- 1. Further negotiations are ongoing to achieve a ceasefire in Gaza, yet more IDF soldiers were killed this week, and the hostages have been held for over 650 days. Pray for a breakthrough in Gaza. Pray that the dark spiritual forces over Gaza would be broken, Hamas would be removed, and the hostages would be freed (Isaiah 61:1).
- 2. Pray for the Gaza Humanitarian Foundation to be able to get the aid to the people of Gaza without incident. Pray for Pastor Johnny Moore, who leads the GHF (Psalm 41:1).
- 3. Pray for President Trump and Prime Minister Netanyahu as they seek to govern their nations with wisdom from the Lord. Pray for their safety, families, and teams as there are many seeking their destruction. Pray for the Israeli coalition government to stay strong as long as the Lord wills (Proverbs 29:2).
- 4. Some Israeli "settlers" in Judea and Samaria are taking on extremist activities, including the recent killing of a 20-year-old American-Arab. Pray for this unrest and illegal activities to stop (click here to learn more) (Psalm 34:18).
- 5. Israeli families are under tremendous stress: from marriages in crisis, ongoing financial concerns, children impacted by trauma, and more. Please pray for the marriages and families of those in Israel to receive healing. May the love of God break in so they would be overshadowed by Divine assistance (Malachi 2:16).
- 6. Pray for the <u>National Leadership Center</u> in Ariel as we work to accomplish our mission, where we seek to help participants on their journey of healing from trauma and share with them about the God of Israel, all within an atmosphere of adventure activities. Pray for Eran Glazer, Rachely, and the team as they bring hope, education, and healing to many experiencing trauma (<u>Psalm 18:2</u>).
- 7. Pray for truth to prevail over lies. Pray for truth in the media, schools, businesses, faith communities, and beyond. Pray for the removal of funding for that which propagates lies. (Psalm 145:18).
- 8. Pray against antisemitism worldwide. From educational institutions to businesses and demonstrations to social media, antisemitism is at an all-time high. Pray for the protection of the Jewish people and for more to stand with them (<u>Psalm 17:8</u>).
