- 1. We give thanks for President Trump's decision to involve the U.S. in the Israel/Iran conflict, which led to the bombings of Iran's nuclear sites. In light of the June 24 ceasefire, please pray for the healing of all Israelis—from trauma, injuries, fatigue, loss of loved ones, damage to homes, and financial loss due to the war. Pray for the innocent Iranian people, and for all the loss they have sustained. Pray for the removal of the Iranian regime, including the Ayatollah. Pray for freedom from the oppressive Islamic state leadership. Pray that the people of Iran, with divine guidance, would have righteous leadership. Pray for the release and protection of Mossad agents who were captured in Iran (Proverbs 29:2).
- 2. Pray for the defeat of Hamas and the release of hostages. Some intercessors are fasting for a day (or a meal) a week until the dark spiritual forces in Gaza, who have been making it challenging to defeat Hamas, are brought down. May we consider joining in on that fast (Psalm 53:6).
- 3. We give praise to God that a large ballistic missile intercepted by Arrow 3 fell by the city gate of Ariel, but did no damage. Pray for the National Leadership Center in Ariel, Israel– for Eran Glazer, Rachely, and the team as they bring hope, education, and healing to many experiencing trauma (Psalm 18:2).
- 4. Pray for Prime Minister Netanyahu, who reportedly works 15-16 hours a day. Pray for strength, protection, divine encounters, and unity among his coalition. Pray blessings on his family, including his son Yair, whose wedding was postponed due to the war with Iran (Exodus 31:3).
- 5. Pray for wisdom for President Trump as well as protection, including for his family and inner circle of leaders. Pray he will accomplish all that God has ordained for him as President of the United States (1 Timothy 2:1-4).
- 6. Pray for truth regarding Israel and the Jewish people to be spoken globally in the media, schools, organizations, and faith communities. Pray for the protection of Jewish people from antisemitism (Psalm 91:9-10).
- 7. Pray for education reformation for the Palestinian people post-Hamas's tyrannical leadership. Pray for wisdom, effectiveness, and protection for Heather Johnston as she is involved (<u>click here to learn more about the need for education reformation from the USIEA</u>) (<u>Exodus 18:20</u>).
- 8. Pray for the children and families of Israel. Pray for a strengthening of relationships, healing, and provision (Malachi 4:6).
- 9. Pray for the IDF soldiers who are known to our community. Pray for the sons of Eran Glazer: Itamar Glazer and Jonathan Glazer. Pray for those related to Ari Sacher (who works with USIEA): Elyasaf Sacher, Amichai Sacher, Tiara Sacher, Assaf Frankel. Pray for the son-in-law of Dean Bye (of the Aliyah Return Center): Chaim Malespin. Pray for those related to Arie Bar David and his daughter Ayelet (of Yad Hashmona): Achinoam and Oriyah, Eden and Tal, Yonatan, PlMatti and Noam, Tsuriyah, Annael, Tsuriel, and Gideon.
