THE TENSION

In a universe of billions, it's easy to feel small. Invisible. Like your life doesn't matter. Suicide rates tell us this isn't theory—it's reality. Maybe you've felt that ache yourself: Would it matter if I wasn't here?

Hear this—you matter more than you know. The God who spoke galaxies into being also spoke you into being. He made you on purpose, for purpose. Your absence would leave a hole no one else could fill.

THE STORY BENEATH IT ALL

In **Creation**, God knows every hair (Matt. 10:30).

In the **Fall**, the serpent whispered, "You are not enough..." (Gen. 3:1-5).

In **Redemption**, Jesus died to prove your worth (John 15:13).

In **Restoration**, eternity shows your value forever (Rev. 21:4).
