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Writing & Math

Writing

- Jot Down things they say & stories they tell and read it to them
- Print First and Last Name
- Draw Pictures that tells a story or write about a picture
- Practice upper and lower case letters
- Use shaving cream spread on table and use fingers to write
- Use a stamp pad to stamp with fingers letters and numbers
- Can of water, big paint brush & “paint” letters and numbers on the driveway

Math

- Count with Them
- Show simple addition and subtraction
- “How Many” game--how many carrots are on the plate
- “I Spy” something with 3 legs
- Roll a dice and count
- Cook together
- Build with blocks and count them
- Sort objects by shape and color
- Play Tic Tac Toe
- Bingo with numbers
- Guess the number “I’m thinking of a number between one and ten.”Go higher or lower.”
