Adventure to Namibia

13-day Namibia tour from Cape Town to Windhoek

DAY 1: The first day of our tour we depart from Cape Town. Our destination for the day will be Vanrhynsdorp. Here we will overnight at Namaqua Lodge.

Included: Dinner

DAY 2: We depart from Vanrhynsdorp and head towards the Vioolsdrif border post. Depending on how long the border crossing takes, we'll visit the Fish River Canyon viewpoint in the afternoon. We will spend the night at Canyon Village.

Included entrance fee: Fish River Canyon

DAY 3: From here, we travel to Aus. The route we take will depend on the road conditions.

DAY 4: After a delicious breakfast at Klein Aus Vista, we head to Kolmanskop for a guided tour. From there, we travel to Lüderitz to explore the famous coastal town. On our return to Aus, we hope to spot the wild horses of the Garub plains.

DAY 5: From Aus, we make our way to the Namib-Naukluft National Park via Helmeringhausen, or possibly along the scenic D707 route, depending on road conditions. We'll spend the next two nights in the Sossusvlei area.

DAY 6: Today we visit the breathtaking and picturesque Sossusvlei in the Namib-Naukluft National Park. Here, we'll admire the world's oldest dunes, glowing in rust-red hues. The endless beauty and power of the dunes will captivate you, with mysterious "fairy circles" appearing here and there.

DAY 7:

Today we travel through the Khomas and Erongo regions to Dune 7 and Walvis Bay, where we'll have the opportunity to see the flamingos. From there, we head to Swakopmund for a three-night stay at Bay View Resort in Langstrand.

DAY 8: Today we explore Oasis Goanikontes, the Moon Landscapes and the ancient Welwitschia plants. The magical lichen fields are also a must-see along our route. After the tour, you'll have time to rest or explore Swakopmund and Walvis Bay at your own pace.

DAY 9: Today you will have the day to yourself to explore Swakopmund. A list of optional activities will be provided.

DAY 10: We depart from Swakopmund and head to the Etosha National Park, where we'll spend two nights at Okaukuejo Rest Camp. We've selected this camp for its fantastic waterhole, where you can observe wildlife late into the night.

DAY 11: Early morning, we head out on a game drive through the park until around lunchtime. You're welcome to enjoy lunch back at the camp. This drive is optional and not mandatory. After dinner—or at any time during the day—you can visit the camp's waterhole to watch the animals come for a drink.

DAY 12: After a hearty breakfast, we leave Etosha National Park and make our way to Windhoek, where we'll spend the night at Arebbusch Travel Lodge. As we arrive in the city, we'll make stops at a few local points of interest.

Important to note

When booking a flight from our end destination, please consult the office via email or phone to make sure that you do not book a flight (or other transport arrangements) too early.

We are happy to assist with flight bookings as well as payment of the flights – the cost is R200 per person for bank charges and administration fee. These flights will be booked after we have received your deposit. The cost of the flights, along with the R200 per person, is also payable immediately after the booking has been completed and you have received your flight ticket. Please note that we do not receive flights at a discounted rate, so you are welcome to book all flights yourself if you prefer.

Road conditions and infrastructure in Namibia

Roads in Namibia and throughout Africa are often in poor condition, which makes it hard on our vehicles. We take great pride in our bus and ensure it is serviced regularly and is in a good condition, but breakdowns do happen. Some of the roads we travel on are long, full of dust and not exactly smooth sailing. This means that the travel time indicated is just a rough guide and dependant on various factors that are not always in our control. We know that it can be tough, but the destinations at the end of the day are extra-ordinary!



Medical & Health information

Travelers, old and young are required to be in good health to participate fully on this trip. We expect all travelers to read carefully through the program and asses you on the stress of activities mentioned in the day-to-day program. If in the opinion of our tour guide or leader, any traveler is unable to participate in activities or on the rest of the tour; they reserve the right to exclude them from the activity or tour at any stage, without refund. The appropriate documentation will be provided for travel insurance. All clients should consult their doctor or medical professional on information regarding vaccinations and anti-malaria medication requirements before departure. We recommend that you carry your own small first aid kit containing personal required medication and an extra pair of reading glasses. Rehydration salt, motion sickness tablets and diarrhea blockers are also advisable to have on hand.



Travel Insurance

We strongly recommend that you take out travel insurance for your tour. We work with TIC (Travel Insurance Consultants) and you are welcome to contact our office for a quotation.

Drinking Water

As a rule, we consider all tap water to be not suitable for human consumption, as it may contain different levels of minerals or bacteria than the water your stomach is used to at home. Your body may not be use to this, and it can cause illness. It will upset your stomach and it will spoil the rest of your trip. Many of the accommodation facilities we use provide guests with safe drinking water and bottled water is readily available throughout the trip. Please make sure to bring along a water bottle to fill up during the tour.
