

Trails beyond our Controlled Recreation Area remain open during winter, but may have capacity and parking restrictions. From mid-December to mid-April, a BC Parks parking permit is necessary.

Enjoy this 13.0-km loop trail near Anmore, British Columbia. Generally considered a challenging route, it takes an average of 4 h 31 min to complete. Dogs are welcome, but must be on a leash.
