ComplianceGo introduces greater inspection flexibility and reporting control with the new "Allow Late Inspections" option and enhanced form builder settings for thumbnails and text sizing. Map and calendar updates improve visibility and printability, while new inspection frequencies and a "Business Day" priority option support better scheduling. A refined password reset flow and updated weather alert wording improve clarity. Fixes resolve issues with deleting in-progress items and missing thumbnails, ensuring a smoother experience.

## **ENHANCEMENTS**

- Added an option in the form builder to allow action log photos to appear as thumbnails in the action log in the inspection report.
- Added options in the form builder to change text size in the action log in the inspection report.
- Added backshading to the notes on map icons to allow for easier viewing.
- Added a counter bubble next to "Site Maps" on the site page.
- Made changes to the inspection calendar to make it more printer friendly.
- Added two new inspection frequencies: "Every 5 Business Days" and "Every Business Day"
- Updated the password reset flow.
- Added a "Business Day" option to action item priorities, allowing action items to consider business days instead of calendar days.
- Changed the wording in the postweather notification from "requires an inspection" to "may require an inspection"

## **BUG FIXES**

- Fixed an issue that could prevent an in-progress on-demand inspection from being deleted.
- Fixed an issue that could prevent an action item on an in-progress inspection from being deleted.
- Fixed an issue that could prevent action item thumbnails from appearing in the action log if the action item was completed.

## **NEW FEATURES**

 Added the "Allow Late Inspections" feature that allows inspections to persist indefinitely until they are signed. This overrides the automatic inspection expiration that occurs when inspections are not completed by the time the next due window begins.
