
# Companion Devotional



# Hear My Prayer — Devotional & Discussion Guide

Based on Psalm 54:2: "Hear my prayer, O God; give ear to the words of my mouth."

### **Overview**

This devotional guide accompanies the short story \*Hear My Prayer\*, following twelve-year-old Marcy Gibson as she and her mother flee abuse and find refuge in the town of Riverside, Oklahoma. The guide explores themes of trauma, trust, answered prayer, friendship, and healing through discussion questions, scripture reflections, journaling prompts, and prayer focus.

### **Devotional: God Hears Even the Quietest Prayer**

Marcy never expected God to show up in a women's shelter bathroom. But there, hidden in plain sight, was a poster with a promise she needed: "Hear my prayer, O God; give ear to the words of my mouth." —Psalm 54:2

That verse didn't erase her pain. It didn't bring back her sister or undo the trauma. But it gave her something sacred—hope that she hadn't been forgotten. God hears whispered prayers. Shaky ones. Silent ones. Angry ones. Desperate ones. And He answers in ways we often don't expect—through a new town, a kind stranger, a safe place, or even a chatty girl with a popsicle stick. If you've ever wondered if your prayers mattered, this story reminds us: Yes. They do. And God is still listening.
