Focus on day-to-day use: speaking, listening, grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation

A1–B1

Academic English (AE)

Learn essay structure, referencing, academic tone, synthesis, summarising, reports

B1–B2

English for Professionals (EP) Tailored for postgrads: research writing, presentations, viva prep, proposal defence

- 📧 You'll receive a Personal English Support Plan via email

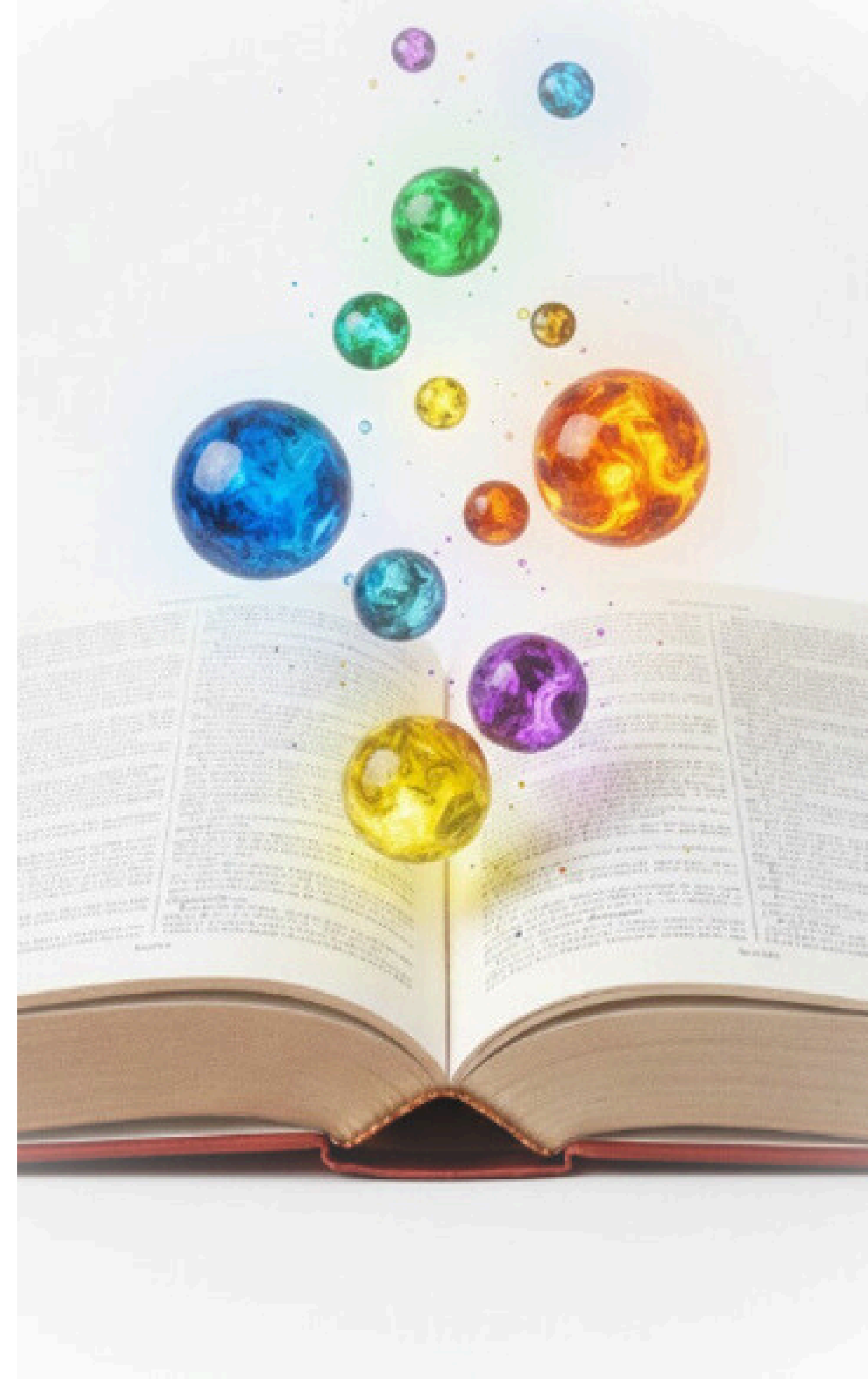

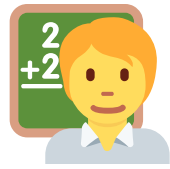
