SPRING CREEK FARMS POOL RULES

As a homeowner you are responsible for reading and understanding the Pool Rules. A copy of these rules has placed at the pool. By entering the pool area, you are acknowledging that you have read these rules and that you agree to comply with these rules. The following rules are to be followed and enforced by all residents. These rules are made for your safety. Any individual(s) who are reported to be/or found to be in violation of any of the pool rules will be reported to the Board and will result in your pool privileges being suspended. You are responsible for ensuring your guest know and follow the rules.

If a cardkey is lost, it can be replaced for a fee of \$25 and the lost cardkey will be deactivated. If you are a new homeowner and did not receive a cardkey from the previous owner, you may purchase one for a \$25 fee (this is a one-time service to new homeowners only) Please contact Acclaimed Property Management to get the issue resolved.

- 1. WARNING > No lifeguard on Duty. Swim at your own risk. Do not swim alone.
- 2. Pool Hours: 8:00AM 9:00PM (Monday-Sunday)
- 3. No use of tobacco or vapor products on pool property (Including chew, snuff, dip, cigarettes, etc.)
- 4. Glass containers of any kind are prohibited and are considered a serious infraction.
 - Violating this rule will result in an instant suspension for the season and the homeowner will be responsible for any fees incurred if the pool needs to be cleaned
- 5. No pets allowed.
- 6. No vulgar language.
- 7. Fighting is strictly prohibited and is considered a serious infraction.
- 8. No diving, flipping, running, or horseplay in or around the pools.
- Vandalism and/or destruction or damage of property will not be tolerated, and both are considered serious infractions. In addition, the homeowner will be responsible for any fees incurred for cleaning or repairing the item(s).
- 10. No riding or hanging on to the gate.
- 11. No balls that are sports approved such as footballs, basketballs, etc are allowed in the pool.
- 12. No floats/ rafts are allowed; Coast Guard approved flotation devices are approved
- 13. Do not open or hold the gate door open for anyone. Immediately shut the gate once entering the pool area.
- 14. All children who are not potty trained must wear swim diapers.
- 15. Proper swimming attire must be worn. (No cut-offs, street clothes, thongs, etc.)
- 16. Children under age 13 must be accompanied by an adult (Age 18 or older).
