THE QUESTION

Does my life actually matter right now?

THE TENSION

It's easy to think today is small—just another 24 hours in a blur of busyness. Yesterday feels like regret. Tomorrow feels out of reach. And cynicism says nothing I do today will make a difference. But the gospel says God works in real time, and He invites you into His story now.

THE STORY BENEATH IT ALL

In Creation, God gave humanity work and purpose (Gen. 2:15).

In the Fall, we wasted today chasing our own way (Gen. 3:6)

In Redemption, we are told to live wisely because the days are evil (Eph. 5:15–16).

In Restoration, every day will echo into eternity (Rev. 21:24–26).

THE COLLISION BETWEEN WASTED DAYS AND REDEEMED TIME

Left on our own, days slip through our fingers—wasted on distractions, buried in regrets, or lost in anxiety about the future. But grace redeems time. The cross proves yesterday is forgiven, the Spirit empowers today, and eternity secures tomorrow. This is the collision: wasted days meet a God who makes every moment count.

SO WHY DOES IT MATTER TODAY?

Without God, today feels disposable—like history is random and life is just survival. With God, today carries eternal weight—He weaves every act of faithfulness, every word spoken, every step taken into His bigger story. Your life isn't waiting to matter “one day.” It matters now.
