1 Test Scores at 30-Year Low

NAEP reading and math scores have declined to their lowest levels since the 1990s. The average 9-year-old lost 5 points in reading and 7 points in math since 2020 - the largest decline in over 30 years.

2 | Tax-Exempt Foundations Control Curriculum

Organizations like the Gates Foundation have spent over \$5.8 billion influencing education policy. These unelected entities shape what your children learn while paying no taxes and facing no accountability to voters.

3 4 Political Bias Infects Textbooks

Studies show **78% of K-12 textbooks** contain political bias, with history and social studies materials heavily slanted toward progressive viewpoints while conservative perspectives are systematically excluded or misrepresented.

4 Rarents Denied Transparency

Schools increasingly refuse to share curriculum details with parents. 43% of school districts actively hide classroom materials from parents, claiming "copyright protection" or "proprietary content."

5 & Lowered Standards Mask Failure

Rather than improve teaching, schools eliminate honors classes and drop standardized testing requirements.

Oregon ended reading and math graduation requirements, claiming it promotes "equity."

6 * Teacher Union Power Over Education

Teachers' unions spend **\$40 million annually** on political lobbying, often prioritizing union interests over student achievement. They fought to keep schools closed during COVID despite evidence of massive learning loss.

7 \$ Massive Spending, Minimal Results

The U.S. spends \$15,000+ per student annually - among the highest globally - yet ranks 13th in education quality. Administrative bloat consumes funds while classrooms lack basic resources.

Schools increasingly teach students *what* to think rather than *how* to think. **65% of students** report feeling pressured to conform to specific political viewpoints in class discussions.

9 Phonics Abandoned, Reading Suffers

Many schools abandoned proven phonics instruction for "whole language" approaches. Result:

40% of 4th graders

cannot read at grade level, creating a generation of functional illiterates.

10 National Security Threat

China graduates 4x more STEM students than the U.S. Our educational decline threatens military readiness, economic competitiveness, and national security as fewer Americans qualify for technical and defense jobs.
