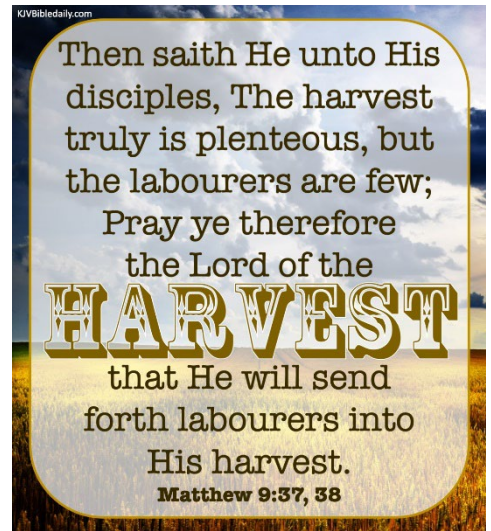


# Pray for the Harvest
