

## General Education

Heartland Baptist Bible College is a ministry training institution offering 1-, 2-, and 4-year programs of study for students from independent Baptist churches. Each year since 1998, new students from around the world have come to Oklahoma City to begin a

process of ministry preparation, and each year students have graduated from the college and begun a lifetime of local church ministry. This continuing process of receiving, training, and graduating students is summarized in the college's theme, "Preaching the Word. Reaching the World." and is made possible by the preserving grace of God and the support of local churches.

Because we believe that local church ministry should be done with a timeless excellence that represents Christ, Heartland has built a foundation of purposeful general education into each 4-year major. Students develop both written and verbal communication skills and receive a biblically-based historical worldview. Based upon major, students also encounter courses addressing literature, philosophy, mathematics, and technology. However, these subjects are not included to dilute students' passion for ministry; rather, our general education is balanced and interspersed with practical training to prepare students to use their increased knowledge for Christ's Great Commission. 


# The Cause of World Evangelism
