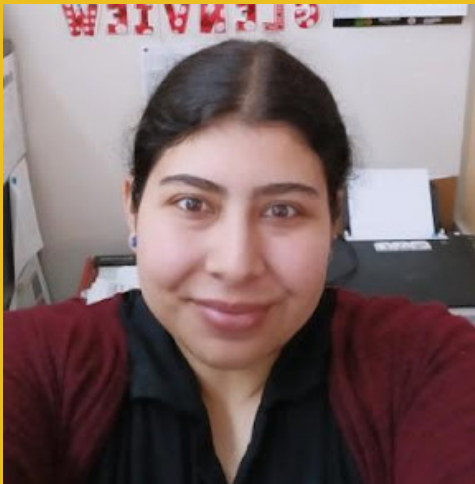




QUINESE (MS. Q)

TARIKA LEWIS (MS. LEWIS)

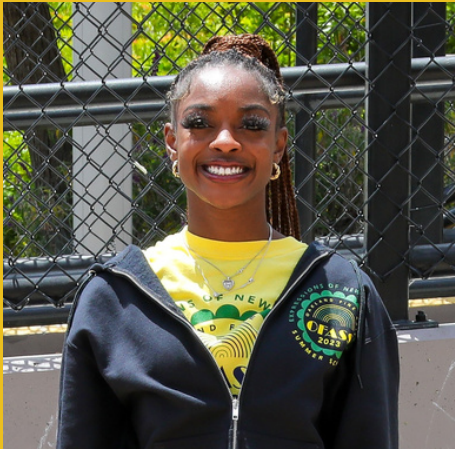
Art/Set Design/Violin

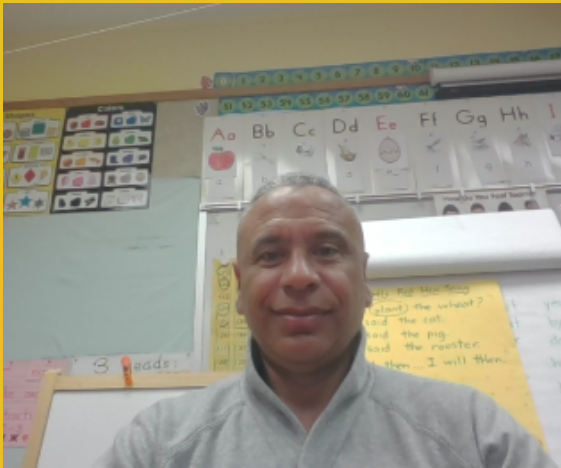
