

Christmas Pinecone Elves

What you ueed → Pinecones

- → Felt (2 or 3 different colours)
 → Small wooden balls
- $\stackrel{\checkmark}{ o}$ Tiny bells
- → Scissors
- Hot glue gun
- Felt pen/permanent marker

*Make sure an adult is available to supervise you when using scissors and the hot glue gun.



Step



Using your hot glue gun, stick the small wooden ball to the pinecone, to make the head. 3

Step 2



You now need to cut out a triangle for the hat, 2 heart shapes for feet and a long rectangle for a scarf. You can use multiple colour felts for this part. *

Step 3



Once you have cut out both hearts, using your hot glue gun, glue one on top of the other to create the feet.

Step 4



Once they are glued togeteher, glue them to the bottom of the pinecone. '

Step 5



The first accessory for our elf is his scarf. To do this, simply cut out the rectangle shape you stenciled up earlier and wrap it around the 'neck' of the elf and add a dap of glue from the hot glue gun to stick it together. *



The next accessory is his hat. Cut out the triangle you drew up and then roll it into a cone shape and glue the sides together. Then add some glue around the base of the cone and stick it onto the top of his head. *



Once his hat is on you can draw on his eyes and a little nose with your felt pen or permanent marker and attatch a tiny bell to the tip of his hat. With left over felt you can also add on some mittons.
