



1. On February 20, the nation of Israel was in mourning as the coffins of four slain hostages returned, including the mother and two children of the Bibas family. The disturbing parading of the coffins through Gaza celebrated by 'innocent' Palestinians brought reactions by many, including an Israeli who commented that at least during the Holocaust, there were righteous Germans who helped hunted Jews, yet there were no Palestinian civilians who helped a hostage. Prayer points for this sad scenario include comfort for all in Israel and especially the families of the slain (see Isaiah 40:1-2) as well as prayer for the disturbed mentality of the Palestinian people that fuel such hatred and atrocities to be changed (Psalm 7:11).
2. With the completion of Phase 1 of hostage talks, pray for the swift completion of Phase 2 with all hostages returned alive (Psalm 126).
3. Iran is known to be working on nuclear weapons, has made attempts to smuggle money into Lebanon to restock Hezbollah and is the 'head of the snake' for Hamas, Hezbollah, Youthies and more terror operatives coming against Israel. It was reported recently that in 2024 Iran's leaders executed 975 of their own people. Pray for the removal of the Ayatollahs in Iran and freedom in that nation to have righteous leadership.
4. Negotiations are on now for what to do with Gaza after the war. The USA and Israel are working on one plan, Arab leaders are seeking another. Pray for the will of the Lord to be done with Gaza post-war. Pray for Hamas to be eradicated, for there to no longer be refugee status allowed (as that means they are seeking to remove the Jews and resettle in Israel as their own land) and for the Palestinian people to be absorbed into nations not seeking the destruction of the only Jewish state.
5. Pray for healing for the many traumatized in the nation of Israel (Psalm 145:18-19).
6. Pray for President Trump, VP Vance, for Mike Johnson and all of the Trump picks for governmental leadership positions as they seek to bring about Biblical change in the USA, including common sense foreign policy - especially for Israel. Pray protection over them, wisdom and clarity for how to lead and the uprooting of any 'bad actors' in positions of influence (Proverbs 1:2-3).
7. Pray for PM Netanyahu and his leadership. Pray for healing, protection, wisdom, strength and the ability to lead Israel despite insurmountable obstacles. Pray for unity in the nation. (Psalm 91; Psalm 133).
8. Pray for a Great Awakening in the USA, Canada, Europe and Israel. Pray for a sweeping return to Biblical values and authentic faith in the God of Creation, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. For all the 'seekers', may they find the truth (Ezekiel 36:26).
9. Pray for the breaking of antisemitism worldwide. Pray for university students who continue in such behavior or those instigating antisemitic acts to be deported or otherwise held accountable. Pray for truthful education and for righteous people to stand with the Jewish people (Psalm 122:6-7).
10. Pray for the IDF soldiers who are known to our community. It is our desire that they would not need to return to full combat, and yet we long to see war objectives accomplished. Pray for the sons of Eran Glazer: Itamar Glazer, and Jonathan Glazer. Those related to Ari Sacher (who works with USIEA): Elyasaf Sacher, Amichai Sacher, Tiara Sacher, Assaf Frankel. The son of Dean Bye (Aliyah Return Center), Chaim Malespin. Those related to Arie Bar David and his daughter Ayelet (Yad Hashmona): Achinoam and Oriyah, Eden and Tal, and Yonatan, PIMatti and Noam, Tsuriyah, Annael, Tsuriel, and Gideon.
