2024 COMPETITION TEAM AGREEMENT

- PCDA Competition Team students are expected to be regularly attending classes and displaying a positive attitude and commitment to participating fully and trying their best in all their classes.
- PCDA Competition Team students are prepared to practice at home regularly outside of their private lessons
 to work on their routines. They should be committed to learning the choreography outside of class so that
 private lesson time can be used to improve performance quality, technique, and skill development.
- PCDA Competition Team students must embrace the PCDA values and spirit. We want the students who
 represent us to love what we are about and be proud to showcase what they are learning as part of the
 PCDA team.
- PCDA Competition Team students are representing PCDA and therefore will need to purchase PCDA uniform to wear at competitions and public events.
- A competition schedule will be provided to all families to advise of the approved events that your child can
 enter. You must advise PCDA via email of all competition entries. If you would like to enter your child into a
 competition not listed on the schedule, you must request permission before entering. All solo / duo /trio
 competition entries are the responsibility of the parent PCDA will NOT be registering competition students.
- PCDA Competition Team students MUST be committed to attending all scheduled events if in the troupes.
- The student can only take a private lesson in the same class style as their regular classes.
- New routines can be requested, but it is up to the teacher to decide when a new routine is necessary. Most routines should be kept for a minimum of 2 years before being changed. Teachers may decide to add more difficult choreography / skills to existing solos as student's ability progresses.
- Students cannot use any choreography for another purpose without written permission from Studio Director. If the student leaves the studio, the choreography remains the property of PCDA and cannot be used without written permission.
- In some cases, a teacher may decide a routine is not ready for competition. Please respect the teacher's decision regarding this. They only ever want what is best for the student and their growth. Failure to do so, could mean the loss of all private spots.

Both dancer and parent have read and understand all that is expected as a member of the PCDA Competition Team. We understand that policies are created to ensure the most positive and rewarding experience for everyone. Both dancer & parent understand that failure to meet the conditions of the team agreement could result in the dancer's dismissal from the PCDA Competition Team.
