Zakat Calculation:

Your Zakat donation should amount to 2.5% of your total zakatable wealth.

Nisab is the minimum amount of wealth you must possess before becoming eligible to pay Zakat.

2025 Nisab threshold: Silver = \$906.29 • Gold = \$11705.69

Amount of money (or silver/gold) you have saved for a full a year $\div 100 \times 2.5 =$ Amount of Zakat you owe

Example Zakat Calculation:
