

Warnings and Notices to the Restrained Person in 2

If You Do Not Obey This Order, You Can Be Arrested And Charged With a Crime.

- · If you do not obey this order, you can go to jail or prison and/or pay a fine.
- It is a felony to take or hide a child in violation of this order.
- If you travel to another state or to tribal lands or make the protected person do so, with the intention of disobeying this
 order, you can be charged with a federal crime.

You Cannot Have Guns, Firearms, And/Or Ammunition.



You cannot own, have, possess, buy or try to buy, receive or try to receive, or otherwise get guns, other firearms, and/or ammunition while the order is in effect. If you do, you can go to jail and pay a \$1,000 fine. You must sell to or store with a licensed gun dealer or turn in to a law enforcement agency any guns or other firearms that you have or control. The judge will ask you for proof that you did so. If you do not obey this order, you can be charged with a crime. Federal law says you cannot have guns or ammunition while the order is in effect.

Service of Order by Mail

If the judge makes a restraining order at the hearing, which has the same orders as in this form, you will get a copy of that order by mail at your last known address, which is written in ②. If this address is incorrect, or to find out if the orders were made permanent, contact the court.

Child Custody, Visitation, and Support

- Child custody and visitation: If you do not go to the hearing, the judge can make custody and visitation orders for your children without hearing from you.
- Child support: The judge can order child support based on the income of both parents. The judge can also have that support taken directly from a parent's paycheck. Child support can be a lot of money, and usually you have to pay until the child is age 18. File and serve a Financial Statement (Simplified) (form FL-155) or an Income and Expense Declaration (form FL-150) if you want the judge to have information about your finances. Otherwise, the court may make support orders without hearing from you.
- Spousal support: File and serve an Income and Expense Declaration (form FL-150) so the judge will have
 information about your finances. Otherwise, the court may make support orders without hearing from you.

Instructions for Law Enforcement

This order is effective when made. It is enforceable by any law enforcement agency that has received the order, is shown a copy of the order, or has verified its existence on the California Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (CLETS). If the law enforcement agency has not received proof of service on the restrained person, and the restrained person was not present at the court hearing, the agency shall advise the restrained person of the terms of the order and then shall enforce it. Violations of this order are subject to criminal penalties.

Arrest Required if Order Is Violated

If an officer has probable cause to believe that the restrained person had notice of the order and has disobeyed the order, the officer must arrest the restrained person. (Penal Code, §§ 836(c)(1), 13701(b).) A violation of the order may be a violation of Penal Code section 166 or 273.6.

If the Protected Person Contacts the Restrained Person

Even if the protected person invites or consents to contact with the restrained person, the orders remain in effect and must be enforced. The protected person cannot be arrested for inviting or consenting to contact with the restrained person. The orders can be changed only by another court order. (Pen. Code, §13710(b).)

Conflicting Orders-Priorities for Enforcement

If more than one restraining order has been issued protecting the protected person from the restrained person, the orders must be enforced according to the following priorities (see Pen. Code, § 136.2, and Fam. Code, §§ 6383(h), 6405(b)):

- EPO: If one of the orders is an Emergency Protective Order (form EPO-001), and it is more restrictive than other restraining or protective orders, it has precedence in enforcement over all other orders.
- 2. No-Contact Order: If there is no EPO, a no-contact order that is included in a restraining or protective order has precedence in enforcement over any other restraining or protective order.
- Criminal Order: If none of the orders includes a no-contact order, a domestic violence protective order issued in a
 criminal case takes precedence in enforcement over any conflicting civil court order. Any nonconflicting terms of the
 civil restraining order remain in effect and enforceable.
- 4. Family, Juvenile, or Civil Order: If more than one family, juvenile, or other civil restraining or protective order has been issued, the one that was issued last must be enforced.

7) **DESCRIPTION OF ABUSE:**

Introduction and Procedural Issues:

This request for a DVRO based on economic and financial abuse of both JESSICA REDDY and the parties' minor children is a competing request that must be resolved immediately as it concerns the health, safety and welfare of minor children.

. The request competes with an Elder Abuse TRO obtain on April 6, 2020 by LEELA REDDY, mother in law to JESSICA and mother to RAVI REDDY. The Elder Abuse TRO was granted based on false and intentionally misleading information and refers only to claimed financial matters, none of which are true. A copy is attached.

The false information and intentional misrepresentations contained in the EATRO are as follows:

- LEELA REDDY is not a resident of Contra Costa County. She resides in Canada.
- 2. The subject real property at 3307 Sweet Drive, Lafayette, is owned by JESSICA REDDY and held by her, a married woman her sole and separate property. RAVI REDDY executed a valid transmutation of the property from community to separate under *Family Code* section 852. A true and correct copy of the deed naming JESSICA REDDY as sole owner is attached hereto as Exhibit A)
- The trust document to which LEELA REDDY refers was revoked and LEELA's attorneys were
 notified of this on the morning of April 6, 2020. The trust was revocable and the real property
 was never placed into the trust. A copy of that document is attached (Exhibit B).

- JESSICA REDDY never refused to "pay rents" for her own home. JESSIC REDDY owes no rent to
 LEELA REDDY for living in the home she owns.
- 5. JESSIC REDDY revoked the revocable trust on April 6, 2020 (Exhibit C)

At no time in her request for Elder Abuse TRO did LEELA REDDY disclose the following:

- She is not a resident of the State of California. She lives in Canada and is either a Canadian
 citizen or permanent resident of Canada. She has never resided in the home owned by JESSICA
 REDDY. She periodically visited with JESSICA and her son RAVI.
- 2. That JESSICA and RAVI REDDY's two minor children reside in the home.
- 3. That the rental property is located on top of the residence as a separate floor, so that the order that JESSICA (and the two children) remain 50 yards away from the rental will result in removing JESSICA and the children from the home.
- That RAVI REDDY is not living in the residence. That RAVI REDDY vacated the home on February
 23, 2020 and is believed to be living in Canada with his mother LEELA.
- That RAVI REDDY, the father of the two minor children, has had no physical contact with the children nor has requested to see them since relocating to Canada.

Further Description of Abuse:

Since moving out of the family home on February 23, 2020, RAVI REDDY has subjected JESSICA and the minor children, ages 10 and 2 years old, to a pattern of financial and economic abuse and terrorism that has caused them to experience extreme emotional distress and has threatened to cause JESSICA and her two small children to be forced out of the family residence. RAVI REDDY's current actions in concert with his mother are just part of a pattern of financial and economic abuse that he has perpetrated on JESSICA and her daughters for years.

JESSICA REDDY does not work outside the home. Her eldest daughter has been homeschooled for years. The parties' have a 2 year old. RAVI currently provides no support and has cut off JESSICA's

access to bank accounts. She has used credit cards and he has paid her a small "allowance", but has drastically decreased that amount. when JESSICA contacted the credit company to inquire as to available balances he threatened her with a criminal complaint (see email attached EXHIBIT D).

JESSICA's ONLY source of income is the rental income from the rental unit on top of her home. RAVI has, however, taken control of the AirBnB listing and refuses to release it to JESSICA despite repeated demands. He is collecting rents. He is not providing funds to pay the mortgage. His intention is to financially terrorize JESSICA and his children, deprive them of a home and support. All of this has caused JESSICA severe and irreparable emotional harm.

Finally, RAVI REDDY who has taken control of payments for the mortgage and HELOC has cancelled the automatic payments for the HELOC placing JESSICA's home at risk. (EXHIBIT E)

Additionally, RAVI is STALKING JESSICA. Incidental to the illegally obtained Elder Abuse TRO, JESSICA was ordered to reconnect video cameras that display the front and back yards of the family residence.

This was done under the guise of allowing RAVI's mother to monitor "her" property. On April 11. 2020 RAVI REDDY email JESSICA's counsel and revealed that he had been stalking her via video camera footage, violating her privacy and the privacy of other. (EXHIBIT F) RAVI REDDY's email is clearly another attempt by RAVI to emotionally control and abuse JESSICA as it is intended to let her know "he is watching her" at all times. (JESSICA and her close friend maintained Social Distancing at all times).

16) ADDITIONAL ORDERS REQUESTED:

JESSICA REDDY requests the following additional relief:

- a) JESSICA REDDY must be allowed to rent the property located above her home;
- b) RAVI REDDY must immediately cancel his account with AirBNB and all control over the rental property must be granted to JESSICA REDDY.
- c) JESSICA REDDY must be allowed to deactivate the RING security cameras on her property to stop RAVI REDDY from invading her privacy and stalking her movements through those cameras.

Possession of Guns or Firearms

If the court grants the orders in item (8), you cannot own, have, possess, buy or try to buy, receive or try to receive, or otherwise get guns, other firearms, or ammunition while this Order is in effect. If you do, you can go to jail and pay a \$1,000 fine. You must sell to or store with a licensed gun dealer, or turn in to a law enforcement agency, any guns or other firearms that you have or control as stated in item (8). This order is enforceable by any law enforcement agency that has received the order, is shown a copy of the order, or has verified its existence on the California Restraining and Protective Orders System (CARPOS). If the law enforcement agency has not received proof of service on the restrained person, the agency must advise the restrained person of the terms of the order and then must enforce it. Violations of this order are subject to criminal penalties.

Start Date and End Date of Orders

This order starts on the date next to the judge's signature on page 4. The order ends on the expiration date in item 4 on page 1.

Arrest Required if Order Is Violated

If an officer has probable cause to believe that the restrained person had notice of the order and has disobeyed the order, the officer must arrest the restrained person. (Pen. Code, §§ 836(c)(1), 13701(b).) A violation of the order may be a violation of Penal Code section 166 or 273.6. Agencies are encouraged to enter violation messages into CARPOS.

Notice/Proof of Service

The law enforcement agency must first determine if the restrained person had notice of the order. Consider the restrained person "served" (given notice) if (Pen. Code, § 836(c)(2)):

- · The officer sees a copy of the Proof of Service or confirms that the Proof of Service is on file; or
- · The restrained person was informed of the order by an officer.

An officer can obtain information about the contents of the order and proof of service in CARPOS. If proof of service on the restrained person cannot be verified, the agency must advise the restrained person of the terms of the order and then enforce it.

If the Protected Person Contacts the Restrained Person

Even if the protected person invites or consents to contact with the restrained person, this order remains in effect and must be enforced. The protected person cannot be arrested for inviting or consenting to contact with the restrained person. The order can be changed only by another court order. (Pen. Code, § 13710(b).)

Conflicting Orders—Priorities of Enforcement

If more than one restraining order has been issued, the orders must be enforced according to the following priorities: (See Pen. Code, § 136.2; Fam. Code, §§ 6383(b)(2), 6405(b).)

- 1. EPO: If one of the orders is an Emergency Protective Order (form EPO-001) and is more restrictive than other restraining or protective orders, it has precedence in enforcement over all other orders.
- 2. No-Contact Order: If there is no EPO, a no-contact order that is included in a restraining or protective order has precedence over any other restraining or protective order.
- 3. Criminal Order: If none of the orders includes a no-contact order, a domestic violence protective order issued in a criminal case takes precedence in enforcement over any conflicting civil court order. Any nonconflicting terms of the civil restraining order remain in effect and enforceable.
- 4. Family, Juvenile, or Civil Order: If more than one family, juvenile, or other civil restraining or protective order has been issued, the one that was issued last must be enforced.

Please confirm the above; I look forward to your response.

I acknowledge and express my thanks for the e-visitation I had with both daughters yesterday evening. I hope and trust that this can continue, on a reasonable 3 to 4 evenings per week.

Jessica and I are of course divided by certain substantial legal disagreements. But I hope that we can keep in mind the two essential areas of agreement:

That she and the children will continue to enjoy rent-free residence in the downstairs unit at Sweet Drive, and

voluntary support payments through the Wells Fargo/Spirit credit cards.

And, that I receive consistent reasonable e-visitation.

But I also need to express one area of serious concern.

Video camera footage establishes that Jessica and my girls are receiving in-person visitation as recently as Friday April 10 16:00hrs - 19:00 hrs from a friend of Jessica's, and the latter's three children. Ironically (and sadly), that friend is the wife of the local Fire Chief (CCCFPD) in charge of enforcing the shelter-in-place order. :(

Obviously we are all under stress in the light of this pandemic, and crave human contact. But I submit that such social visitation poses a risk to the health of all concerned (see below link from Moraga Police); and I adamantly request that it not be repeated and sincerely hope that such friends and Jessica don't think they are *above* the SIP rules.

Adjustment of Claims

To submit to arbitration, to compromise or to release or otherwise adjust, with or without compensation, any and all claims affecting the trust estate.

No bend for the faithful performance of duties shall be required of any Trustee appointed under this agreement.

The Trustee shall receive reasonable compensation for the services performed by him, but such compensation shall not exceed the amount customarily received by corporate fiduciaries in the area for like services.
