

Privacy Policy

1) Who we are and how this policy applies

This Privacy Policy explains how **Nestive Ltd** ("Nestive", "we", "us", "our") collects and uses your personal data when you interact with our websites and services, including [www.nestivegardenrooms.co.uk] and related sub-domains (the "Site"), our social channels, and when you contact us by email or phone.

We act as the **data controller** for the personal data described in this policy. We process your data in accordance with the **UK General Data Protection Regulation** (**UK GDPR**) and the **Data Protection Act 2018**, and, where relevant, the **Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations** (**PECR**).

2) The data we collect

We may collect and process the following categories of personal data:

- **Identity & Contact Data:** name, email address, phone number, address, and any information you include in enquiry/quote forms or correspondence.
- Project & Transaction Data: details of your project requirements, quotes, invoices, contracts, work orders, customer service communications, and warranty/aftercare records.
- Marketing Preferences: your choices about receiving marketing and the channels you prefer.

- Usage & Technical Data: IP address, device and browser type, operating system, pages viewed, interactions, and referral sources collected via our Site, logs, and analytics tools.
- Cookies & Similar Technologies: small files set on your device—see
 Cookies below and our Cookie Policy.
- **Social Media Interactions:** likes, comments, messages, or form submissions via platforms such as Facebook/Instagram and LinkedIn.

We do **not** intentionally collect special category data (e.g., health, ethnicity) or children's data. Please do not provide such information to us.

3) How we obtain your data

- **Directly from you:** when you submit forms, request quotes, call or email us, sign contracts, or subscribe to updates.
- Automatically: via cookies/analytics when you browse the Site.
- From third parties: advertising and analytics partners (e.g., Google, Meta, LinkedIn), lead generation forms embedded on our pages, and publicly available sources (e.g., Companies House for business clients).

4) Purposes and lawful bases

We only use your personal data where the law allows. Below is a summary of our purposes and lawful bases under UK GDPR:

You can withdraw consent at any time (e.g., for marketing or non-essential cookies), and you can **object to processing** based on legitimate interests—see Your rights below.

5) Marketing (including PECR)

We may send you marketing about our services if:

- you have opted in, or
- you are an **existing customer** and we rely on the **soft opt-in** under PECR for similar products/services.

You can opt out at any time using the unsubscribe link in emails or by contacting us. We do not sell your personal data.

6) Cookies and similar technologies

We use:

- **Strictly necessary cookies** required for the Site to function (set without consent).
- Analytics and advertising cookies to understand performance and show relevant ads (set with your consent).

When you first visit, our cookie banner lets you **accept, reject, or manage** nonessential cookies. You can also adjust your browser settings. For full details (including cookie lifespans and providers), see our **[Cookie Policy]**.

7) Disclosures of your personal data

We share data only as needed with trusted recipients who act under contract and appropriate safeguards, including:

- Service providers / processors such as: website hosting, security and backup, IT support, email/CRM platforms, form and scheduling tools, analytics, and advertising platforms (e.g., Google, Meta, LinkedIn).
- Professional advisers such as accountants, insurers, and legal advisers.

- Authorities and regulators where required by law.
- **Business transfers** in the event of a merger, acquisition, or restructuring (your data would remain protected).

We ensure processors commit to confidentiality, use data only on our instructions, and implement appropriate security.

8) International transfers

Some providers may process data outside the UK. Where they do, we ensure appropriate safeguards, such as:

- UK adequacy regulations/decisions (where available), or
- the UK International Data Transfer Agreement (IDTA) or the UK Addendum to the EU Standard Contractual Clauses, plus supplementary measures as needed.

You can contact us for details of current safeguards relevant to your data.

9) Data retention

We keep personal data only as long as necessary for the purposes set out above, including to satisfy legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. Typical periods are:

- Enquiries/leads: up to 24 months from last contact if no contract follows.
- Contract and project records: 6 years after completion (to comply with limitation and tax rules).
- Marketing data: until you opt out or we identify prolonged inactivity (typically 24 months).
- Cookie data: per our Cookie Policy.

We securely delete or anonymise data when retention ends.

10) Security

We use appropriate **technical and organisational measures** to protect personal data, including access controls, encryption in transit where appropriate, regular updates, and staff awareness measures. No system is 100% secure, but we work to prevent unauthorised access, use, alteration, or disclosure.

11) Your rights (UK GDPR)

You have the right to:

- Access your personal data and get a copy.
- Rectify inaccurate or incomplete data.
- **Erase** your data in certain circumstances.
- Restrict processing in certain circumstances.
- Object to processing based on legitimate interests or to direct marketing.
- Data portability for data you provided to us with consent or under a contract.
- **Withdraw consent** at any time (this won't affect processing prior to withdrawal).

We aim to respond within **one month** (extendable by two months for complex requests). We may need to verify your identity.

You can complain to the **Information Commissioner's Office (ICO)** if you are unhappy with how we've used your data. We'd appreciate the chance to resolve concerns first.
