THREE STEPS TO FULLY SANITISE YOUR BUSINESS

The global pandemic has given rise to many businesses recognising the importance of regular workplace cleaning and the benefits of a hygiene regime for the benefit of employers, business productivity and visitors.

There are three terms that get used almost interchangeably: deep clean, fogging and Zoono.

We've put this fact sheet together to explain what each term means. All three are different and every business will benefit from a routine combination of all three; we are able to advise you on the best approach for each business's individual requirements.



DEEP CLEAN

A full infection prevention control to fully sanitise & clean your premises



FOGGING

The use of disinfectant sprayed from a fogging machine to disinfect high levels of horizontal surfaces and hard to reach areas



ZOONO

A specific chemical that we recommend is sprayed on high touch point areas within a high traffic area zone

A deep clean is essentially a full infection prevention control performed by our cleaning operatives in order to fully sanitise and clean your premises.

Deep cleaning is a more enhanced programme of environmental cleaning than a regular office clean. It complements routine daily cleaning in a place of work. It includes the thorough cleaning of all surfaces, floors, soft furnishings and re-useable equipment, either within the whole environment or in a particular area, covering high traffic touch points in the office, kitchen area and toilets.

A deep clean must only be performed by cleaning operatives that have been trained in the use of appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), and in line with current national guidance.

FOGGING



Fogging is the now-familiar description for the use of disinfectant sprayed from a fogging machine to create what looks like fog in the room where it's applied. It is an effective way to disinfect high levels of horizontal surfaces and hard to reach areas that are often missed in a routine clean or forgotten, small and confined spaces, such as extractor units.

Fogging kills 99.9% of the bacteria present within your business. TGC recommends that, as a rule, businesses get this done immediately after a Deep Clean or on a fortnightly or monthly basis.

Zoono is the name of a specific chemical that we recommend is sprayed on high touch point areas within a high traffic area zone. Zoono lasts up to 30 days on any surface and can survive up to 30 washes, preventing the spread of virtually any virus. It also kills any germs on skin and on all textiles yet contains no toxins or alcohol. It kills repeatedly and mechanically, not chemically and can be applied as a mist, foam or wipe.

Cleaning and disinfection remove or kill micro-organisms but typically, surfaces can become re-contaminated after two hours. Zoono creates a residual barrier which greatly reduces recontamination within a 30-day period. Zoono delivers a sustained microbiological clean environment, reducing the level of contamination with pathogenic micro-organisms on a continual basis. It's effective and efficient, reducing sickness and the risk of serious illness because of a contaminated environment. Zoono leaves a monomolecular layer permanently bound to the surfaces it touches.
