Prayer Points for the Week

- 1. Pray for both the <u>National Leadership Center</u> located in Ariel, Israel, and our new property, the <u>Jerusalem Leadership Institute</u>, as each brings light and biblical education to thousands. Pray for Eran Glazer, Rachely Scapa, Tair, and the rest of the team as they navigate the expansion and renovations. Pray also for the provision of finances for this new site (<u>Habakkuk 3:19</u>).
- 2. Pray for peace in Judea and Samaria, as there have been various Arab/Jewish conflicts. Weapons have been smuggled in from the border with Jordan, and numerous attacks have occurred, including incidents of rocks being thrown at people driving on a road. There is also what is called "settler violence." Pray for Israel to gain sovereignty over this region and for the Lord's will to prevail (Psalm 34:14).
- 3. Syria continues to be a border nation of Israel that needs prayer. Since the fall of the Assad regime, the president, Ahmed al-Sharaa, has led a fractured nation. Iranian-backed militias and Hezbollah operate freely. Turkish-backed factions are present in the north, and Kurdish forces occupy an autonomous region in the Northeast. Druze communities are present in the southwest. Local tribes and armed groups are also present throughout the nation. The recent wounding of IDF soldiers near the border in Beit Jann by Islamic militants who were preparing terror activity against Israel highlights the volatility of the region. Please pray for peace in Syria, a stable government, and true normalization of relations with Israel (Psalm 72:7).
- 4. Unlike the Allied victory in World War II when Germany was forced into an unconditional surrender, Hamas freely roams most of Gaza as the ruling power. They have not laid down their arms; they are still shooting at IDF soldiers, and they continue to steal 60% of the humanitarian aid given to the region. Please pray for the complete defeat of Hamas and its removal from Gaza. Pray for the proper governance in Gaza (Psalm 7:9).
- 5. Lawyers for Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu have petitioned President Herzog for a pardon in the six-year legal battle the Prime Minister has faced over receiving gifts from foreign leaders. Pray for Bibi to be pardoned so that the longest court case in Israel's history would come to an end (<u>Proverbs 2:9</u>).
- 6. Thank you for continuing to pray against antisemitism globally (Psalm 61:1-4).
- 7. Pray for healing for all in Israel who have experienced trauma, loss, family discord, and financial difficulties. Pray for IDF families who have been struggling since serving in the war (Isaiah 58:8).
- 8. Pray for Psalm 133 unity within the nation of Israel.
- 9. Pray for more Isaiah 62 intercessors globally to care for, stand with, and pray for Israel (<u>Isaiah</u> <u>62</u>).
- 10. Pray for a Great Awakening in Israel. Pray for a return to biblical values and authentic faith in the true God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (<u>Deuteronomy 10:12-13</u>).
