What is CSP?

The Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP) is a voluntary program that offers annual payments to agricultural producers and forest landowners who maintain and expand conservation activities on their land. CSP helps you build on your existing conservation efforts while strengthening your operation.

Why Enroll in CSP?

Get paid annually for existing conservation practices and new enhancements Increase productivity and build resilience to weather and market changes Support pollinator habitat, soil health, water quality, and wildlife Access tailored conservation bundles for your land type and goals

Who is Eligible?

- Farmers, ranchers, and forest landowners
- Participants must have control of the land for the term of the CSP contract
- Existing basic conservation practices must be in place

How It Works

- Work with NRCS to evaluate your current conservation efforts
- Choose from a list of enhancements and conservation bundles
- Enter a 5-year CSP contract with annual payments
- Install enhancements and report progress annually
- · Renewable after 5 years with additional improvements

CSP Pays You to Improve

Participants receive annual payments based on the conservation performance on their land. Minimum annual payments are \$1,500 per year for most contracts. Enhancements like cover cropping, prescribed grazing, or wildlife habitat improvements can increase your earnings.
