



*Please mark your calendars as we will fast 21 days together for Israel and the Jewish people (along with Lou Engle and his network) from March 12 - April 1 (ending at Passover)*

1. In theory, President Trump's Gaza Peace Board seems like a good idea to bring international unity around an alternative governing framework for Gaza beyond Hamas. At the same time, it is sparking controversy by adding nations like Turkey and Qatar to the conversations. Pray for the Lord to align the board according to His will, and also that it would be favorable for Israel. Pray for Hamas to be disarmed and removed from all power and from Gaza (Proverbs 16:9).
2. Let us continue to pray for the people of Iran. Pray for regime change, which might be aided by Iran's military turning on extremist leaders. Pray for a righteous leader, or that Reza Pahlavi, the exiled Shah of Iran, would be reinstated as the country's leader, at least in some transitional capacity. Pray that the US would do the right thing regarding stepping in militarily to help the people of Iran (Jeremiah 49:35 (Elam is modern-day Iran)).
3. Pray for both the National Leadership Center located in Ariel, Israel, and our new property, the Jerusalem Leadership Institute, as each brings light and biblical education to thousands. Pray for Eran Glazer, Rachely Scapa, Tair, and the rest of the team as they navigate the expansion and renovations. Pray also for the provision of finances for this new site (Habakkuk 3:19).
4. Continue to pray for the Lord to expose hidden things that need to be exposed, including plots of terror, antisemitic acts, and lies in all forms of media. He has heard our prayers and exposed various threats, including an Arab-Israeli woman who was charged with assisting Hamas's propaganda and psychological warfare efforts (Luke 12:2).
5. Pray for unity in Israel, including among different groups such as Orthodox, Modern Orthodox, Haredim, Chabad-Lubavitch, Ultra-Orthodox, Secular, and Messianic (Psalm 133).
6. Pray for healing for all in Israel who have experienced significant loss and trauma over the past years, particularly IDF soldiers and those who have lost loved ones (Isaiah 61:1-3).
7. Pray for peace in Judea and Samaria and for Israel to incorporate this entire region as a sovereign part of the nation (Psalm 29:11).
8. Pray for more to join the call of Isaiah 62 to pray for Israel. Pray against apathy, replacement theology, and ignorance in the worldwide church regarding God's purposes for Israel and the Jewish people (Isaiah 62).
9. Pray for a Great Awakening in Israel. Pray for a return to biblical values and authentic faith in the true God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Psalm 36:9).
