

Privacy Policy for More Than A CRM

More Than A CRM ("we," "us," or "our") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting the personal data you share with us. This Privacy Policy describes how we collect, use, and disclose your information when you use our services (the "Service"), and your privacy rights.

1. Data Collection

We collect and process personal data to provide and improve our Service to you. Personal data may be collected in the following ways:

a. Information You Provide to Us Directly

- **To Improve Our Service:** Analyzing usage and trends to improve the Service's functionality, design, and user experience.



- To Communicate with You: Sending transactional emails, updates, newsletters, and promotional materials. You may opt out of receiving marketing communications at any time.
- **To Enforce Legal Agreements:** Processing your data as necessary to fulfill our contractual obligations, comply with laws and regulations, and enforce our Terms and Conditions.

3. Legal Basis for Processing Personal Data

If you are located in the United Kingdom or the European Economic Area (EEA), we rely on the following legal bases for processing your personal data:

- **Contractual Necessity:** Processing necessary to perform our contractual obligations to you, such as providing the Service.
- Legitimate Interests: We may process your data for our legitimate interests, provided that such interests are not overridden by your rights and freedoms. This includes fraud prevention, improving our Service, and understanding our users.
- **Consent:** If we rely on your consent for processing personal data, you may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting us.

4. Data Sharing and Disclosure

We do not share, sell, or disclose your personal data with third parties except in the following cases:

- **Service Providers:** We may share your data with third-party vendors who provide services on our behalf, such as payment processing, data analysis, email delivery, and hosting.
- **Legal Requirements:** We may disclose your data if required to comply with legal obligations, such as a court order, regulatory requirement, or legal process.

5. International Data Transfers

6. Data Retention

We retain your personal data for as long as is necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy or as required by law. After this period, we will delete or anonymize your data. You may request data deletion at any time by contacting us, but note that certain information may need to be retained for legal compliance or legitimate business purposes.



7. Your Data Protection Rights

If you are in the UK or EEA, you have the following rights concerning your personal data:

- **Right to Access:** Request a copy of the personal data we hold about you.
- Right to Rectification: Request correction of any inaccurate or incomplete data.
- **Right to Erasure:** Request the deletion of your personal data, subject to certain conditions.
- **Right to Restrict Processing:** Request that we restrict the processing of your data under certain conditions.
- **Right to Data Portability:** Request a copy of your data in a structured, machine-readable format.
- **Right to Object:** Object to our processing of your data where we are relying on legitimate interests.
- **Right to Withdraw Consent:** Withdraw your consent for data processing at any time. To exercise any of these rights, please contact us using the contact information provided below.

8. Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect the security of your personal data. However, please note that no electronic transmission or storage method is 100% secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute data security.

9. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We use cookies and similar technologies to collect information about your use of the Service. You can control the use of cookies through your browser settings. However, disabling cookies may affect your ability to use certain features of the Service.

10. Children's Privacy

Our Service is not directed to individuals under the age of 18. We do not knowingly collect personal data from children under 18. If you become aware that a child has provided us with personal data, please contact us so that we can take appropriate action.
