



Policy Responsible Service of Alcohol

To ensure Gosford RSL Club complies with the requirements of the Liquor Act, Registered Clubs Act and Harm Minimisation legislation regarding the sale and service of alcohol Gosford RSL Club has adopted a House Policy which provides a framework for Responsible Service of Alcohol:

We will demonstrate our commitment to the responsible service of alcohol by:

- a) Providing approved training of management and staff in the responsible service of alcohol
- b) Refusing to serve alcohol to persons who are obviously or visibly affected by alcohol;
- c) Refusing entry to persons who are obviously or visibly affected by alcohol;
- d) Avoiding the promotion of alcohol in a way that could encourage minors to seek to purchase or to consume alcohol;
- e) Avoiding the promotion of alcohol in a way that could encourage the excessive consumption of alcohol;
- f) Refusing alcohol service to under age persons and requiring the presentation of Proof of Age and other approved forms of identification before providing services to persons we suspect of being minors;
- g) Making Club patrons aware of their responsibility under the law in respect of the supply of alcohol. Trainers must be approved by the Office of Liquor, Gaming and Racing. To minors and intoxicated persons; and
- h) Not supporting any pricing practice which encourages the excessive consumption of alcohol.
- i) GRSL club will support and promote all initiatives to minimise drink driving so as to safeguard the wellbeing of all road users.
- j) Record all incidents of refusal of service or entry underage patrons and aggressive or inappropriate behaviour on the clubs premises.
