The man who didn't believe

One of the many reasons why I am sure the resurrection of the Man we call Jesus actually happened! Imagine growing up in a family where your elder brother spoke with special wisdom and performed what you could only see as miracles? Just so different!



One of the brothers, growing up with Jesus was a man called James. James and the brothers of Jesus tried to persuade Jesus to go to Jerusalem to show the miracles He could perform. Jesus declined saying "my time has not yet come" and then "the world hates me because I testify of it that it's work is evil". Looking at the world today might you agree with the words of Jesus?

Later, the brothers and family of Jesus went out to take custody of Jesus saying "he is out of his mind". We see that James with the brothers and the family did not believe, did not understand who Jesus is, or who He claimed to be.

You can find records of these events in your Bible. Gospel of Mark chapter 3 and verses 20-21 and Gospel of John chapter 7 and verses 1-9

The man who changed his mind

James grew up with Jesus, for close to thirty years. James knew the details of the crucifixion, and likely was present with his mother Mary. Surely, he still did not believe in Jesus to be the Son of God or divine in any way?

The greatest shame, in those days, was to be crucified. The people and soldiers mocking the beaten naked body of Jesus on the cross, crucified with thieves and robbers at each side.

James changed his mind about his brother Jesus! James led the Church in Jerusalem and three early historians confirm James was martyred for his faith in Jesus. The three non-Christian believing historians were Josephus, Origen and Eusebius reporting in their writings.

So what happened James? From non-belief to total belief? Belief so certain, so definite, that you died for it.?

What happened? The resurrection! James knew Jesus very well, his appearance, his mannerisms and his voice. There is confirmation that Jesus appeared to His brother James, all the apostles and then to 500 people at one time. These statements are falsifiable, meaning they could have been denied and discredited by those around at the time, but not so.

Am I good enough?

In the darkness of night, using my mobile phone torch I could see where to put my feet. Reaching the road, the brightness of the street lamp shone down. Now my phone light was outshone, it achieved nothing!

The street lamp was still on when the sun came up, the light from my phone was pointless.

If I had any goodness to compare with anyone else, my goodness could fade into insignificance against their brightness of light in this world.

So, am I good enough?

Good enough?

They were lined up on the track. They had practiced and become good at competing in the classic 100 metres sprint. Proud of their success to date, they waited for the sound of the starting pistol. At that moment an unknown impressive athlete lined up with them.



The starting pistol! They're off! In a flash, the unknown athlete raced ahead breaking the finishing tape. Flailing behind, and despite their best efforts, the others looked at themselves in dismay. They had not come up to the mark. Not good enough it seems.

Who was the unknown athlete? He said his name was Bolt. Usain Bolt, winner of multiple Olympic and World Championship gold medals.

Is anyone good enough?

In times past there were teachers and rabbis in the hills and towns around Jerusalem. A young good religious and wealthy man approached the one known to be an outstanding Teacher.

The young man asked, "Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" The teacher stopped him right there, saying "Why do you call me good? No one is good but One, that is God."

Who Is this Teacher? Jesus from Nazareth, the place from where it was said that no good could come.

All the young man's goodness was not enough then. He was looking up into the face of the only One good enough to be able to offer him the gift of eternal life. Invited to follow the teacher, give his wealth to the poor and learn about this, the young man turned sadly away clinging to his earthly wealth.

More than the Golden Rule

The Golden Rule of 'loving your neighbour as yourself' is magnified in true Christianity. "Greater love has no man than this, than to lay down his life for his friends" A Man of His word, Jesus, proclaiming Himself to be the Son of God, did this. He suffered the Cross.

The book of Genesis tells us that we are made in the image of God. How we treat each other must reflect this knowledge.
