protectants, and leave-in conditioning mists.

What if my extensions are not as curly as I expected?

To enhance curls, use a curl-enhancing mousse or product. Scrunch it into the extensions and let them air dry or use a diffuser. Avoid brushing to maintain the wave.

What if I accidentally brushed the wave out? Are my extensions ruined?

No, simply re-wash or wet your hair to reset the wave pattern.
