Admission Requirements

To be considered for admission to the CoachRN Nurse Coach School, applicants must meet the following requirements:

Professional Requirements

- Hold an active, unencumbered RN (Registered Nurse) license in the United States or internationally.
- Minimum of 2 years of nursing experience (or equivalent life/professional experience demonstrating readiness to coach).
- Strong communication skills and an openness to self-reflection, personal growth, and professional transformation.

Personal Commitment

- A genuine desire to serve others through the art and science of nurse coaching.
- Willingness to participate fully in all components of the program — including live sessions, group experiences, personal coaching, and independent study.
- Commitment to ethical integrity, respect for diversity, and heart-centered leadership.

Application Materials

- Completed Application Form – including personal contact info and background.
- Personal Statement (300–750 words): Share your “why.” Why nurse coaching? Why now? What calls you to this path?
- Current Resume or CV – outlining relevant nursing experience, education, and professional development.
- Two References (professional or personal) – who can speak to your character, commitment, and readiness for this work.
