

PERTH BIBLE COLLEGE GUEST RENTAL POLICY

Introduction

These terms and conditions apply to your stay at Perth Bible College (PBC). In this document:

- "Arrival Date" means the check-in date in your booking.
- "Unit" means the accommodation provided by PBC.
- "Booking" means your reservation for the unit.
- "Inappropriate Behaviour" includes lighting fires during fire bans, damaging property or wildlife, making excessive noise, or not following PBC instructions.
- "Rate" means the price per night.
- "We/Us/PBC" means Perth Bible College (ABN 52 599 089 532), 1 College Court, Karrinyup, WA, 6018.
- "You/Your" refers to the person booking the unit and any other guests staying.

Before You Arrive

- 1. You are responsible for your safety and must follow PBC's House Rules. PBC is not responsible for injuries, weather-related damage, or loss of personal property.
- 2. Read these terms before arrival and contact us with any questions.
- 3. You must arrange your own transport and mobility assistance if needed.
- 4. Two days before arrival, PBC will email you instructions. You will also receive the House Rules when you check in.
- 5. Park only in the designated areas (maximum of 1 vehicle per booking).
- 6. Check-in: from 12:00 PM. Check-out: by 10:00 AM. Late check-outs without permission will be charged an extra night.

During Your Stay

- 1. In case of emergency, follow the contact details provided in your check-in instructions.
- 2. The unit is on an active college campus where regular activities such as pest control and maintenance take place. Do not interfere with these operations.
- 3. Fires: Not allowed on campus.
- 4. Speed Limit: Drive at a maximum of 5km/h and be cautious of students and staff. PBC is not responsible for vehicle damage.
- 5. Noise & Parties: No parties or gatherings without permission. Keep noise levels low, especially after 10:00 PM.
- 6. Smoking: Not allowed inside the unit or anywhere on campus.
- 7. Wildlife: The campus has wildlife such as birds, spiders and insects. PBC is not responsible for interactions with them.

- 8. Utilities: PBC is not responsible for power, water, or gas failures beyond our control. Report any issues to management.
- 9. Photo & Video Shoots: Require prior written approval from PBC.
- 10. Damage & Repairs: Report any damage or non-working items upon arrival.
- 11. Children: Children must be supervised at all times.
- 12. Pets: Not allowed on campus.

When You Leave

- 1. Rubbish: Dispose of it as per House Rules. A fee applies for improper disposal.
- 2. Check-out: Leave by the agreed time.
- 3. Condition of Unit: Leave the unit clean and tidy as you found it.
- 4. Damage: Report any damage caused during your stay.
- 5. Lost Items: If you forget something, you must pay for postage to have it returned

Payments & Cancellations

- Full payment confirms your booking.
- All payments are in Australian dollars.
- Bookings are not transferable or for resale.

Rescheduling or Cancelling Your Booking

- 1. Rescheduling: Requires 7 days' written notice. Late requests may not be accommodated.
- 2. Multiple Reschedules: PBC may refuse further changes and issue a voucher instead.
- 3. Cancellation:
 - More than 30 days before check-in: Full refund minus 5% admin fee.
 - o 7–14 days before check-in: 50% refund minus 5% admin fee.
 - Less than 7 days before check-in: No refund.
 - No-shows, late arrivals, or early departures: No refund.

If PBC Cancels Your Booking:

- 1. We may cancel due to reasons such as bad weather, fires, or other emergencies.
- 2. We will give as much notice as possible and try to reschedule your booking. If we cannot reschedule, you will receive a full refund.

Special Events & Public Holidays

- Minimum three-night stays apply for long weekends and special events.
- Shorter stays may be available at PBC's discretion.

House Rules & Behaviour

- 1. Follow PBC's House Rules provided at check-in.
- 2. Follow instructions. Failure to do so may result in eviction.
- 3. Inappropriate Behaviour (e.g., excessive noise, ignoring fire bans) may lead to eviction and additional charges.

Liability

- 1. Personal Belongings: You are responsible for your own belongings. PBC is not liable for lost, stolen, or damaged property.
- 2. Injuries & Accidents: PBC is not responsible for accidents, injuries, or losses during your stay.
- 3. Natural Disasters: PBC is not liable for loss caused by weather, fires, or natural disasters.
- 4. Refunds & Disputes: Any refund requests must be sent to college@pbc.edu.au.
- 5. Indemnity: You agree to cover any loss, damage, or liability caused by your actions during your stay.

Privacy & Legal Matters

- 1. Privacy: PBC follows Australian privacy laws. Our Privacy Policy is available at www.pbc.wa.edu.au.
- 2. Governing Law: These terms are governed by Western Australian law.
- 3. Changes: These terms can only be changed in writing by PBC.
- 4. Agreement: By booking, you confirm you understand and accept these terms.
- 5. Age Requirement: You must be at least 18 years old to make a booking.

Fees & Charges

Fee Type	Cost
Late Check-Out	\$50 per hour if not pre-arranged
Lost Key/Lockout	\$110 call-out fee + cost of new lock
Linen Damage	Cost of replacement
Plumbing/Electricity Issues	Guest covers the cost if caused by them
Call-Out Fee for PBC Staff or	\$150 if the issue was caused by the guest

Fee Type	Cost
Noise Complaints	\$500 per offence
Police/Security Call-Out	\$500 per offence
Damage to Unit or Campus	Cost of repair/replacement
Cleaning Fees	Charged if the unit is left excessively dirty
Smoking Penalty	\$250 + additional cleaning costs
