Psalm 80

We make choices that can cause separation in our hearts from God. He wants us to respond to Him, to allow Him to restore our us and when his face shines on us, we fleck his light to a world that desperately needs to be restored.

Daniel 2:14-23

Daniel's life was being threatened because of his choice to serve God and shine His light. God gave Daniel wisdom in how to handle a very difficult situation. When Daniel responded, he chose wisdom over his fleshly response and it produced life-saving favor over his life and his friends. When we seek God's hidden purpose in difficult situations, He reveals His light in darkness.and when we operate in God's wisdom, then others see the light that dwells within us!

Psalm 31

David was learning to trust God. As we get rid of worthless idols in our lives, we put our trust fully in God and in him alone. As you seek God today, lean in and choose to trust Him above every circumstance. God already knows your situation and He is full of mercy. When we are weak, He is strong! Put your trust in God and allow the light of trusting Him to take priority.

1 John 1:5-10

When we have a relationship with God, real fellowship with Him, we walk in His light. Darkness cannot exist because God is light! This light purifies us from all sin. Relationship, truth and light are all connected. God wants a relationship with you, not just the idea of a loving God and Father, but an actual relationship that is genuine and allows us to walk in light and not darkness!
