

ONLINE DUAL CREDIT COURSES

Information for Parents & Students

CSCS is continually working to provide unique and fulfilling educational opportunities for its students. An excellent example of this is our online dual credit courses that enable CSCS students to earn both college and high school credits while exploring areas of interest and passion.

Our online dual credit courses allow you to save money with reduced online college fees ranging from \$300 - \$850 per course compared to an average \$1,500 - \$3,000 for a traditional college course. Another advantage is that all of the universities partnering with us to offer these online courses are faith-based institutions. Even though these courses are online, students will come to a CSCS classroom every day with a CSCS instructor who will offer educational and technical support while helping to maintain accountability. This will help students develop the skills necessary to successfully complete an online course before taking one in college.

Since online dual credit courses offer greater challenges than a typical high school course, students must be able to meet the criteria listed on the Student Profile section of this packet, including a good attendance record and a cumulative unweighted GPA of at least 3.0.

IMPORTANT! As with any dual credit course, transferability is not guaranteed, even by the sponsoring college. Before making the decision to apply for a dual credit course, we encourage the student to verify that the credits earned will transfer to the college program of his/her choice by sending a formal written request to the registrar's office at the college, asking that credits be accepted. We recommend that the student get all credit acceptance decisions in writing from that college or university.

In addition to course fees, parents will be responsible to purchase textbooks for any course students take. This ADDITIONAL COST TO YOU, THE PARENT, IS <u>NOT</u> covered by the online course fee charged by CSCS for the actual course.

Please note that courses provided by Grand Canyon University are only 7 weeks in length. Therefore, students taking an online course through GCU have two options for the semester: 1) Take two seven-week courses back-to back OR 2) Take one course: seven weeks of coursework, then study hall through the rest of the semester.
