The NLC has also advanced its content to take into Israeli high schools for in-class leadership training. Since the tragic events of October 7, 2023, the NLC in expanding its mission to include trauma response, offering vital support and healing to widows, orphans, and IDF soldiers through its Parent-Teen program.

Heather is the author of Uncommon Favor, a book chronicling her journey from an ordinary life to a life passionately following God's lead on an international stage.
